A Trip to the Capital

Reading continues a six-game series at Harrisburg with game five tonight. Reading holds the edge in the season series 6-4. The Fightin Phils need one mroe win this weekend to clinch both this week's series and the season-series over Harrisburg.

#### Looking Back

Late heorics led Reading to a 2-1 win over Harrisburg in 11 innings Friday night. Mitchell Parker was excellent, pitching eight-shutout inning for the Senators. Parker came back out for the ninth in a 1-0 game, but on the first pitch he threw Baron Radcliff launched a home run to right to tie it up. Cody Roberts drove in the go-ahead run in the 11th to give Reading the lead. Matt Osterberg was stellar, going 5.1 innings with eight strikeouts. The bullpen combined to pitch 5.2-shutout innings, while allowing just one hit and striking out eight hitters.

#### Max Do Well

Max McDowell is swinging a red-hot bat as of late, since his return from Triple-A Lehigh Valley on August 16. His three hits Thursday night matched a season high and he's now had a hit in six-straight games, which is a new season high for McDowell. Over his last five games, he's hitting .500 and .438 across his last ten. Against Harrisburg in 2023, McDowell is hitting .320, which included a walkoff homer on May 26.

#### Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's win last night was just the second time this season where Reading won a game when trailing after eight innings. Before last night, the R-Phils were 1-49 in such situations, with the other win actually coming against Harrisburg on May 26 in Reading. It also marked just the sixth time Reading's won this season when being outhit (prev. 5-35) and 14th win when scoring less than five runs (prev. 13-49).

#### **Playoffs?**

Reading remains in the playoff hunt, just 1.5 games back of a spot with 20 games to play. Since Somerset won the first half title, if the Patriots remain in first place, then the second place team in the Northeast Division will earn the final playoff spot. The two teams ahead of Reading are still on the schedule. Portland comes to Reading from Sept. 5-10 and Reading ends the season in Binghamtom from Sept. 12-17.

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies enjoyed a strong night with a 7-2 win over the Cardinals to open the series as Alec Bohm crushed a 444-foot home run in the win. Lehigh Valley fell 6-5 to Scranton last night Dustin Peterson hit two homers and Rafael Marchan doubled. Jersey Shore fell to Wilmington 8-3 as Cole Moore had three hits and Jared Carr tripled. Clearwater fell to Lakeland 6-2 first round pick Aidan Miller singled and walked. The DSL Phillies fell 5-2 to the DSL Angels in game two of a three-game quarterfinal series. The teams will now play a winner-take-all game three.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 26, 2013: At Reading, the Phils storm back from an early 6-1 deficit to beat Richmond, 7-6, in 10 innings. Maikel Franco, celebrating his 21st birthday, sends the game into extras with a 2-out, 2-run homer in the 9th. Kelly Dugan homers on the first pitch of the bottom of the 10th to end it.

#### Hey Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 23-26 record in the second half and 54-63 record overall. Last week, the Senators took just one-of-five from Richmond, while dropping the last-four games. Next week, Harrisburg will begin a 12-game road trip at Binghamton, then Altoona. Currently, 10 of Washington's top-30 prospects are on Harrisburg's roster: Dylan Crews (1), James Wood (2), Brady House (3), Robert Hassell (8), Trey Lipscomb (14), DJ Herz (16), Cole Henry (19), Israel Pineda (22), Mitchell Parker (26) and Jacob Young (30).

#### Senators Pitcher

Righty Michael Cuevas gets the start tonight for Harrisburg, the long right-handed starter Reading sees this week. He's 2-6 with a 5.51 ERA across 19 starts this season (80 IP, 88 H, 40 BB, 59 SO). Cuevas earned a win against Reading on May 24, pitching six innings, allowing three hits and two runs, with eight strikeouts. Last time out, Curvas went just one inning at Richmond in a loss, allowing five runs on four hits. He is 0-6 since May 30 and his last win came in that May 24 start at Reading. Cuevas spent all of 2022 with High-A Wilmington, going 6-12 with a 4.64 ERA over 26 games/24 starts. He spent 2021 with Single-A Fredericksburg and 2019 with the Rookie Nationals. Washington drafted him in the 23rd round of the 2019 draft out of Brennan High School in San Antonio, Texas.
