YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 4-3, in 10 innings for their second straight win in the series. Trailing by two entering the bottom of the 10th, Turner Hill hit an RBI double and Bryce Eldridge knocked in a run with his first Double-A hit to tie the score. With the bases loaded, a wild pitch scored Hill from third to win the game. Victor Bericoto opened the scoring with an RBI double in the first inning. The RubberDucks tied the score in the fourth inning with a single by Yordy Valdez. Jorge Burgos broke the 1-1 tie with a two-run double in the top of the 10th inning. Jack Choate started and allowed one run over four innings with six strikeouts. Nick Swiney and Mat Olsen each pitched two scoreless innings. Cameron Cotter entered in the 10th and threw one pitch, working a double play, to pick up his first Double-A win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the thirdd of a six-game series at The Diamond, Richmond's finale home series of 2024. The two teams faced off in the first series at The Diamond this year from April 9-14, splitting the set. From April 30-May 5, the RubberDucks won five-of-six at Canal Park. Richmond returned to Akron for three games coming out of the All-Star Break from July 19-21, with the 'Ducks winning two-of-three.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in the last series at Erie after going 4-1 in their previous five games from August 21-25 which followed losing a six-game losing streak from August 14-20. In their last 15 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .267 (134-for-502) and averaging 8.9 hits per game (134 total) and averaging 4.9 runs per game (74 total), also best in the Eastern League. In their last 15 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels have homered 14 times after hitting six homers in their previous nine games from July 27-August 17.

THE RUBBERDUCKS clinched the Southwest Division's second-half on Saturday night. They swept all six games of last week's series against the Baysox at Canal Park. Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including 1B C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 19), SS Kahlil Watson (No. 20), C Cooper Ingle (No. 21) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes Kayfus (No. 7), Ingle (No. 15), Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28) and Watson (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his 14th Double-A start and his first against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on Friday at Erie and allowed four runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Among Giants minor league pitchers (min. 90 IP), Sinacola leads the organization in BAA (.221) and WHIP (1.05). He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). Sinacola began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. FOR AKRON: Right-hander Austin Peterson makes his 12th Double-A start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He faced Richmond on July 19 at Canal Park and was charged with a loss after allowing two runs over 4.2 innings with seven strikeouts. Last time out, Peterson faced the Baysox on Friday in Akron and threw six scoreless innings with five strikeouts for a win. Peterson began the season with High-A Lake County, going 7-2 with a 2.44 ERA in 14 starts before being promoted to Double-A on June 24. In his pro debut season last year with Low-A Lynchburg, Peterson went 6-8 with a 4.54 ERA in 24 starts. Peterson was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Connecticut, where he was a teammate of former Flying Squirrels pitcher Reggie Crawford.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 89 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 21 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 21 GIDPs this year are tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005).

WELCOME HOME, BRYCE: Bryce Eldridge was assigned to the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday afternoon. The 19-year-old first baseman was selected with the 16th pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Madison High School in Vienna, Va. With his debut, he became the fifth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history born in Virginia, joining Jarrett Parker (2013-14), Matt Winn (2016-19),(2018-19) Connor Overton and Spencer Bivens (2023). At 19 years, 10 months and 14 days old, Eldridge became the second-youngest player in franchise history, trailing only Anyesber Sivira (2019) and just ahead of Heliot Ramos 2019, 2021). As the 16th player selected in last year's draft, Eldridge is the seventh-highest draft pick in franchise history, trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018), Hunter Bishop (10, 2019), Patrick Bailey (13, 2020), Tyler Beede (14, 2014), Will Bednar (14, 2021) and Will Wilson (15, 2019). This season, Eldridge leads the Giants organization in home runs (22), RBIs (87), SLG (534), OPS (910), extra-base hits (48) and total bases (206) and ranks second in batting average (.293), second in hits (113), second in runs (69), fourth in OBP (.376), fourth in doubles (25) and sixth in walks (52). Last week, he was named Northwest League Player of the Week for Eugene after hitting five home runs.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 62 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .293 (72-for-246) with six homers, 13 doubles, 14 walks and 38 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. On Sunday, he hit a grand slam in Erie.

MUN-SHOTS: In his 23 August games, Ismael Munguia batted .353 (30-for-85), third-highest in the Eastern League, with three homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 21-of-26 games played since August 1. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .295 (136-for-461) in 118 games, which is the third-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA). In his last 10 games since August 24, Munguia is batting .412 (14-for-34) with four homers and 11 RBIs. He has nine RBIs in his last six games since last Thursday.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Diego Velasquez is batting .368 (14-for-38) in his last 10 games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has seven hits in his last five games played with three RBIs. Among Giants full-season Giants minor leaguers this season, Velasquez is ranked fourth in batting average (.282), third in hits (110), fifth in stolen bases (21), tied for seventh in triples (4), ninth in OBP (.360) and ninth in total bases (148).

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell has collected 14 hits in his last 12 games since August 21, batting .292 (14-for-48) with a double and seven runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), tied for first in triples (6), tied for fourth in hits (115), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (39) and eighth in total bases (166).

PACKING THE HOUSE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,517) and total (404,079) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels are 12th in average attendance. In 2022 and 2023, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance for the first times in franchise history.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-33), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B Bryce Eldridge (No. 3), OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 19).
