FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: In a six-inning shortened contest, the Bradenton Marauders fell 5-2 to the Clearwater Threshers on Friday night at BayCare Ballpark, snapping their four-game winning streak. **Solomon Maguire** crushed a two-run home run in the third inning to put the Marauders ahead 2-1 before the Threshers scored four unanswered runs. The game went into a rain delay at start of the seventh inning before being ruled an official contest.

REHAB START: Pittsburgh Pirates No. 10 prospect **Mike Burrows** is scheduled to make his second rehab start with Bradenton on Saturday night in Clearwater. The first came back on Sunday at LECOM Park against the Lakeland Flying Tigers. The Waterford, CT native is coming off Tommy John Surgery last April after reaching Triple-A Indianapolis in 2022 and starting two games in 2023 before injury.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 30 home runs in 25 games, which is the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 18 of their last 20 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023. **The Marauders need four home runs in their next two games to tie the record.**

JAVVY'S MASHIN: In June, **Javier Rivas** is slashing .342/.402/.658 with five doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBIs, three walks, and 13 runs scored in 24 games. Rivas' six-game hitting streak came to an end on Thursday night. His seven home runs are also a new career-high with his six in June tied for the most in Single-A.

A PINCH-HIT SALAMI: **Axial Plaz's** pinch-hit grand slam in the eighth inning on Wednesday afternoon against Clearwater was the first ever in franchise history. It was also just the third pinch-hit home run in franchise history as well with the most recent occurring last season on a pinch-hit walk-off inside-the-park home run from Deivis Nadal last September against Palm Beach. Dan Grovatt hit the other in August of 2012 against Port Charlotte in a game that Jameson Taillon started for the Marauders.

THEY'RE FIGHTING: After a 4-22 record on the road to start the season, Bradenton won three of their last four games at TD Ballpark in Dunedin last week to force a series split. It was the first time this year that the Marauders have won back-to-back games on the road this year or shared a series split. Bradenton won their fifth-straight road game on Thursday for the first time since last June/July when Bradenton won seven-straight road games in Lakeland and Daytona.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, **RHP Khristian Curtis** entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30 on Tuesday night. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system.

IT'S ALWAYS SUNNY IN CLEARWATER: This week the Bradenton Marauders make their second and final visit to BayCare Ballpark this season. In their first trip, Bradenton dropped five of the six games with all six games in the series decided by eight runs. The Marauders have lost 10 of their last 12 games in Clearwater entering Tuesday and haven't won a series at BayCare Ballpark since they won four out of six from 9/6/22 - 9/11/22, the final series of the season.

LIFT OFF: After only hitting one home run in their first nine meetings against Clearwater, Bradenton has slugged 16 over their last 10 games against the Threshers. The only other home run against Clearwater hit by the Marauders came on April 26 at BayCare Ballpark when P.J. Hilson hit a two-out eighth inning go-ahead solo-home run in a 1-0 victory.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday's win against Clearwater marked the Marauders' 27th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 16-11 record in those games with 49 of their first 73 (67.1%) games having been decided by three runs or less. Only 12 of their last 22 games have been decided by three-runs or less.

PITCHES: In his first rehab start with the Marauders, Burrows retired the first five batters in order before issuing a pair of walks and then an RBI single to Daneurys De La Cruz. Peyton Stumbo entered and retired the last batter to leave two stranded.

2023 Highlights:

- Entered the season listed by Baseball America as being the ninth-best prospect in the Pirates' system...Made two starts for Triple-A Indianapolis, but left his start on 4/8 with a right forearm injury and was placed on the injured list on 4/11...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 4/26 and missed the remainder of the season...In total, posted a 2.70 ERA (6.2ip/2 er) with three strikeouts and .174 opponents average in his two outings prior to the injury.

2022 Highlights:

- Entered the season listed by Baseball America as having the "Best Curveball" in Pittsburgh's minor league system...Was also ranked by FanGraphs as Pittsburgh's 12th-best prospect...Was added to the Bucs' 40-man roster on 11/15...Split the season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis, combining to go 5-6 with a 4.01 ERA (94.1ip/42er) in 24 games (22 starts)...Went 4-2 with a 2.94 ERA (52.0ip/17er) and 69 strikeouts in 12 starts with Altoona before being promoted to Indianapolis on 6/16...Was selected to represent the National League in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game in Los Angeles on 7/16, tossing a scoreless fifth inning with a strikeout and a walk...Posted a 2.10 ERA (25.2 ip/6 er), 27 strikeouts and a .189 opponents average over a seven game (five start) span from 7/12-8/28 with Indianapolis...Was placed on the 7-Day Injured List from 8/30-9/28 with right shoulder inflammation.
