CARDINALS BLANK HOOKS, CLINCH SERIES WIN: Tink Hence, Max Rajcic and Jack Ralston combined to allow just five hits and delivered the Cardinals' 5th shutout of the season as Springfield defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks 4-0 on Saturday night at Hammons Field. Jeremy Rivas opened the scoring with a solo home run in the 6th inning, and was followed

by RBI doubles by Nathan Church and Jimmy Crooks. Making his first start since June 23, Hence struck out 4 over 1.2 innings. Rajcic followed with 6.1 scoress innings allowing 3 hits with 7 K's in his first career relief appearance.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jose Fleury** makes his 5th start (9th appearance) of the season for Corpus Christi...Last pitched on Sunday, July 21 against Midland at Whataburger Field and allowed iust one unearned run on 2 H over 4.0 IP with 2 K...Returned from a two-month stint on the Injured List on July 3 after 2 rehab starts in the Florida Complex League...Initially placed on the IL May 11...Made his full-season debut in 2023 with Low-A Fayetteville and went 4-3 with a 3.65 ERA in 26 appearances (14 starts), striking out 139 to 48 BB in 98.2 IP...Opponents batted just .182 against him...Made his pro debut in 2022 in the DSL...Changeup is rated by Baseball America as the best in the Astros system...Signed by the Astros in December 2021 as an International Free Agent for just \$10,000 as an 18-year-old out of the Dominican Republic...22 years old

CARDS HOST HOOKS IN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON MATCHUP: The Cardinals return to Hammons Field for a six-game series and their final regular season matchup with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). Springfield won four of six against the Hooks at Whataburger Field in June, including a postseason-clinching win in the series finale on the final day of the first half on June 23.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HOME SWEET HOME: After struggling for a stretch and even after Wednesday night's loss, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield is 12-3 over its last 15 games at home, lifting its home record back over .500 at 25-24. The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.53.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in home runs this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles of late. Over its last 21 games since June 30 Springfield has clubbed 24 homers, good for 2nd in the circuit during that time behind only Midland (29). The Cardinals sport a SLG of .448 and .799 OPS during that time and have homered in 13 of their last 15 games. For the season the Cardinals are 8th in the Texas League with 66 homers.

EDMAN RETURNS TO HAMMONS FIELD: Rehabbing wrist and ankle injuies, Cardinals utilityman Tommy Edman returns to the Ozarks for his 2nd rehab stint with Springfield. In 7 games covering two rehab stints this season, Edman is batting .250 (6-for-24). The Stanford product has not played in the big leagues yet this season after offseason wrist surgery. The 2021 gold-glover at 2B signed a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 21 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the league among gualified hitters with a .346 average while adding 5 HR and 17 RBIs with 4 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .615 and has a 1.015 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .865 OPS and .402 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO HITS CAREER MILESTONE: With his stolen base in the 3rd inning on Friday night, Cardinals OF Mike Antico reached 150 for his career. With the franchise record for stolen bases in hand, Antico's next stolen base will give him 100 for his Springfield career. With his 2-run shot on Tuesday is just 3 homers shy of 50 career bombs.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the alltime franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 8-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 14-for-28 (.500) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI. In 11 games in July, he is batting .395 (17-for-43) with a team-high 1.052 OPS.

YEAGER BOMBS: With home runs in back-to-back games, Cardinals INF RJ Yeager has regained his power stroke and run his hitting streak to 8 straight games, batting .306 with 2 2B, 3 HR and 7 RBIs since July 10. Yeager hit a team-high 5 homers in April before hitting just 2 longballs in May and June

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 16-for-16 and his 16 saves lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 12.0 IP (0.69 ERA) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities.


