LAST OUTING: Jarvis had a rocky Triple-A debut on July 6 vs. Columbus, issuing a season-high six walks over 3.1 innings on his way to a loss. He allowed five runs (four earned) on five hits in the Sounds' 6-2 defeat. Six walks was a season-high for Jarvis and for any Nashville pitcher.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Jarvis' first career appearance against Jacksonville.
