# FRIDAY'S RECAP

The Baysox won their fourth-consecutive game with a 4-3, 10 inning victory over the Senators. Enrique Bradfield Jr. led the way with three hits for Chesapeake, including the go-ahead double in the top of the tenth inning. Bradfield scored the tying run in the eighth, after taking off on a pitch grounded to the right side of the infield and scoring from second on the play. **Creed Willems** opened the scoring with a two-run double early in the contest. Right-hander Keagan Gillies pitched a scoreless pair of innings and took the win for the Baysox.

## CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is tied for sixth in the Eastern League in doubles (11) and extra base hits (18). The Orioles No. 12 prospect has the third-most homers in the league in the month of May (4), while his .952 OPS this month is 8th-best. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the Baysox.

## **ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES**

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. tallied his fourth-career Double-A game with three or more hits on Friday, and his first such game of the season. In 36 career Double-A contests, the O's No. 3 prospect is batting .306, with a .410 on-base percentage and .839 OPS. The Baysox are 7-1 this season in games started by Bradfield, who missed 32 games earlier this season due to injury.

## **WALK THIS WAY**

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (33). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. No player has drawn more walks in the circuit since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

### **ACTION JACKSON**

Over his last 10 games, IF Jeremiah Jackson is batting .333 with two home runs, five doubles, and 9 RBI. The first year Baysox shortstop is third in the league in doubles (13). The next home run for Jackson will be the 100th of his pro career. A former Mets farmhand who played 158 games with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Jackson has homered in every Eastern League ballpark aside from FNB Field in Harrisburg.

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.89 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifthbest in MiLB. Baysox relievers threw 14-consecutive scoreless innings to open this week in Harrisburg - the most of any Minor League team - and have allowed just one run in 18.2 innings this series (0.48 ERA).

### ONE RUN WONDERS

Last night was Chesapeake's 13th one-run victory of the season - the most of any Minor League team. The Baysox have also played more one-run games (21) this season than any other MiLB side.

# SCOUTING THE SENATORS

The Harrisburg Senators enter Saturday with a record of 19-23 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg's 97 runs in the month of May are tied for most in the Eastern League. The Senators roster features two active members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10) and IF Kevin Made (No. 26). Harrisburg is managed by returning skipper Delino DeShields, who appeared in four games for the Baysox in 1999 during his playing career.

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTERS

RHP Hyun-il Choi is set to get the ball in game one of Saturday's doubleheader for Harrisburg. Choi has spent time both with the Senators and Triple-A Rochester this season, after spending the first five seasons of his career with the Dodgers organization, spending most of last season in Triple-A. The 24-year-old from South Korea was a Rule 5 selection by the Nationals from the Dodgers this past offseason. Harrisburg's game two starter is set to be left-hander Dustin Saenz. A 4th round pick from Texas A&M in 2021, Saenz has spent three seasons with Harrisburg, missing close to four months last season due to a stint on the injured list.

# Manager

## **CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS**



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

## **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

## **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
