YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 6-3. Mitchell Tolman hit a two-run homer in the second inning to give Richmond a 2-0 lead. Bowie tied the score with two runs in the third. Zach Watson hit a solo homer and a run later scored when Kyle Stowers grounded into a double play. The Flying Squirrels moved back in front with an RBI single by **Diego Rincones** in the top of the sixth. **Sandro Fabian** opened the lead to 5-2 with a two-run homer, his tenth on the year. Watson hit a second solo homer in the bottom of the seventh. **Brandon Martorano** clubbed his fourth Double-A home run in the top of the ninth, his fourth of the season. **Patrick Ruotolo** picked up two strikeouts and closed out a four-out save, his seventh save of the year. Richmond starter **Trenton Toplikar** worked 6.0 innings and allowed two runs for his first win since June 8.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Baysox are the only team the Flying Squirrels play more than two series against in 2021. This is the last of four sets between the two teams this year. In the Flying Squirrels' last trip to Bowie from July 6-11, they went 4-2. The Baysox went 4-2 at The Diamond from May 18-23 and 5-1 in Richmond from July 27-August 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three straight after losing 12 of the previous 14 games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 9.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .232 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a .381 ERA for the season.

THE BAYSOX have won seven of the last 11 games. They split last week's road series against the Somerset Patriots. The Baysox are currently second in the division and sit 2.5 games out of the second postseason spot for the league. The Bowie offense is ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .238 batting average. Bowie's pitching staff is ranked fourth with a 4.16 ERA. Bowie's roster features seven of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including RHP Grayson Rodriguez (2), LHP D.L. Hall (3 - on IL), OF Yusniel Diaz (8), 2B Terrin Vavra (10 - on IL), OF Kyle Stowers (22), LHP Drew Rom (25) and SS Joseph Ortiz (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Aaron Blair makes his fourth start for the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Thursday and was charged with a loss after allowing four runs, all unearned, over 3.0 innings with five errors committed behind him. He has not allowed an earned run in his last two starts, spanning 6.0 innings of work. He faced the Baysox on July 30 and worked 3.0 scoreless innings. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with be Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. *For more on Blair, see page two*.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Grayson Rodriguez makes his 12th Double-A start and third against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he pitched 4.2 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in a no-decision at Somerset last Thursday. He has faced Richmond twice this season. On July 10 in Bowie, he allowed three runs in 5.0 innings against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on July 30 and allowed one run in 2.0 innings in a game interrupted by rain. Rodriguez was drafted by the Orioles in the first round (11th overall) in 2018 out of Central Heights High School in Nacogdoches, Texas. He pitched nine games in 2018 in the Gulf Coast League before spending all of 2019 Low-A Delmarva, where he went 10-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 20 starts. In 2019, he was named a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star and the SAL Most Outstanding Prospect while also earning a selection for the Futures Game in Cleveland. Rodriguez is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 2 prospect and the No. 19 prospect overall.

STARTING STRONG: Over the last 12 games since July 28, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.98 ERA (14 ER/63.2 IP). In the last seven games since August 3, spanning the series against Reading and Bowie, starters have posted a 1.35 ERA (6 ER/40.0 IP). Sean Hjelle pitched 7.0 innings scoreless innings last Tuesday. **Trenton Toplikar** worked 7.0 innings last Wednesday and allowed three earned runs. **Aaron Blair** did not surrender an earned run over 3.0 innings in his start last Thursday. **Michael Plassmeyer** worked 5.0 scoreless innings last Friday night. **Akeel Morris** pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in a combined shutout last Saturday. **Matt Frisbee** allowed one run over 6.0 innings on Sunday in the finale. Toplikar allowed two runs in 6.0 innings in the series opener at Bowie on Tuesday.

BIG FLIES IN BOWIE: The Flying Squirrels have combined to hit 14 home runs at Prince George's Stadium in seven games. During the Flying Squirrels' first visit to Bowie from July 6-11. They added three more homers in a win on Tuesday. In the last seven games in Bowie, Vince Fernandez has hit three homers, Frankie Tostado, Sandro Fabian, Heliot Ramos and Brandon Martorano have hit two and Mitchell Tolman, Andy Sugilio and David Villar each have one homer in Bowie this season.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, Jacob Heyward set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by Mark Minicozzi, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 26 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 106 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by Ricky Oropesa, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank ninth in the circuit with 86 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 121 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .382 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be tied for the highest in the franchise's history (Even with a .382 mark from 2013). Richmond's 86 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2019 (94), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons.

GO, DIEGO, GOI: Over his last 18 games since July 17, Diego Rincones is batting .312 (19-for-61) with four homers, four doubles, one triple and 16 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. Over his last seven games since August 3, Rincones is batting .385 (10-for-26) with three doubles and five RBIs. He has knocked go-ahead hits in the Richmond wins on Saturday, Sunday and Tuesday.

SIMON SAYS: Simon Whiteman is batting .317 (26-for-82) over his last 22 games since July 15 with six doubles, one triple, one homer and six RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 14 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 31 steals in 34 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

TORRES ON A TEAR: Bryan Torres is currently riding a 13-game hitting streak dating back to July 3, which is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres is batting .386 (19-for-49) with three doubles, a triple and seven RBIs. He has picked up two hits in five of his last eight games played. He is batting .306 this season in 34 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.

LEFT ON BASE: Over the last 17 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .145 (20-for-138) with runners in scoring position and have left 143 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .131 (8-for-61) with the bases loaded, which is the second-lowest mark of the 120 full-season minor league teams this year.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked ninth with 49 RBIs. Simon Whiteman is tied for fifth with 14 stolen bases. Trenton Toplikar is ranked eighth with a 4.90 ERA. Joey Marciano (29/T-4th), Patrick Ruotolo (29/T-4th), Frank Rubio (28/8th), Raffi Vizcaino (28/T-8th), and Matt Seelinger (27/T-10th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. Patrick Ruotolo is tied for fourth with seven saves and R.J. Dabovich is tied for seventh with six.

FREE FALLING: The Flying Squirrels have lost 13 of the last 18 games since July 21. On August 1, their record dropped .500 for the first time since May 5 (1-1). On August 5, the record fell below .500 for the first time since May 4 (0-1). Prior to this stretch, the Flying Squirrels were tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron. The team has fallen back to fifth and is now 9.5 games back.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have two players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: Will Wilson (10) and Tristan Beck (13 - on IL). Simon Whiteman is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (12) and Beck (20), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
