### FRES-NOTES

**THURSDAY TRIUMPH:** The Fresno Grizzlies (7-3) conquered the Stockton Ports (3-7) 8-4 Thursday evening from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno moved to 5-0 wearing the gray jerseys and 6-0 when scoring first. In the top of the first, the Grizzlies growled ahead 4-0 after bringing 10 batters to the plate. Aidan Longwell led off the game with a single and raced home after a Braylen Wimmer RBI double split the left-center agp. Wimmer scored the second run on a wild pitch. Later in the frame, Fadriel Cruz and Tevin Tucker drew bases-loaded walks to extend the lead. Fresno expanded their advantage to 8-1 after another four-run inning in the third. A Tucker RBI groundout, two wild pitches and an Andy Perez RBI single were the scoring plays in the frame. Both Cruz and Longwell provided tremendous reads on their wild pitch runs. Cruz bolted home on a ball that barely squirted away and Longwell sprinted to the plate from second.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their sixgame series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the first of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the first set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 63-24 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 32-7 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

JACK OF ALL TRADES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #20 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney went to high school in Illinois where he was teammates with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

**GETTING INTO THE EARLY NUMBERS:** The Grizzlies' pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters in nine of their first 10 games this season (10, 5x, 11, 2x, 13 and 14). Overall, Fresno arms have fanned 104 total batters in 2024. The Grizzlies offense has walked 60 times over their last eight contests, giving them 73 base-on-balls this year (2nd in the California League, T-3rd in Single A).

**AN ACE IN JACE:** Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has started his 2024 campaign in the best way possible. Kaminska has not allowed a run over two starts (April 7-16), spanning eight and two-thirds innings. He has permitted six hits and one walk while fanning 10 batters (0.81 WHIP, .194 batting average against him).

KING OF THE (BRADY) HILL: Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill has appeared in four games, earning two saves out of the bullpen this season. In four shutout frames, he has allowed one hit and one walk while punching out seven.

**COLLIN IS BALLIN':** Grizzlies RHP Collin Baumgartner has appeared in four games out of the bullpen this season. Baumgartner is 1-0 with two holds and a 0.00 ERA. In five and two-thirds shutout frames, he has allowed one hit and one walk while punching out 10.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an impressive start to the season, going 8-for-27 (296 AVG/.545 OBP/.593 SLG/1.138 OPS) with one homer, one triple, three doubles, six RBI, 13 runs, 14 walks, two hit-by-pitches and two stolen bases. Snider's triple on April 7th (Sunday) in San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all 10 games to start this season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. Perez is 15-for-44 (.341 AVG/.383 OBP/.636 SLG/1.019 OPS) with two homers (one grand slam), two triples, three doubles, 14 RBI, seven runs and three walks. Perez's triple on April 17th (Wednesday) in Stockton was his ninth in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him four triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

**WIMMER IS A WINNER:** Grizzlies INF Braylen Wimmer has also had a spectacular start to the season, going 12-for-38 (.316 AVG/.458 OBP/.579 SLG/1.037 OPS) with a team-leading three homers, one double, seven RBI, 15 runs, nine walks and two stolen bases.

**EJ AND THE SB:** Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' OF EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 12 bases, one in 12 different games. Fresno is 12-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with all 12 games ending within five runs.
