ORIMOLOYE HAS TWO HITS. RBI BUT FISHER CATS FALL: Demi Orimolove went 2-for-4. driving in a run, but the Fisher Cats fell to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies 8-4 on Sunday at Delta Dental Stadium. The teams split a six-game series. After the teams exchanged three first-inning runs, Binghamton went ahead in the second on an RBI single by Brett Baty for a 4-3 lead. The Ponies tacked on four in the fourth, chasing Fisher Cats starter Luis Quinones (L. 2-3). New Hampshire cut the lead to 8-4 in the fifth on a groundout by LJ Talley, but could not get any closer. After Quinones, the four New Hampshire relievers combined for 5.2 scoreless innings. Graham Spraker struck out the side on 11 pitches in the eighth and Sean Rackowski had a perfect ninth.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12<sup>th</sup> against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 31, 2017-In an 8-6 win at Reading, the Fisher Cats opened a big lead with four runs in the third and three in the fourth. Reese McGuire knocked in a pair of runs with a double, and Richard Urena and Emilio Guerrero each had a pair of hits, driving in a run apiece. Justin Shafer earned the win in relief and Dusty Isaacs struck out four over two hitless innings for his fourth save.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays opened a series at Rogers Centre with a 7-3 win over Baltimore. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. homered twice, driving in four runs. His 38 homers are tied for second most in the Majors, behind only Shohei Ohtani (42). The FCL Blue Jays won 15-7 over the Tigers. The Dominican Jays fell 3-2 to the White Sox on Monday.

TODAY: We start play today with the suspended second game from a July 4 doubleheader. The game is tied at 3-3 after three innings, and is scheduled for seven innings. Portland had won the first game of the doubleheader 9-4. Jeremy Beasley, who's been on the IL for two weeks, will take the mound for the Fisher Cats. He has worked in 26 games this season, including eight for the Blue Jays. Served as an opener in Harrisburg on August 11 in his Fisher Cats debut, allowing one run in two innings. Beasley joined the Jays organization April 22. Matthew Kent takes over on the mound for the Sea Dogs.

Maximo Castillo goes in the seven-inning nightcap. He's still tied with Akron's Juan Hillman for most wins among Double-A pitchers with 10. Dropped his first start of the homestand last Wednesday to Binghamton. Allowed six runs (five earned) in four innings. Castillo, who's 22, has made six starts against Portland (4-1).

Portand starter is .Chris Murphy, who's making his fifth start. 23-year old was selected by the Red Sox in the sixth round of the 2019 draft (San Diego). Hit for five runs in 4.2 innings last Tuesday against Reading, but struck out a career-high 11 in the loss. Made 14 starts for Adv. A Greenville, going 5-3 with a 4.21 ERA for the Drive. This is his first career start vs. Fisher Cats.
