EARLY SCORING HOLDS UP AS CATS TAKE SERIES SPLIT: The Fisher Cats scored thrice in the first inning and rode that lead to a 3-1 victory over Reading Sunday, as Maximo Castillo (W, 7-2) delivered a quality start, his first of the year. LJ Talley, Jordan Groshans, and Samad Taylor provided the run-scoring knocks in the first inning. Sean Rackoski and Brody Rodning both picked up holds, as Jon Harris worked a 1-2-3 ninth for his second save of the season. Austin Martin reached base three times and Jordan Groshans doubled twice in the winning effort.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats meet the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox) for the fifth of six series on the season. The last series between these teams resulted in only four games being completed, with a projected eight-game series being played in the final meeting of these teams in early September. The Fisher Cats will return to Delta Dental Stadium for a six-game set against the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) next week. The last time the Fisher Cats played at Hadlock Field, they took the final four games of the series. The Sea Dogs have won 17 of the last 18 and lead Akron by 2 games, and Somerset by 2-1/2 in the playoff race.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: July 28, 2008—In the completion of a suspended game from June 22, the Fisher Cats beat Portland 7-5 in Manchester.. New Hampshire then won the regularly scheduled game 5-1. J.P. Arencebia (aaron-SEE-bee-uh) homered to break the 5-5 tie in the bottom of the eighth of the first game. Kyle Phillips homered in the first inning of the nightcap as the Fisher Cats cruised to the win. Interesting notes on this one- Andrew Pinckney started at third for Portland in Game 1- and for New Hampshire in Game 2 (he was signed by Blue Jays after Red Sox release in between). Also, Kyle Jackson of Hudson, N.H. started both games for the Sea Dogs. He's currently the manager of the Nashua Silver Knights of the Futures Collegiate Baseball League.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays and Red Sox play a doubleheader today at Fenway (2:10 and 7:10). Buffalo was rained out at Worcester. They play a single game at 12:10 today- and a twinbill tomorrow. Vanouwer lost 8-6 at Spokane. Will McAffer was tagged with loss. C Philip Clarke (Vandy) homered and tripled...Dunedin over Bradenton 11-6.

STARTERS:

Reilly Hovis will make his first start at Hadlock Field this season. Hovis' only appearance against the Sea Dogs came in the suspended game on July 4th. Hovis throws a fastball, a slider, and a changeup, and has recently altered his throwing motion to incorporate a more sidearm approach. Hovis' last outing was on July 21st against Reading, where he pitched four and two thirds innings, giving up two runs on three hits. The Fisher Cats are 2-2 in games which Hovis starts. Hovis, a Gastonia, NC native, pitched for his native UNC before being drafted by the Marlins, making it as far as Double-A Jacksonville before winding up pitching for the Gastonia Honey Hunters. Game 2 will be a bullpen game.

For Portland, Frank German will make his fifth start of the year against the Fisher Cats and his 13th start overall (14 appearances) including the July 4 suspended game. Has allowed 12 ER in 13.1 IP against NH (8.10 ERA). On the year, German has a record of 3-4 with a 4.83 ERA and is coming off of a no-decision against Harrisburg in which he went five innings without allowing a run...Brayan Bello made his Double-A debut against NH June 12 at Hadlock (4 IP, 1 ER). Also faced NH July 1 (4.2 IP, 2 ER). Is 0-0, 4.63 ERA in seven starts including a no decision last Friday when he worked one inning against Harrisburg. He was lifted a rain delay.

The Blue Jays signed Barbato, a former Major League reliever, on June 3 and he immediately moved into a starting role with the Fisher Cats.

Last Thursday against Reading, Barbato allowed five runs on eight hits in 4.2 IP (97 pitches), leaving with New Hampshire down 5-2. New Hampshire would rally for a 7-6 win.

The Miami, FL native was selected in the 6th round of the 2010 draft by the San Diego Padres. He appeared in 44 MLB games with the Yankees, Pirates, and Tigers between 2016-18.
