NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 15 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 7 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have an 8-11 record over their last 19 games, having split 2 of their last 3 series, though the Chasers lost last week's series to Indianapolis.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 23 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 27 losses this year.
- 23 comeback wins are tied for the 5th-most in the International League, tied 8th in Triple-A ... 27 blown leads are tied 2nd-most in the league, tied 4th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 15 of their last 25 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 53 games (since May 9), Omaha is 23-30 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 16 of 23 wins and led at some point in 17 of 30 losses, meaning 33 of Omaha's last 53 games (62%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 35 of 53 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.
- Over his last 13 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .362/.418/.532 (17-for-47) with 9 RBI ... Tuesday, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).
 - Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .296 (32-for-108) with 8 home runs and 23 RBI in 28 games ... since his arrival, he is tied 3rd in the International League in runs scored (24), 5th in home runs, tied 5th in total bases (64), tied 7th in extra-base hits (16) and 9th in SLG (.593).

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .333 average (52-for-156) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.045) and 3rd in SLG (.647) and AVG ... his 41 RBI over 41 games since May 12 rank tied as the 4th-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 32 of 42 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.
 - Over his last 9 games (since June 27), Toro is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI, with a 1.322 OPS.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) with 3 XBH and 6 RBI, with 1 multi-hit game ... but in his last 42 games (since May 16), he's hitting .293 (43-for-147), with 13 XBH and 20 RBI, with 12 multi-hit games.

LOUISVILLE SLUGGING

- While the Bats hold the edge in the season series so far this year, a few Omaha hitters have been a thorn in the side of Louisville both this year and in previous seasons.
- Luca Tresh** is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with a 1.006 OPS and 10 RBI in 9 games against Louisville this year ... his 1.006 OPS ranks 7th among 40 hitters with at least 30 plate appearances against the Bats.
 - Louisville has also struggled pitching to **John Rave** ... over 25 career games at Louisville Slugger Field, Rave has 4 home runs, tied for his most of any visiting Triple-A park ... since 2024, his 12 homers, 26 RBI and 86 total bases against the Bats are the most of any opposing player vs. Louisville.
 - Drew Waters** is a career .359 hitter (23-for-64) at Louisville Slugger Field (since 2021), with 10 extra-base hits and 14 RBI for a 1.103 OPS across 16 games, his best road AVG, OBP (.447), SLG (.656) and OPS of any Triple-A venue he's played in.

ROAD WARRIORS

- A pair of bullpen arms have stepped it up when pitching away from Werner Park.
- Génesis Cabrera** has allowed just 2 earned runs in 6.0 road innings (3.00 ERA) for the Storm Chasers, compared to a 9.28 ERA (11 ER in 10.2 IP) at home.
 - Dan Altavilla** has a 4.20 ERA (7 ER in 15.0 IP) in 15 road appearances this year and an 8.72 ERA (21 ER in 21.2 IP) in 17 home games, between Omaha and St. Paul.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Ryan Ramsey is making his **14th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **17th overall appearance** of the season with Omaha.
- ✓ Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- ✓ Prior to his stint on the Injured List, Ramsey was tied 7th in the International League in innings (64.2) ... he leads Omaha's staff in innings (72.2) and strikeouts (64) but has also allowed the most hits (74).
- ✓ This is Ramsey's 2nd career start against the Bats and 3rd appearance against a Reds affiliate ... he pitched against the Bats earlier this year, firing 5.0 innings of 2-run ball on April 30 at Werner Park.

RAMSEY RUNDOWN

- ✓ **STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made 2 spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Chasers' 2026 Opening Day roster and is tied for the Storm Chasers' pitching staff team lead in starts (13), but has also made 3 bulk relief appearances throughout the season.
- ✓ **DOUBLE THE TROUBLE:** Ramsey has had 16 double plays turned behind him this season, the 2nd-most of any pitcher between the Majors and Minor Leagues (behind Tacoma's Casey Lawrence, 18) ... he's had 7 games without a double play turned behind him, but 4 games with 2+ double plays turned on the ground, including 3 double plays on April 5 vs. Buffalo, April 17 vs. Indianapolis and April 30 vs. Louisville.
- ✓ **RAMSEY TO THE RESCUE:** Omaha starters have earned just 6 wins this season (the fewest at the Triple-A level by 2) and Ramsey is responsible for 3 of those: his starts May 6 @ Indianapolis (PIT), May 24 @ St. Paul (MIN) and June 4 @ Columbus (CLE).

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, JULY 4 VS. INDIANAPOLIS

- ✓ Made his 3rd bulk relief appearance of the season for the Storm Chasers ... took over for Bailey Falter in the top of the 1st with one on and two outs, and induced an inning-ending groundout ... struck out 2 in a perfect 2nd ... worked around two baserunners in the 3rd ... allowed 4 runs and loaded the bases with two outs before exiting in the 4th ... Andrew Pérez allowed all 3 inherited runners to score.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance ... also worked 5.0 innings of 2-run relief on June 9 vs. Las Vegas (ATH).
- ✓ Fired his first quality start of the season on May 29 vs. Memphis (STL) ... opened the game with 6.0 scoreless innings and retired 11 straight hitters between the 3rd and 6th innings, but got a no-decision.
- ✓ Placed on Omaha's 7-day Injured List on June 19, activated on June 26.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- ✓ Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with Shane Panzini for the Royals organization lead.
- ✓ Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers Chazz Martinez, Ryan Brady & Brandon Johnson finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
- ✓ Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- ✓ Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and rotation ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- ✓ Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... set a Fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- ✓ Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- ✓ Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten ... in 2022, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- ✓ Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- ✓ Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
