OKLAHOMA CITY BASEBALL CLUB (14-9) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (6-17)

RHP Dinelson Lamet (1-1, 6.35) vs. RHP Tyler Danish (NR)

TODAY'S GAME: Oklahoma City holds a 2-0 series lead after beating the Isotopes 11-9 last night ... Albuquerque has lost at least three-straight for the third time in 2024 and dropped four of five ... Right-hander Tyler Danish is set to make his Isotopes debut while Oklahoma City is scheduled to send former Isotope Dinelson Lamet to the hill.

SWIPES: Albuquerque swiped a season-high five bags last night, giving them a stolen base in six-straight games, their second-longest streak of the year (long: seven, March 29 – April 5). They have stolen multiple bases four times during the stretch and 10 times on the year. The five stolen bases are the most since they swiped six Sept. 17, 2023, at El Paso.

VS. OKC: Albuquerque has dropped five-straight games to Oklahoma City for the first time since losing six in-a-row over two three-game series sweeps between 2018 and 2019.

XBH: The Isotopes allowed a season-high 10 extra-base hits last night (six doubles, one triple, three homers). It's the most since allowing 11 on Aug. 16, 2023, vs. El Paso ... Albuquerque's six doubles yielded yesterday tied a season-high (April 14 vs. Sugar Land).

DOUBLE-DIGIT RUNS: Albuquerque has relented double-digit runs in nine of 23 games this season.

DINGERS: The Isotopes allowed three homers last night, the fifth time in 2024 the club has yielded at least three clouts.

HITS: The Isotopes have surrendered double-digits hits in four-straight games, one off the season-high of five (April 10-14).

TIME OF GAME: Tonight's 3:32 time of game is the longest of the season and the sixth game over three hours in 2024. It's the ninth game over 3:30 since 2023.

REHAB: Walker Buehler made a rehab start for Oklahoma City yesterday and allowed five runs, three earned, over 4.0 innings on seven hits, two walks and two homers while fanning five. The seven hits allowed tied for the most surrendered by an opposing starter (twice, last: April 23 vs. Oklahoma City, Nabil Crismatt).

THREE-BAGGERS: Drew Romo tripled in the 5th inning Tuesday, the team's Triple-A-leading 13th three-bagger of the year. The club has a three-bagger in nine of 23 games.

BY WAY OF THE K: The Isotopes' 238 punchouts are third-most in Triple-A (most: Norfolk, 241) ... Albuquerque has struck out 10-plus times in 10 contests.

MR. VOLUNTEER: Jordan Beck tallied his second-straight threehit game to go along with his third contest with at least four RBI. It's the second time in his career he has recorded two-straight three-hit contests (also: June 4-6, High-A Spokane). He is 6-for-11 with a double and five RBI since a 0-for-13 slump.

BECK'S BARRELS: Has a 14.7 percent barrel rate (10 barrels/68 BBE) ... His 10 barrels are tied for 5th in all of Triple-A (most: 14, Hunter Goodman and Joey Loperfido).

TONY: Drew Romo extended his streak to 12 games (team lead) with a double. The 12-game streak is also tied for the third-longest active hit streak in Triple-A (longest active: 14 Nick Gonzales, Indianapolis). During the stretch, he is slashing .367/.380/.490 with four doubles, a triple and seven RBI. He has five multi-hit games during streak.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes mashed his second homer of the year yesterday (first: April 18 at El Paso). Also connected on a double, his first game in 2024 with multiple extra-base hits (last: Aug. 31, 2023, at Sacramento, double and homer). Has two-straight multi-hit games for the third time this year and is 5-for-9 during the stretch. Has an RBI in three-straight contests, second-longest streak of year (longest: four, March 29-April 3).

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron extended his hitting streak to 11 games (every game he's played in 2024) with a solo blast in the second inning off Buehler, second of the year. His 11-game streak is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in Triple-A. He has just one multi-hit game during the stretch (March 31 vs. El Paso, two hits, including a homer).

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk also extended his hit streak to 11 games with a single. During the stretch he is slashing .364/.431/.477 with five doubles and 11 RBI. Has four multi-hit contests during stretch.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard connected on his ninth multi-hit contest of the year and second-straight. He has a modest four-game hit streak (7x16) ... He is just one homer shy of tying Jordan Patterson's Isotopes team record for homers.

POUR ME A PINT: Riley Pint tied a career-high with six punchouts (six times, previous five were all starts). The last time he fanned six was July 15, 2017, with Low-A Asheville.

TRIPLE-A LEADERBOARD: **Jordan Beck** is 4th in RBI (25), T-5th in XBH (14), T-6th in total bases (52) ... and T-7th in runs (20), ... **Julio Carreras** is T-3rd in triples (3).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
