REDMOND'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS WAY, CARDS TOP SURGE:

Chandler Redmond set a Springfield Cardinals franchise mark with his 60th career home run on Friday night and the Cards scored twice in the bottom of the 8th inning in a 9-7 victory over the Wichita Wind Surge on Friday night at Hammons Field. **Redmond's** 3-run blast came in the bottom of the 5th inning and was one of 3 Springfield homers; **Nathan Church** hit a solo shot in the 2nd and **Jimmy Crooks** added a 2-run homer in the 3rd. **Crooks** and **Redmond** each had 3 hits for Springfield, who has won 9 of its last 11 games and 5 of 7 at home.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Cory Lewis** makes his 5th start of the season for the Wind Surge... Last pitched on Saturday, July 6 at Tulsa and tossed 4.0 scoreless innings allowing just 1 H with 4 K and 3 BB while throwing a season-high 61 pitches for the 3rd straight start...Was slated to break camp with Wichita but was placed on the IL April 6 with a right shoulder impingement...Made his season debut in the FCL on May 24...Made 2 rehab starts in the FCL and one in the Low-A Florida State League with Fort Myers...Split the 2023 season between Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids going a combined 9-4 with a 2.49 ERA...Named the Jim Rantz Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Twins last season... Pitched against the Peoria Chiefs in the first round of the postseason in the Midwest League last season and allowing just 1 R over 4.0 IP with 4 K...The Chiefs lost the game 9-1 with Ian Bedell taking the loss... Throws a knuckleball along with a fastball, curve, slider and changeup...Selected by the Twins in the 9th round of the 2022 draft out of UC Santa Barbara...In his final year with the Gauchos went 9-1 with an ERA of 3.57...23 years old

CARDS, SURGE SQUARE OFF FOR FINAL TIME AT HAMMONS FIELD: The Cardinals head into the All-Star break with a six-game series at home against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins), the final regular season meeting between the two in Springfield. The Cardinals swept a six-game series from Wichita in April at Hammons and come into the series 11-1 in the season series.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.
