- The Blue Jays squandered a 3-2 9th inning lead and dropped the series finale with Bradenton 4-3 on Sunday at TD Ballpark.
- Dunedin was no-hit through six innings, but scored three runs prior to collecting a hit thanks in part to eight walks from Marauders reliver Carlos Jimenez.
- Jays reliver Kai Peterson tied a season-high with six strikeouts in 2.1 innings.
- Yondrei Rojas surrendered two runs in the top of the 9th a solo homer from Axiel Plaz, and RBI double from Jeral Toledo.
- The defeat marks just the third time this season the Blue Jays lost after leading through eight innings (27-3).

THE WEEK IN REVIEW

- The Blue Jays settled for a split with Bradenton, dropping the final two games of the series with the Marauders.
- After scoring 10 runs in Friday night's victory, Dunedin managed just four runs in the final two games.
- The Jays drew 29 walks in the series the most in the FSL last week.
- Victor Arias had a historic Friday night, ripping eight RBIs the most by a D-Jay since 2021.
- Four of six games in the series were rain-effected.

FIRST HALF FINISH

With three games remaining in the first half, Dunedin's record stands at 32-31. While eliminated from playoff contention, a win would clinch the Jays' best first half record since 2019, when the D-Jays went a whopping 41-24 in the FSL North. Dunedin went 32-34 in the first half last season.

SERIES SUCCESS

With Friday night's win, the Blue Jays clinched five straight sets with a split or better. Across that stretch, Dunedin has earned three splits and two series wins. Across the last five weeks, the Jays are 18-16. Dunedin has split three of its last four series.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

With Sunday's 4-3 loss, Dunedin has played 22 one-run games this season, going 10-12 in those contests. 43 of the Blue Jays 63 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 21-22 record in those games.

PATIENCE PAYS

Dunedin tied a season-high with 11 walks on Sunday, which helped them score three runs before collecting a hit. The Jays' 29 walks (4.8 per game) last week were the most in the Florida State League. Dunedin is fourth in the league with 280 walks this season.

SURE HANDED

Entering this week's series, Dunedin is tied for the best fielding percentage (.975) and fewest errors (56) in the FSL. The Blue Jays committed just one error in last week's series with Bradenton.

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split three times and won twice.

KAI'S KS

After struggling in May (8 app, 10.24 ERA, 9.2 IP, 14 BB), Kai Peterson has found his footing out of the Jays' bullpen in June. Across Peterson's last six outings, the lefty has struck out 28 batters in 12.1 innings of work. In his last three outings, he's struck out five or more without allowing an earned run.

REHAB CITY. USA

Dunedin has hosted 10 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Infielder Cade Doughty re-joins the Jays' roster today for his second rehab stint of the season. In April, Dunedin went 4-0 with Doughty in the lineup, as he went 3-10 with three walks.
