OKC OFFENSE TAKES GAME FIVE

The Express fell by a final of 7-3 last night at Dell Diamond. In the fourth, Oklahoma City SS Alex Freeland singled then stole second. 1B Ryan Ward singled to and Freeland scored on an error. The Comets led 1-0. In the home half, LF Kellen Strahm singled and 3B Frainyer Chavez walked. The two advanced on a double steal. 2B Alex De Goti hit a sacrifice fly. CF Dustin Harris broke the tie with a single, sending Chavez around for a 2-1 Round Rock advantage. Oklahoma City's response came with six runs in the top of the fifth. 3B Kody Hoes doubled to score two. Hoes advanced to third on an error and came home on 2B Austin Gauthier's sacrifice fly. RF Esteury Ruiz drove in CF Justin Dean with a single. Freeland recorded an RBI single and Ward sent him around on a double moving the Comets lead to 7-2. In the seventh, Harris singled, stole second, then moved to third on a wild pitch. 1B Blaine Crim sent a sacrifice fly to center field and the Express scratched another run across, cutting the deficit to 7-3.

LET'S GO WITH GERSON

Express RHP Gerson Garabito is set for his sixth start of the year. In his five starts, he owns an 11.74 ERA (20 ER/15.1 IP) with 10 walks and 15 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .118 (2-17) in the first inning while they are hitting .449 (22-49) in the second through fourth frames. He owns a 12.8% walk rate compared to a 5.7% mark for the 2024 season with the Express.

SEARCHING FOR A SPLIT

Round Rock is looking to split the series with a win today. The Express are 0-6-1 in six game series against the Comets since the start of the 2023 season. This season, Oklahoma City has scored five runs or more in a single inning on five different occasions against Round Rock. The Comets own a .270/.356/.515/.871 slash line in 11 games against the E-Train.

CURVELO KEEPS ROLLING

RHP Luis Curvelo threw 1.1 innings without allowing a run or a hit on Saturday. Curvelo has given up just two runs in his last 11 outings (11.1 IP). He has struck out 13 batters and walked three in that span. He is 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER/16.2 IP) on the season.

CHAD ENTERS THE CHAT

C Chad Wallach has recorded a hit in five of his last six games. Wallach had just eight hits in his first 18 games. In this series, he is 6-for-16 with two RBI, two runs scored, two walks and four strikeouts.

HERE COMES J.O.

In his first 18 games with Round Rock, INF Jonathan Ornelas owned a .145 average (8-55). Since May 1, Ornelas is batting .268 (11-41) in 11 games. He did not have an extra-base hit in his first 24 games but has three in his last five games. In this series, he is 6-for-18 with three doubles, five walks and four strikeouts.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
