JUMBO SHRIMP SHUT OUT 2-0 BY WOOSOX

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 2-0 on Wednesday by the Worcester Red Sox from VyStar Ballpark. The game's only runs came in the top of the first inning. when Marcelo Mayer cracked a two-run home run. That was the only mistake for Jumbo Shrimp starter Adam Mazur, who ceded those two runs on two hits in 5.0 innings, striking out four against one walk. Justin King tossed 2.0 scoreless of relief with three strikeouts. John Rooney pitched 1.2 shutout innings and Matt Pushard retired the only batter he saw in the effort.

'PEN PALS

Only Robinson Piña and Adam Mazur have gone 5.0 innings thus far for Jacksonville's starting rotation. Luckily for the Jumbo Shrimp, however, the club's bullpen has been excellent through the first five games of the season. Jacksonville relief pitching has combined for a 2.52 ERA. the fourth-best mark in the International League. The club's bullpen also ranks third in the circuit in batting average against (.176), tied for fourth in strikeouts (31) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (16). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 25.0 innings through five games, the fifthmost in the IL.

BOOM OR BUST

With no in-between thus far in 2025, Jacksonville's offense has either been extraordinary or has really struggled depending on the game. In two of their five contests thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated double-digit runs - something they accomplished only 10 times in 149 games last season. However, in their other three contests. Jacksonville has plated a total of three runs. On Wednesday, the Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 2-0 - the first time the club was blanked in a nine-inning game since August 30, 2024 against Norfolk.

MUSICAL CHAIRS

The 2024 season saw unprecedented player movement in Northeast Florida. Jacksonville set franchise records in their combined Triple-A/Double-A era (1962-present) with 90 players used, including a club record 51 pitchers. The Jumbo Shrimp also smashed another franchise record with 28 different starting pitchers used during the 2024 campaign.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base on Friday, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in three of their last four games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp's five stolen bases on Saturday at Nashville was a mark the club has reached only once in the prior two seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the International League with 11 stolen bases. The last time a Jacksonville squad ranked in the top 10 of the league in steals was 2008, when the Suns finished second in the 10team Southern League with 128 swipes. The Jumbo Shrimn finished 17th, 13th and last (20th) in steals from 2022-24 in each respective season.

CARP-F DIFM

The 2025 season will be David Carpenter's first piloting a team in MiLB. The 39-year-old spent the last two seasons at the helm of the West Virginia Black Bears in the MLB Draft League while also serving as the pitching coach at Division II Fairmont State University from 2021-24. With the Black Bears, he posted an 81-66 (.551) record, steering West Virginia to a league championship in 2023. Carpenter pitched in 222 MLB games over six seasons from 2011-15 and 2019 with the Astros. Blue Javs. Braves. Yankees. Nationals and Rangers. He registered a career 3.69 ERA in the big leagues. Carpenter's ties to the IL include a stint of eight games pitched with Gwinnett from 2013-14 and 39 games with Nashville, then a PCL club, in 2019.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo, The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season. De Los Santos smacked 11 of them. including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

ABOUT JANSON

-Junk was originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft out of Seattle University.

-Junk began his career at Seattle University as a walk-on. He worked with Redhawks pitching coach Elliott Cribby, and during his three years, had improved his fastball velocity by more than 10 miles per hour.

-The Yankees traded Junk and fellow right-handed pitcher Elvis Peguero to the Los Angeles Angels on July 30, 2021, in exchange for left-hander Andrew Heaney. Junk made his major league debut for the Angels on September 5, 2021 with a start against the Texas Rangers.

-Junk earned his first major league win on July 27, 2022, when he tossed $5.0\,$ scoreless innings in a start against the Kansas City Royals.

-On November 22, 2022, the Angels traded Junk, Peguero and left-handed pitcher Adam Seminaris to the Milwaukee Brewers for outfielder Hunter Renfroe.

-Junk remained in the Brewers' organization until he was claimed off waivers on August 2, 2024 by the Houston Astros. Twenty-nine days later, on August 29, Junk was claimed again, this time by the Oakland Athletics.

2024 SEASON

-Left-handed batters hit .285/.355/.504/.859 in 143 plate appearances against Junk, compared to a .291/.348/.412/.760 batting line for right-handed batters in 163 plate

-Twenty-one of Junk's 30 appearances came out of the bullpen (2-1, 4.35 ERA, 31.0 IP, 39 H, 14 BB, 33 K, .312 BAA). In nine starts, Junk was 1-4 with a 5.30 ERA (37.1 IP, 39 H, 11 BB, 29 K, .267 BAA).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Junk is from the same hometown (Federal Way, Wash.) as former Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-handed pitcher Jeff Brigham. The pair worked out together in the offseason leading to the 2025 season.
