TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are gear up for the first of their six-game set on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. Round Rock fell on Sunday afternoon to the Oklahoma City Comets at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Comets CF Alek Thomas drove in 2B Tommy Edman with an RBI single and Tibbs III scored on a sacrifice fly to give Oklahoma City an early two-run cushion. SS Hyeseong Kim singled and came around to score on an RBI by RF Zach Erhard in the second. The E-Train made it a one-run game in the fifth after a sacrifice fly by CF Cam Cauley. In the bottom of the frame, DH Ryan Fitzgerald added an RBI single and came around to score on a balk by LHP Thomas Ireland. In the seventh, RF Trevor Hauver launched a homer to make it a 5-3 game. A two-run RBI single by SS Hyeseong Kim grew the lead to five in the bottom of the seventh. The Express were held to one hit in the final two innings as they fell 7-3.

WHERE WE STAND

The Express secured their 4th series of the season with their win on Saturday night...are 2-0-1 in their last 3 series...4-6-1 in series play this season...are 10-20 at Dell Diamond...333 win percentage at home ranks 30th of 30 Triple-A clubs... have won 6 of 10, 9 of 15 and 11 of their last 20 G...are tied for 7th place (-11.0 G) and 9 G below .500 with 12 G remaining in the 1st half of the season... It marked their first six-game series win against Oklahoma City since August of 2022.

TURNING THE CORNER

Since May 19, the Express have scored 7.1 runs per game (127 runs/18 games) with an 11-7 record...previous 18 G (4/27 - 5/18), had scored 3.3 runs per game (61 runs) with a 4-14 record... Round Rock's first half elimination number is 2.

BRICKTOWN BRILLIANCE?

Express pitchers held the Comets to 25 runs and a .261 (52-199) average last week, the 2nd lowest rate in the PCL. The previous week against Sugar Land, OKC won 5 of 6 and hit .275 (57-207) with 44 runs (7.3 runs per game).

THE CRIM FILE

1B Blaine Crim became the Express leader in walks in the Triple-A era (since 2005) with his fifth-inning walk (192) on Friday... passed INF Justin Focue (2023-26) and OF Joey Butler (2011-2013) who were tied at 191... his single on Friday was the 400th hit of his Express career... now 4 hits away from passing Butler for 5th... 3 HR away from 3rd (INF Mark Saccomanno, 64)... 16 RBI away from first all-time (OF Jared Hoying, 272).

WELCOME, WILIAN

RHP Wilian Bormie was promoted to Round Rock on 6/9 to make his Triple-A debut with the Express...was named Rangers' Minor League Reliever of the Month for May after going 1-0 with 2 saves and a 2.70 ERA over 8 relief appearances...is in his 5th professional season after signing with Texas out of the Dominican Republic in 2019.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SATURDAY, JUNE 9, 1979

With 36,499 in attendance at Anaheim Stadium, 32-year-old Nolan Ryan tossed a complete game as the Angels beat the Detroit Tigers, 9-1. Ryan allowed his only run on a Jason Thompson RBI single in the fourth inning. He struck out 16 and walked just two to improve to 7-3 on the year.

"That's the sharpest I've ever seen him," said former President Richard Nixon, who was in attendance. Ryan was asked after the game about his performance. His response? "Adequate."

Carney Lansford led the Angels offense, going 4-for-5 with a double, a homer, three RBI and two runs scored as he finished a triple shy of the cycle. Willie Aikens went 3-for-4 with a homer, four RBI and a run scored.

Ryan had missed his previous start with a muscle pull. By the end of his career, he finished 17-7 against the Tigers, and his 2.36 ERA versus Detroit was lower than against any other team he faced. His second no-hitter also came against the Tigers on July 15, 1973.

"I love playing third when Nollie's pitching," Lansford said after the game. "You can just worry about hitting the ball and not defense."

MANAGER KYLE MOORE
The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.
A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI
Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.
His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN
Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.
Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ
Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.
The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON
Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.
He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI
Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.
A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

There had been only three starts this year where a PCL pitcher went 5.0 innings and struck out at least nine batters and Stephan tossed two of the three
- In 2025, set career highs in games (25) and innings (111.2), going 7-7, 4.67 ERA in 25 G/22 GS for Frisco (23 G) and Round Rock (2 G).
- Finished 2025 season with Round Rock, making his Triple-A debut against SUG on 9/13...threw 4.0 IP, allowing 2 earned runs and 3 hits while walking 2 and striking out 6.
- Attended South Grand Prairie (Tex.) H.S....was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University...played on the Rangers scout team at the Perfect Game WWBA Championships in Jupiter, Fla., in 2019.
