#### Abstract

Shipping Up to Portland The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Portland Sea Dogs tonight. It is the eighth of 21 matchups between the teams this season, with Portland holding the 5-2 edge. Reading won the series in 2023 11-9 over Portland. Christian McGowan starts tonight for Reading, opposite Helcris Olivarez for Portland.

\section*{Put it in the Rearview}

Reading fell 9-3 to Portland on Tuesday night to open this week's series. Marcus Lee Sang was the lone bright spot for Reading with three hits, a double, two home runs and three RBI. Portland stole six bases, which is the most by an opponent this season and more than the five Reading allowed in a game three times last season. Reading also set a season-high six errors, which is the first time they committed that many errors in a game since July 9, 2016 against Bowie. Zach Haake also walked five hitters in 0.2 innings, which is the most walks issued by a Reading starter this season. In total, the R-Phils walked a season-high 11 batters. In the field, Robert Moore committed a career-high three errors at shortstop. Reading's 31 errors this season lead all of Double-A after last night.

\section*{Trifecta of Arms}

The Fightin Phils were able to lean on three of its most-consistent pitchers to finish out the game on Sunday against Somerset. Tristan Garnett (7th), Max Lazar (8th) and Tommy McCollum (9th) combined to allow no runs, zero hits and strike out five hitters over the games final three frames. That trio currently own a combined 1.02 ERA, with a $33 / 2$ strikeout to walk ratio over 26.1 innings and 20 games combined. McCollum and Lazar have also combined for six saves. Reading is $6 / 7$ in save oppurtunities this April, after going $3 / 6$ last season. Also the R-Phils have not blown any leads after the 6th, 7th or 8th innings in April.

As of Late Reading's win on Sunday gave the R-Phils their first series win of the season. The R-Phils first series win of the season in 2023 came one week later, the first week of May at Hartford. In total, Reading won seven series in 2023. The Fightin Phils ended up finishing April with a 10-12 record, which comes after going just 6-14 in the season's first month last season. The Fightin Phils posted a 6-6 home record in April, which compares to just a 4-7 home record in the first month of the 2023 season.

\section*{Marcus Mashing}

Marcus Lee Sang had his best game of the season on Tuesday night. Lee Sang went three-for-four, with two runs, a double, two homers and three RBI. It marked his third-career multi-homer game, and first in Double-A. It was also the third-time in his career Lee Sang had three extra-base hits. The last time he accomplished both of those feats was Aug. 6, 2022 with High-A Jersey Shore. It marked Reading's second multi-homer game this season, with the other coming Apr. 9 against Portland from Carson Taylor. Ironically, both of Reading's multi-homer games have come in the first game of a series against the Sea Dogs.

\section*{Schwecke's Week}

Trevor Schwecke had a strong week against Somerset capped off with a Sunday performance that saw him go two-for-four, with a double and two RBI. In total, Schwecke slashed $.357 / .375 / .500$, with an .875 OPS. He added a run, two doubles and three RBI. Sunday was hit first multi-hit/multi-RBI game of the season.

\section*{This Day in Baseballtown History}

May 1, 1912: At Bronx Oval in New York City, the outlaw United States League inaugurates its season as Reading and New York play to a 10-10 draw in 10 innings, after which the game is called on account of darkness. Reading scores three in the top of the 10th only to give them back in the bottom of the inning. Poor field conditions contribute to eight errors on the day, six by Reading.

\section*{Playing Portland}

Portland enters today with an 12-8 record and sits in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, the Sea Dogs went 2-4 at Hartford, incluing dropping the final three games of the series. After this week, Portland remains at home and welcomes Binghamton. Portland went 73-63 in 2023 and narrowly missed out on winning the division in the first half of last season. Portland's roster has nine of Boston's top-30 prospects on its roster, featuring: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Nick Yorke (6), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25) and Angel Bastardo (26). Blaze Jordan was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting . 444 (12-28), with four 2B, two HR and 8 RBI.

\section*{Portland Pitcher}

Lefty Helcris Olivarez gets the start tonight for Portland. Overall, he is $1-0$, with a 2.53 ERA. Olivarez has pitched 10.2 innings, allowed five hits, three runs, walked 15 and struck out 12 hitters. He last pitched on Thursday Apr. 25 at Hartford, earning his first win of the season. Olivarez tossed a season-best five innings, allowing just one hit, no runs, walking five and picking up six strikeouts. Olivarez faced Reading on Apr. 13, but lasted just 1.2 innings, as he walked five hitters and allowed a run in a no-decision. Olivarez did not pitch in 2023, and appeared in just one game for the ACL-Rockies in 2022 after sustaining a scapula strain in the back of his left shoulder in April of 2022. His last full season came in 2021 with High-A Spokane, in the Rockies organization. He elected free agency after the 2023 season and signed with the Red Sox. Colorado signed him as an international free agent in August of 2016 out of the DR.
