Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, begin a 12-game, 13-day road trip with the start of a six-game series with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and Timber Rattlers this season. Lansing is coming off a split at home with Peoria in the first meetings between the two clubs since 2019.

Sunday: Chiefs 7, Lugnuts 6. Peoria scored six runs in the fourth inning and held on to defeat Lansing, earning a six-game series split in front of a crowd of 6,342. In a scary moment in the fourth, Aaron McKeithan sent a line drive off the back of Lansing starter Mitch Myers' head, with Myers immediately being taken to Sparrow Hospital. He never lost consciousness and is currently recovering well at the hospital.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Chris Mehring on the call, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Timber Rattlers through Sunday, take a day off on June 26, and then continue this two-week road trip with a six-game series at Great Lakes. The next Lugnuts home game will be on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains.

Lug•Notes

What a Debut: 2018 Lugnuts infielder Samad Taylor made his Major League debut Saturday for the Kansas City Royals, becoming the 178th Nut all-time to reach the Majors and the fifth this year. (The previous four debuted with Oakland: Ryan Noda, 3/30; Hogan Harris, 4/14; Mason Miller, 4/19; and Garrett Acton, 5/14.) Taylor's first MLB hit was of the game-winning variety, a walk-off RBI single off the center field wall to send the Royals to a wild 10-9 victory over the Angels. Taylor finished the game 1-for-3 with two runs scored and two walks. Bobby Witt, Jr. rushed out to center field to get the ball for Samad.

Nail-Biters: Of the six games the Nuts played against Peoria, all but one – Saturday's 5-3 ten-inning win on a Brayan Buelvas walk-off homer –were decided by one run. 12 of the Nuts' last 17 games have been decided by one run; the Nuts are 6-6 in those games.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts turned another double play yesterday, giving them 15 double plays in their last eight games. Lansing leads the Midwest League with 59 double plays in 62 games. The Double-A Midland RockHounds, a level above the Lugnuts on the Oakland organizational ladder, have 62 double plays in 63 games, leading the Texas League.

Guante in Spanish, By the Way, Means Glove: Wander Guante, a pitcher with Single-A Stockton, a level below the Lugnuts, has tossed seven innings in each of his three June starts, firing seven two-hit scoreless innings on Sunday. Guante has allowed one run in 21 innings this month, allowing eight hits, walking seven and striking out 17. Lansing has already seen two Stockton starters, Jake Garland and Jose Dicochea, receive promotions to the Midwest League to replace promoted aces Blake Beers and Jack Perkins.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom**.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1996: José Amado changed dugouts, going from the Seattle Mariners-affiliated Wisconsin Timber Rattlers to the Kansas City Royals-affiliated Lansing Lugnuts, as the Mariners acquired Rusty Meacham from the Royals. Amado immediately became the Lugnuts' starting third baseman. He had slashed .289/.361/.409 with 13 doubles, five homers and 36 RBIs plus six steals in 11 attempts in 61 games with Wisconsin. In an identical 61 games for the Lugnuts, he slashed .342/.403/.509 with 25 doubles, one triple, four home runs and 45 RBIs, plus 10 steals in 12 attempts.

2015: A triple play! The Lugnuts clinched their first division title since 2012, beating the Great Lakes Loons, 8-2, on a Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. In the second inning, the Loons had Kelvin Ramos at second base and Alex Verdugo at first base with none out. Jimmy Allen sent a line drive to shortstop Richard Ureña, who dropped it – incorrectly allowed by the umpiring crew – then tagged out Ramos (one out), stepped on second to force out Verdugo (two outs) and threw to first to retire Allen (three outs).

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-el-vis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... nicknamed Elvis... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... has been clocked as hot as 98 mph this year; says that he has hit 100 mph once in his life, the first time his mother came in from the DR to watch him pitch in a professional game, in 2022 in the Florida State League... currently rated the No. 29 prospect in the Athletics' organization by MLB Pipeline; Fastball 55, Slider 50, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 40.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16 for \$33,000, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.


