Jersey Shore BlueClaws (36-29/74-57) vs Aberdeen IronBirds (32-33/66-65)

Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium - Aberdeen, Maryland (opened 2002) RHP Esitbenzon Jimenez (4-10, 6.95) vs TBA Series: Game 6 of 6 (season series tied 13-13 of 27)

Last Time Out... Braydon Tucker threw seven scoreless innings, matching the longest outing by a BlueClaws pitcher this season, and Jersey Shore's four first inning runs proved enough in a 4-0 win over Aberdeen on Saturday night at Leidos Field...The BlueClaws have won four in a row after dropping the series opener on Tuesday...Bryson Ware had a two run double in the first inning for the BlueClaws.

Still at Stake...With a win today, manager Greg Brodzinski would pass Shawn Williams (2015-16) for solo-third in team history with 148 wins...The BlueClaws are 147-115 under Brodzinski in the last two years and went 147-131 under Williams in his two seasons (the BlueClaws play a 132 game schedule now and played 140 game schedules from 2001-2019)...Marty Malloy (160-117 in 2017-18) is the team's all-time wins leader and Steve Roadcap (149-125 in 2007-08) has the second most wins.

A Team High-A Record...The BlueClaws win last night gave them 74 on the season, the most they have won in four years as a High-A affiliate...They went 73-58 last year (and had one game cancelled)...They were 51-81 in 2022 and 56-62 in 2021...A win today would give them a .568 winning percentage, which would be the 6th best in team history (23 seasons) and the second-best since 2011 (they were 87-51, .630 in 2018).

Drive for Five... A win would give the BlueClaws five straight wins four the fourth time this season... They also finished the 2016 season with five straight wins (the last three of which were shutouts).

Mendez Mashing...Hendry Mendez hit a game winning home run in the ninth inning on Friday, breaking a 4-4 tie...It was his third home run with the BlueClaws...He then added four more hits on Saturday...Mendez is 7-17 in the series and is 22-46 in his last 13 games with two doubles, two triples and a home run...Further, since the start of July, Mendez is 54-160 (.338) with 14 doubles and all three of his home runs...The 20 year old spent last year with Wisconsin (Brewers High-A) and was acquired from Milwaukee last November.

Anthony, Dissin Promoted to Reading... Keaton Anthony, who had four hits in his final BlueClaws game on Thursday, was promoted to Reading on Friday along with Jordan Dissin...Anthony finished his BlueClaws career at .356 after arriving on June 26th from Clearwater...He added four home runs and 45 RBIs in 205 at bats and 53 games played...Dissin led the BlueClaws with nine home runs and was second in the league in throwing out 32 potential base-stealers defensively

A Studpendous Season...Anthony's .356 batting average is the third best in BlueClaws history (min 200 at bats) behind Chris Duffy's .384 in 2012 and Michael Taylor's .361 in 2008...While he didn't have enough at bats to qualify for the SAL or the FSL League title (he hit .322 with Clearwater), he does for the overall MiLB crown, and Anthony's combined batting average this season is third best in the minors among qualified hitters (Chandler Simpson of the Rays leads at .356).

ards Wednesday...Aidan Miller was named South Atlantic League Player of the Month for August (hit .299 with 3 HRs and a .906 OPS) and Hendry Mendez was named Phillies Minor League Player of the Month for August (hit .352 with a .957 OPS)...Miller was the first BlueClaw to win SAL Player of the Week since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021....Mendez was the second BlueClaw to win Phillies Minor League Player of the Month this year after Otto Kemp in May

Knocked Out....The BlueClaws were eliminated from playoff contention on Wednesday night with Hudson Valley's win over Asheville...The Renegades clinched a playoff spot with their win and Jersey Shore's win over Aberdeen...Jersey Shore was trying to reach the postseason for the second straight season...They went to Aberdeen three out, without the tiebreaker, and six games remaining in the season (they would have been one out with the tiebreaker had they defeated Hudson Valley on Sunday).

Welcome to Aberdeen...The BlueClaws are in Aberdeen (3-1 this week) for the final series of the regular season...Jersey Shore is 12-13 agianst the IronBirds this year and 7-9 at Ripken Stadium...The last series was a six-game series that they split ending July 28th in Lakewood...They next meet on April 8th, Opening Night at the Jersey Shore in 2025 in what is the second series of the season.

First Two for Viars...Jordan Viars hit his first two BlueClaws home runs this week - one on Tuesday and one on Friday...He now has 25 of Viars' career and 14 this year- he hit 12 with Clearwater before joining the BlueClaws on July 15th, three days before his 21st birthday... Viars hit three home runs in a May 30th win over Lakeland with Clearwater, adding nine RBIs...He was a 3rd round pick in 2021 from Rick Reedy High School (TX).

BlueClaws-a-Palooza...Sam Aldegheri, who began the year with the BlueClaws (6-5, 3.18 in 13 starts), made his big league debut with the Angels on August 30th, becoming the 124th player to go From the Shore to the Show...His first pitch was thrown to C Logan O'Hoppe (2021 BC), hit by JP Crawford (2013-14 BC) and caught by CF Mickey Moniak

Farquhar On Fire...Trent Farquhar has hit safely in 13 of his last 17 games, over which he is 21-73...Since joining the BlueClaws on July 20th, he has also drawn 17 walks and been hit by six pitches while adding 17 stolen bases...He had three hits on August 24th, his second three-hit game with the BlueClaws...Farquhar was hit by three pitches in his July 20th BlueClaws debut in Brooklyn, tying the team single-game record set last year by Nick Ward on 6/6 against Hudson Valley...Farquhar signed as a non-drafted free agent last year out of Michigan State.

King Felix of ShoreTown... Felix Reyes has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games, going 21-66 with three doubles and two home runs... Seven of his eight home runs this year

Welcome Back Bryan...SS Bryan Rincon was reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on Tuesday and is 4-22 with four walks...The Phillies #10 prospect (MLB Pipeline) had been out since May 19th with a hamstring injury...Rincon was a 14th round pick in 2022 from Shaler Area HS in Pennsylvania.

Ware It...Bryson Ware hit a solo home run on August 27th, his first as a BlueClaw, that broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning...He had two hits on Thursday and Saturday and is 25-70 since August 13th and hitting .305 since ioning the BlueClaws on August 1st...Ware has started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, and SS with the BlueClaws...With Clearwater, he started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and CF...Ware was an 8th round pick in 2023 out of Auburn

On Pan...Wen-Hui Pan has allowed just three ER In 21 innings with the BlueClaws this year, adding 22 strikeouts against just seven walks...Pan threw a scoreless inning on Sunday and another on Wednesday...He earned a save on August 17th against Winston-Salem at ShoreTown Ballpark...The 21 year old signed with the Phillies in January of 2023...He is the #20 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws have hit 33 HRs in Lakewood and 42 on the road this season...Hendry Mendez hit a game winning home run in the ninth inning on Friday at Aberdeen, his 3rd of the year...Aidan Miller hit his 6th BlueClaws home run on September 1st...Bryson Ware homered, his first with Jersey Shore, on Tuesday...Felix Reyes and Emaarion Boyd hit back to back home runs on August 24th in Brooklyn, the first pair of back to back home runs this season by the BlueClaws... Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda (now with Reading) and Schreffler each have eight.

The NEWClaws...The BlueClaws roster entering today has just eight players that have been with the team since Opening Day: Ps Jack Dallas, Charles King, Gunner Mayer, and Danny Wilkinson, IF Felix Reyes, and OFs Emaarion Boyd, Hendry Mendez, and Troy Schreffler.

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches nine times in a game this season – eight are BlueClaws...Mitch Neunborn threw 108 over 6.2 innings on August 16th...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading) earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has four while Jaydenn Estanista has three.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws erased a six-run deficit on August 20th at Brooklyn, trailing 8-2 and rallying to win 10-9 (their largest comeback win of the

season)...The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reyes on July 21st at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 18th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three

run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

**Just Missed Back to Back....The BlueClaws just missed qualifying for the playoffs for the second

grand slams since May 30th – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home

straight year...They have only done so once in team history, winning back to back titles in 2009 and 2010.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws had five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21th).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller was the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.
