#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**BUT HE GET'S ON BASE:** Marauders **UTIL Jesus Castillo** has reached base safely in each of the first 10 games of the season. He is the only Marauder and just one of two players in the Florida State League to do so, joining Geoge Lombard Jr (TAM). Dating back to last season, Castillo has reached base in 19 straight games. The 20-year-old is also t-1st in the FSL with six stolen bases.

WALK THIS WAY: Jesus Castillo's walk streak came to end at 11 games on Wednesday night in Lakeland. Castillo was one of just eight players in Minor League baseball last season to work 100 or more walks. The Marauders infielder is tied for first in the FSL with New York Yankees No. 7 prospect in George Lombard Jr who also has 15. The 15 walks are the third-most in all of MiLB and are the most among all Single-A, High-A, and Double-A players. (Triple-A started on March 29 compared to April 5 for the rest of the affiliates).

**DEFENSE! DEFENSE!:** Over the last three games, the Marauders defense has yet to commit an error and in fact have just two in their last six games. Their .983 fielding percentage as a team is the best in the FSL through 10 games.

**GOT EM!:** After Antwone Kelly picked off Brett Callahn on first base last Thursday, the Marauders tallied their fifth pickoff in just six games. As of Wednesday morning, the Marauders currently sit tied for second in all of MiLB, only trailing the Fredericksburg National (Single A, WAS) who own six. The Salt Lake Bees (Triple-A, LAA) also have five pickoffs as well.

**DEALING: LHP Yoldin De La Pa**z has been the rock out of the bullpen so far for the Marauders in 2024. The southpaw has punched out eight and has yet to allow in a run in first four outings, which spans 4.2 innings. Dating back to last season, De La Paz has now tossed seven straight scoreless outings which covers total 10.1 innings. He last allowed a run on Aug. 17, 2023 against Lakeland.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to Tuesday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the addition of **SS Andrés Alvarez** who will begin his Minor League rehab assignment with Single-A Bradenton. Alvarez was selected in the 22nd round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Pittsburgh and has played in Double-A Altoona the last two seasons. In 96 games last year, the 27-year-old hit .215/.285/.345 with 8 HR and 35 RBIs.

**ROSTER IS HERE!:** On April 6, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the break camp roster for the rest of their Minor League affiliates. The roster features six Top 30 prospects between Baseball America and MLB Pipeline. 10 players selected in the 2023 draft are featured on the roster which includes 3rd round pick **Garret Forrester**, 4th round pick **Carlson Reed**, and 6th round draft choice **Hunter Furtado**.

MARAUDERS IN THE SHOW: 25 former Bradenton players were represented on Opening Day rosters. In Pittsburgh, the list was headlined by 2019 Marauder infielder Oneil Cruz, Gold Glove Award-winning infielder Ke'Bryan Hayes, and 2023 All-Star pitcher Mitch Keller. Other notables include 6x All-Star and CY Young Award winner Gerrit Cole (NYY), RHP Tyler Glasnow (LAD), and Silver Slugger award winner Josh Bell (MIA).

Horner was the FCL Pirates manager last season and returns to Bradenton after serving as the Bench Coach on the 2021 Low-A Southeast Championship team. The Twins Falls, Idaho native joined the Pirates organization before the 2020 season after managing in the Seattle Mariners organization from 2005-2010, 2013-2015. A former Washington State catcher, Horner played nine seasons in the Minor Leagues and reached Triple-A Tacoma before retiring.
