The city of Columbus got a new baseball team in 1977 with the debut of the Columbus Clippers.

The games were played at Franklin County Stadium. The Clippers started a tradition which continues to this day, where fans can buy hot dogs for just ten cents. It is known as "Dime-A-Dog"

Night.

In the first season, the Clippers won 65 games but lost 75 games and finished the year in 7th place in the standings. However, things got better soon. The Clippers won the League Championship three straight seasons from 1979 to 1981. Overall, Columbus has won eleven championships, which is more than any other team.

The Clippers are a Minor League Baseball team. Many former Clippers players have gone on to become All-Stars and champions in Major League Baseball. A few have even made it to the National Baseball Hall of Fame, such as Derek Jeter and Mariano Rivera.

In 2009, the Clippers relocated to a new stadium known as Huntington Park. The current ballpark is in the Arena District in downtown Columbus. Huntington Park has won many awards as the best ballpark in the country. Over 25 million fans have attended games at Huntington Park.






