HE GETS ON BASE: 1B Luke Adams extended his on-base streak to 19 consecutive games on LONGEST ON-BASE STREAKS IN '25 (SL) Thursday, the 2nd-longest streak in the Southern League this season... During the streak, 1. Homer Bush Jr. (MTG) Adams is hitting .323 (20-for-62) with 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 15 walks and a .494 on-base 3. Brock Wilken (BLX) percentage... Adams has drawn a walk in 17% of plate appearances during the streak... If 4. Luis Lara (BLX) Adams reaches bases today, he will set a new career-long streak.

NEED AN ASSIST? : Entering today, the Shuckers lead the Southern League and are 2nd in
Double-A with 13 outfield assists The Shuckers are 1 of 4 Double-A teams with at least 10
this season OF Luis Lara (5) and OF Garrett Spain (5) are both tied for the Double-A lead
and are tied for the 6th-most in Minor League Baseball The single-season franchise record
is 12. set by OF Josh Fellhauer in 2015.

IN THE STANDINGS: Entering today, the Shuckers have spent 14 days with a share of first place in the South Division... The Shuckers have spent 8 days in 2nd, 9 days in 3rd and 19 days in 4th... The Shuckers have gone from 5.0 games back in the division to 3.0 games ahead over the span of 21 days.

LUIS IS LUDICROUS: OF Luis Lara recorded his team-leading 12th multi-hit performance of the season on Saturday night... In May, Lara owns a .306 average (22-88) with 5 doubles, 13 walks and is 11-11 in stolen base attempts... Lara enters today with a .252 average, the 15th-highest among qualified Southern League hitters.

BECOMING A DEMON (DEACON): Entering today, 3B Brock Wilken owns a .286/.407/.686 slash line with a 1.093 OPS in May... Across 19 games in the month, Wilken has drawn a walk in 17% of plate appearances.

Sout of 53 qualified Southern League hitters in May, Wilken is among the league leaders in OPS (1st, 1.093), home runs (1st, 8), RBI (2nd, 17), and on-base percentage (4th, .407)... Wilken's .686 slugging percentage in May is 22 points higher than the Southern League OPS in 2025 (.664)

WARREN'S CHASING HISTORY: INF/OF Zavier Warren recorded his 35th career home run with the Shuckers on Saturday night... Warren enters today tied for the 2nd-most career home runs in franchise history (since 2015)... The franchise record is 36, set by INF Jake Gatewood between 2017-19... Warren is 1 of 5 players in franchise history to record at least 30 career home runs.

Over their last 35 games, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 191-120, a +71 run differential... Over that span, the Shuckers have averaged 5.5 per game... Their 191 runs over that span are the most in Double-A and 43 more than any other Southern League team... The Shuckers team OPS of .780 is 14 points higher than any other Double-A team over that span.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER // RHP K.C. HUNT (2-3, 5.28): Hunt makes his 8th start of the season and first since May 13 at Montgomery... Hunt's 10 days of rest between starts marks the longest he's gone between starts this season... In 3 home starts, Hunt owns a 3.94 ERA (7er, 16.0ip) with a .645 OPS... Won the 2021 Men's College World Series National Championship with the Mississippi State Bulldogs, the first national title for any sport in school history... Played at Keesler Federal Park with Mississippi State as part of the Hancock Whitney Classic in 2020, 2022 and 2023... Brother, Shooter, was an All-American, the 2008 Conference USA Pitcher of the Year and was selected in the first round of the 2008 Draft by the Minnesota Twins... Middle name is "Clemente", named after his father's favorite player, Roberto Clemente... Roommates with 2024 Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year, Craig Yoho, and 2024 Shucker Brett Wichrowski during 2024 Spring Training.

TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Brewers as an Undrafted Free Agent on July 20, 2023... Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 12th round of the 2022 Draft, elected to return to Mississippi State.
