2024 GIRL SCOUT NIGHT HANDBOOK

We ask that Scouts, Troop Leaders and participants observe the following rules. It will make the event more enjoyable for everyone and will help keep the cost down in future years.

Do:

- Treat the field with care
- Bring sleeping bags, tents, etc. Wheeled wagons/coolers are allowed on the field.

• TENTS ARE ALLOWED!

Do Not:

- Use heating devices.
- Spray bug spray on the field. Please go in the seating area to apply.
- Bring anything flammable (lighters, candles, kerosene lanterns) onto the field.
- Bring pets of any kind, shape or size.
- Smoke or consume alcohol.
- **USE TENT STAKES!**

Rain Out Policies

If the game is cancelled, so is the campout. If the game is played, the sleepover would only be cancelled if the weather forecast calls for severe storms overnight. If the sleepover is cancelled, hold onto your game tickets. These tickets will be good for a sleepover make-up date to be named at a later time. There will be NO REFUNDS on game tickets.

Game Tickets

The Storm Chasers do not refund money on tickets purchased. Keep your tickets; they can be used as a rain check for most* future 2024 Storm Chasers regular season games. *Some exclusions apply

FAQs

What essentials do we need to bring?

The list should include a sleeping bag/pillow, tent, flash light, proper clothes to sleep in, light jacket/sweatshirt for after the game and any necessary toiletries.

Who receives campout patches?

Everyone (adult or child) who purchases the Premium Package.

Is the campout available to family members?

Yes, the sleepover is for Scouts and leaders, mothers, fathers, and siblings of Scouts.

Will there be adequate supervision?

Yes! Any troops that plan on staying the night are REQUIRED to have adequate chaperoning by their troop leader(s). Follow Scouts Scout:Adult ratios. There will be at least 2 Chasers employees and 1 security officer on hand to assist throughout the sleepover and in the morning. If you need help, you can find a security or first-aid employee, or call 402-709-4669, the cell phone of Landon Caldwell.

What is the itinerary for the event?

Pre-game: A designated pick-up table will be located near Gate 2 on the sidewalk before the game starting at 5:15pm. This is where you will go to check-in and get your Troop's patches, wristbands, coupons, fun zone passes, and gift cards (if applicable.) This is also where you will need to turn in your signed waivers for those camping out on the field after the game (if applicable) if you have not already sent them in. Gates to the ballpark will open at 6:00 pm. The pre-game parade will begin at approximately 6:35 pm. Scouts should meet to the right of the Hy-Vee Pavillion in right field at 6:15 pm. **Sleepover:** Following the game, all Scouts (this includes ones sleeping over) will be required to leave the ballpark to gather their camping equipment. Once the field is cleared and prepared for a safe sleepover, Scouts will be allowed to bring their sleeping bags and tents onto the field for the night. Scouts will get their sites ready immediately after re-entering. Snacks can be picked up immediately after gates re-open in the designated area inside Gate 2. The movie will begin approximately 30-40 minutes after gates re-open. All lights except for emergency flood lights will be turned off when the movie begins. **Next Morning:** The following morning all campers will clean up their sites. Wake up call will be at 7:00 am*. Camping gear needs to be removed from the field and all Scouts should be out of Werner Park by 8:00 am*. **Morning Clean Up:** All Scouts are REQUIRED to assist in field clean-up on Saturday morning. We will walk the field looking to pick up all debris left from the sleepover. By cleaning up after yourselves, you will help in keeping the cost down in future years. *Subject to change

How do I get my campout snacks?

A designated area just inside Gate 2 will be the location to pick up your snacks and drinks upon Gate 2 re-opening after the game. Only those who purchase the Premium Package will be given patches and campout snacks.

Where do the Scouts store their camping gear?

Scouts will need to keep their gear in their chaperone/Troop Leader's vehicle during the game. All vehicles must be parked in Lot F2 or the North Lot marked on the map.

How/when/where should we transport our camping gear onto the field?

How? Wagons are allowed to assist with bringing your sleeping gear onto the field. **TENTS are allowed (no stakes)**; tarps must be on the inside of tents, not on the grass. **When?** Approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the game is when you will bring your gear onto the field. Enter back into Werner Park through Gate 2. **Where?** There are two locations to enter on the field. If you do not have items on wheels you can enter through the field access gate between sections 120 and 121. If you have items on wheels you **MUST** enter via the ramp beneath the Autograph Bridge, between Section 125 and the Home Run Porch.

How do we get into the campout?

Everyone will reenter through Gate 2 next to lot F2 or the North Lot after the game is over (and you have gotten your gear from your vehicles). Lot F2 is on the west side of Werner Park and the North Lot is north of the park. A Storm Chasers staff member will check all wristbands to ensure you are allowed back into the venue for the sleepover.

If we have someone in a wheelchair, can we get them on the field to spend the night?

Yes, you can. Please call (402) 738-5112 to make special arrangements.

Will there be concession stands open during the sleepover?

No. You can purchase concessions during the game if you did not bring your own for the sleepover. Feel free to bring in snacks, water, soda and/or Gatorade for after the game for the sleepover; however, **no outside food or drinks will be permitted in to the stadium at any time during the game (facility rule). No Soda/Gatorade will be permitted on the field and must be drank in the seating bowl or concourse.**

What other activities can we do on the field during the sleepover?

Frisbees, baseball gloves, and other entertainment may be brought in. However, please respect other campers by not disturbing their "campsite" since there are other people sleeping out on the field.

Will there be restrooms open during the campout?

Yes, the restrooms on the third base side of the main concourse will remain open for the entire night.

How do I get to the Home of the Storm Chasers?

From Omaha: Take I-80 west to the Hwy 370 exit. Take a left (east) on Hwy 370. Werner Park will be on your left.

From Lincoln: Take I-80 east to the Hwy 370 exit. Take a right (east) on Hwy 370. Werner Park will be on your left.

From Bellevue: Take Hwy 370 west. Werner Park will be on your right. Access to Werner Park parking will be from 120th Street & 126th Street.
