On this day in 2005, Corey Hart launched two homers, a grand slam (5th) and a solo shot (7th) in Nashville's 9-2 win over Iowa. a gem, going eight scoreless innings with six strikeouts.

Southpaw Slayers: The Sounds offense pounced on Gwinnett starter Justus Sheffield last night, plating six runs in three frames against the lefty. Nashville is batting .296 against left-handed pitching this season, second in the International League behind Iowa (.358). When facing southpaws with runners in scoring position, the Sounds are batting .341 (56-for-164) with a 18.3% strikeout rate, pacing the circuit in both.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, right-handed pitcher Abner Uribe is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed Sounds starter Justin Lehr tossed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

> How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 636-549 record during an eight-season span.
