#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jake Lamb went 3-for-3 and Nick Gonzales extended his league-leading on-base streak to 20 games as the Indianapolis Indians dropped Tuesday night's series opener against the Omaha Storm Chasers at Werner Park, 7-4. In the first contest of the season between the two clubs, Indianapolis struck right away in the first inning, courtesy of a Jake Lamb RBI single to scored Ji Hwan Bae. The Indians added another in the third courtesy of a Yasmani Grandal RBI double to plate Bae for the second time. Gonzales then scored on a wild pitch from Omaha starter Daniel Lynch, who tossed 5.0 four-run innings. Nick Loftin put Omaha on the board in the third inning with an RBI single, and back-to-back run-scoring ground balls quickly tied the game. Three singles in the fourth inning turned the game in the Storm Chasers' favor. The Indians went hitless in the final two innings of the game, with Will Klein closing out the game in the ninth.

LAMB LEADS THE LEAGUE: With a 3-for-3 performance last night, Jake Lamb raised his season batting average to a league-best .400 (20-for-50) in 16 games with Indianapolis this season. He joins Gonzales, who ranks second, on the leaderboard. Lamb has reached base safely in 15 of 16 games played this season with six runs, five extra-base htis, 10 RBI and 11 walks. In addition to batting average, he ranks among IL leaders in on-base percentage (2nd, .492) and OPS (9th, 1.072).

NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES: The Indians' 52 doubles are the second-most among all 30 Triple-A teams this season, trailing Albuquerque's 54, and the most in the International League. In addition to leading the International League, Nick Gonzales is currently leading the Triple-A pack with 11 two-baggers. The Indians as a team are also hitting .278 (198-for-713), good for the third-best batting average in the IL behind Durham (.283, 219-for-773) and Buffalo (.278, 189-for-679).

GONZALES GETS ON BASE: Nick Gonzales went 2-for-4 with a run and walk yesterday to extend his league-leading on-base streak to a careerhigh 20 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 20-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona and is tied with Columbus' Johnathan Rodriguez for the longest in the IL this season. His two-hit performance also extended his hitting streak to 13 games dating back to 4/6. The middle infielder currently leads all International League leaders in doubles (11) and hits (T-1st, 32), while also ranking among leaders in batting average (2nd, .390) runs (T-2nd, 20), extra-base hits (T-5th, 13), total bases (9th, 48) and on-base percentage (9th, .444).

GO GRANDAL: Pittsburgh Pirates rehabber Yasmani Grandal logged two hits for his second consecutive game last night (2-for-5) after homering on Sunday vs. St. Paul. His third-inning double last night extended Indianapolis' lead before Omaha tied the game in the bottom half. It was Grandal's fifth game of his rehab assignment, during which he has hit .294 (5-for-17) with two runs, a double, home run and six RBI.

OUTHITTING: The Indians logged 10 hits last night at Omaha, marking the 11th time in 22 games that they've recorded double-digit hits in a game. Omaha outhit the Indians, 12-10, which was just the eighth time this season that Indianapolis has been outhit by their opponent. In those games, they are 1-7 with a 10-4 record in games in which the Indians record more hits.

TODAY: The Indianapolis Indians will look to even the series in the second game of the six-game set at Omaha today. Last season, the Indians went 5-12 vs. Omaha with a 5-4 record at Werner Park. Taking the mound for Indianapolis in the MiLB.TV Free Game of the Day is RHP Paul Skenes (0-0, 0.00), making his first career start against the Storm Chasers. Countering for Omaha is RHP Zach Davies (0-0, -.--), who has made one career start against Indianapolis during his 2015 season with Norfolk. In that contest, he took the loss with 6.0 three-run innings and five strikeouts.

STRIKEOUT COUNTER SKYROCKETING: Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) punched out eight batters across 3.1 innings for the second consecutive start on Thursday vs. St. Paul, his fourth career Triple-A outing. All eyes were on the 21-year-old, who has racked up 27 strikeouts in just 12.2 innings pitched this season. On Thursday, Skenes worked another masterpiece with 3.1 innings of one-hit baseball and eight punchouts. The right-hander had everything working, with his fastball reaching triple-digits on 34 of 65 total pitches. His four-seamer topped out at a seasonhigh 102.1 mph.

THIS DATE IN 1902: In the newly formed American Association, the Indianapolis Indians opened the regular season with a 5-4 win over the Milwaukee Brewers – who were a minor league team at the time – at Washington Park. The team was part of a parade from the Grand Hotel to Washington Park, where a crowd estimated at 4,000 watched the locals earn the hard-fought victory.

**Paul Skenes:** The hard-throwing right-hander Skenes will make his fifth Triple-A start as the MiLB.TV/MLB.TV Free Game of the Day this afternoon at Omaha.

**Last Outing:** For the second start in a row, Skenes punched out eight while tossing 3.1 innings of shutout baseball. He allowed one hit and two walks in the outing vs. St. Paul.

**Against the Storm Chasers:** Skenes has never faced Omaha.

**Triple Digits:** Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.6 mph during his last start on Friday at Toledo. In his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. The hardest-thrown fastball in Triple-A since velocity began being tracked in the minors in 2021 was 102.9 mph in 2023.

**Prospectus:** Enters the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. ... Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 3 prospect in baseball and No. 9 by *Baseball America*. ... Is also rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline. ... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft and No. 2 by *Baseball America*. ... Was also rated first in "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball" and "Best Athlete, third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" by *Baseball America* in the Class of 2023.
