HOMERS HURT SHRIMP IN 4-2 LOSS

The Bulls hit three home runs on Friday to beat the Jumbo Shrimp 4-2. The game was scoreless until Jacob Berry's RBI double in the top of the fifth. Durham promptly tied things when Jamie Westbrook launched a leadoff home run in the bottom of the fifth. Later in the inning, Bob Seymour's tworun shot gave the Bulls a lead they wouldn't relinquish. After a Tristan Peters solo shot in the sixth, Berry's RBI ground out in the seventh set things at 4-2. Patrick Monteverde allowed just one run on three hits in 4.2 innings of work. Matt Pushard pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 25 of their last 36 games (69.4 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs: the lumbo Shrimp rank tied for first in Triple-A with 56 home runs over the last 36 games. They swatted just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 27 of his 36 starts, including 13 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 45-for-136 (.331/.421/.647/1.068 at the plate with nine doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 23 RBIs, 22 walks and 26 runs. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (44) and walks (63). He also ranks tied for second in triples (5). tied for 19th in homers (13), 20th in OBP (.378), 21st in hits (83) and tied for 25th in extra-base hits (32).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games this year. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 51 games, Berry has drawn as many walks (25) as strikeouts (25) while going 48for-156 (.308/.409/.494/.903) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 27 RBIs and 26 runs. He has the winning hit in four of Jacksonville's 12 last at-bat wins.

IT GFTS LATE FARLY

With their starters working such a small amount of innings, Jacksonville's bullpen has been forced to shoulder the load throughout the 2025 campaign, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 472.1, or 54.8 percent, of the club's 862.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks tied for the fifth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.73), while also leading Triple-A in BAA (.216). During this series against Durham, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has worked 17.1 innings, yielding only five runs, four earned, on 10 hits for a 2.08 ERA. They have combined for 23 strikeouts against seven walks.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 99 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 390.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the sixth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.69 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 202 this season not only lead the entire level, but they are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville now has 12 last at-bat wins through 98 games this season. They mustered only 14 throughout all of the 2024 campaign... The Jumbo Shrimp are 41-21 (.661) in games decided by three runs or fewer, including 21-9 (.700) in bouts determined by exactly one run. Those 21 one-run victories are tied for the second-most such wins in all of Minor League Baseball... At 59-40 (.596), Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2007 Jacksonville Suns started the campaign with a 61-38 (.616) record.



ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was promoted to Jacksonville on July 9 from Double-A Pensacola.

-At the time of his promotion, Snelling ranked tied for fourth in the Southern League in strikeouts (85), seventh in WHIP (1.22), 11th in ERA (3.61), 13th in batting average against (.238), tied for 13th in games started (14) and 14th in innings pitched (72.1).

-With Pensacola, opposing right-handed hitters batted just .202/.251/.301/.552 in 195 plate appearances. In comparison, left-handed batters hit .309/.387/.436/.823 against him in 104 plate appearances.

2024 SEASON

-Snelling was transferred to Jacksonville on September 20 from Double-A Pensacola.

With both Double-A San Antonio and Pensacola, held opponents to a .254/.335/.457/.792 batting line in 257 plate appearances. With runners on, that swelled to .322/.376/.503/.879 in 223 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

Earned Baseball America's Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

-Between three levels, Snelling went 11-3 this season with a 1.82 ERA. He struck out 118 and walked 34 in 103.2 innings. He allowed just four home runs in 22 starts. Since 2000, just seven teenage minor league pitchers have recorded a sub-2.00 ERA in 100 innings or more. Snelling is joined on the list by Cole Hamels (2003), Will Inman (2006), Madison Bumgarner (2008), Michael Piñeda (2008), Jose Fernandez (2012) and Andrew Painter (2022). Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-A.
