PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Shuckers sit six games behind the Pensacola Blue Wahoos for first place in the Southern League South Division with seven games remaining in the first half... After the 69th game of the year, the division leaders in the North and South Division will both clinch playoff spots, securing half of the spots in the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... For Biloxi to win the South Division first half title, they would need to win their seven remaining games, and Pensacola would need to lose each of their remaining games.

**GRAND THEFT BASES:** With a stolen base on Saturday, the Biloxi Shuckers now have 118 stolen bases in 2023, the second-most out of any team in Double-A, and the most by any team in the Southern League... The Shuckers are one of four teams, along with the Portland Sea Dogs (126, BOS), Somerset Patriots (117, NYY) and the Arkansas Travelers (113, SEA) to swipe at least 100 in 2023... Biloxi is currently on pace for 262 stolen bases, two shy of the Birmingham Baron's Southern League record, 264, set in 1989.

BLX SINGLE-SEASON SB LEADERS THE RACE TO 52: With a stolen base in game one on Friday's doubleheader, INF Tyler Black tallied 36 stolen bases in 2023, one away from tying OF Corey Ray for the second most in a single-season by a Shuckers player... His 36 stolen bases lead the Southern League and Double-A, and he's the only player in Double-A with at least 30... Over 11 games in June, Black has 12 stolen bases, including at least one in eight games.

TYLER'S MASTERPIECE: After going 0-4 on Saturday night. INF Tyler Black's 35-game on-base streak came to an end... The on-base streak, which was the longest in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015), stretched back to April 29, 49 days ago... The on-base streak is the longest in Minor League Baseball this year, and is the longest by a Southern League player since at least 2020... Over that span, Black slashed .254/.421/.434 with 31 hits, 11 extra-base hits, 32 walks and 30 stolen bases.

RODRIGUEZ THE BAT: Entering today, OF Carlos Rodriguez is slashing .333/.438/.436 with four doubles and more walks (8) than strikeouts (3) in the month of June... In June, Rodriguez leads all Shuckers hitters with a .333 average and has tallied a hit in each of his last three games, going 4-8 with a double.

THOU SHALL NOT STEAL: C Jeferson Quero threw out two more baserunners on Saturday night, increasing his CS% to 35%, a Southern League-best... In 2023, Quero has thrown out 15 of 44 potential basestealers... As a team, the Shuckers have allowed 51 stolen bases, the third-lowest in Double-A and the lowest in the Southern League.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (4-3, 5.37): After a career-high 101 pitches on Tuesday, RHP Christian Mejias is set to make his 11th start of the year, and his fifth against Montgomery... Against the Biscuits, Mejias has struck out 31 battera in 19.2 innings, the most by any opposing pitcher in 2023... Right-handed hitters are also hitting .141 against Mejias this year, the second-lowest average in the Southern League and Minor League Baseball.
