STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- Last Time Out: The Chiefs and Captains split a doubleheader on Saturday at Classic Park. Lake County took the opener 5-1 while Peoria evened things up with a 4-1 win in the nightcap. Jimmy Crooks homered in game one to provide the Chiefs offense. In game two, Peoria plated a pair in the top of the first and never looked back. Ian Bedell and Edwin Nunez limited Lake County to
- Rolling Along: Peoria's pitching staff has carried the load in the month of August. Entering play on Sunday, the Chiefs own a 2.45 ERA in August, the second lowest among full-season MiLB clubs. Peoria has posted four shutouts this month. Last week, the Chiefs turned in 25 consecutive scoreless frames against Beloit. Earlier this month, Peoria turned in 30-straight scoreless innings against Quad Cities.
- A Moore Milestone: In the nightcap, Brody Moore smashed his first professional homer, an opposite field shot, to extend the Chiefs lead. Prior to his long ball, Moore had gone 252 at-bats without a home run to begin his career. The versatile infielder has battled injuries in 2023 and spent a portion of the season on the 60-day IL.
- RISP-y Business: For the most part, the Chiefs have been quite reliable with runners in scoring position in 2023. As of late, however, the Peoria bats have struggled to deliver the timely hit. Over their last 11 games, the Chiefs are 15-for-97 (.155) with RISP.
- Double Digits: Jimmy Crooks extended his team lead with his 10th homer of the season in game one on Saturday. The ten homers are the most by a Peoria catcher since 2021 when Zade Richardson hit 12 for the Chiefs.
- Millsy: Zane Mills takes the ball in Sunday's finale and will try to get Peoria to their 60th win of the year. Mills earned his first win since June 20 with a victory over Beloit in his last outing. The right-hander has worked his way into the circle of trust over the last month. Over his last nine starts, Mills has a 3.86 ERA.
- Church of Nathan: Nathan Church continues to pace the Midwest League and all of High-A in hits (118). Church is in some rare air among recent Chiefs. His 118 knocks are the most in a single season since 2019 when former first-round pick Delvin Perez racked up 123 hits for Peoria. If Church continues on his 2023 pace, he'll accumulate the most hits in a single season since Magneuris Sierra's 161 back in 2016.
- Roadtrip Update: Peoria still has a chance to secure a .500 road trip with a win Sunday afternoon. Peoria was 8-4 on their first 12game roadie back in June.
- Cardinals History: Coach Christina Whitlock is blazing a trail in the game of baseball. Whitlock is the first uniformed femle coach in the history of the Cardinals organization. Whitlock coached softball for more than two decades and suited up for the U.S. Women's National Team as a player.
