Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds suffered their second consecutive shutout loss to the Fredericksburg Nationals on Thursday, 9-0. The Fred Nats took advantage of three first-innings walks and turned them into three runs on a two-run single by **Juan Cruz** and a fielder's choice off the bat of **Kevin Made**, making it 3-0. A sacrifice fly from Cruz in the fourth, plus an error on a dropped fly ball in the fifth, allowed Fredericksburg to extend their lead to 5-0. The Fred Nats put two more runs on the board in each of the seventh and eighth innings to take a 9-0 advantage, and that proved plenty for their pitching staff, which threw their second consecutive shutout, allowing only three hits to the Shorebirds' offense. They've held Delmarva scoreless for 25 consecutive innings and handed them a seventh straight loss overall.

Lo Re Joins Frederick: Jaiden Lo Re's incredible run with Delmarva has resulted in his promotion to High-A Frederick. In 56 games, Lo Re had 66 hits and is batting .325, with a team-best 22 multi-hit games. He was a regular on base, with a .439 OBP, thanks to 41 walks compared to 22 strikeouts over 247 plate appearances. Since the point he joined the Shorebirds on June 2, the No. 19 prospect for the Orioles led the Carolina in batting average (.325), highlighted by a 13-game hitting streak and a 19-game on-base streak that was snapped last week against Hickory.

Jhomnardo Heating Up: The recently acquired Jhomnardo Reyes has found his groove at the plate. He's reached base in 10 of his past 11 games and has a hit in 9 of his last 11, including a stretch of three consecutive multi-hit games. Since the start of this run on August 13, Reyes is 12-for-41 (.293) with five walks.

Turning Heads: The Orioles' second-round pick, Ty Head, has gotten off to a hot start since joining Delmarva. In 12 games with the Shorebirds, Head has hit two home runs and is 16-for-46 (.348) with six RBIs and ten runs scored. He has also been active on the base paths, with five stolen bases.

Leave it to Stiven: Delmarva's best power bat, Stiven Martinez, is ending his season on a positive note, hitting two home runs this past week against the Hickory. He continues to pace the Shorebirds with 13 homers this season, a career-high. He has hit four in August, which is turning into his best month statistically. He's hitting .296 in August with 18 RBIs and 7 extra-base hits, while walking 14 times to give him an on-base percentage of .425 and an OPS of .974.

Welcome the Class of 2026: The Shorebirds have added three players from the Baltimore Orioles' 2026 draft class. The additions include OF **Eric Booth Jr.**, OF **Ty Head**, and SS **Jimmy Anderson**. Booth Jr. was the No. 7 overall pick in the draft and the highest-selected player by the Orioles since they picked **Jackson Holliday** No. 1 overall in 2022. Ty Head was the best center fielder in college baseball last season and won a Gold Glove at the position. Jimmy Anderson was originally selected by Baltimore in the 19th round of 2025 but returned to school at Heartland Community College in Illinois, where he was picked again in 2026 in the 5th round. Delmarva also recently added 9th-round pick RHP **Collin McKinney**, 10th-round UTL **Carlos Sanchez**, and 15th-round pick RHP **Braden Smith**.

About the Nationals: The Shorebirds welcome the Fredericksburg Nationals to Perdue Stadium for the final homestand of the regular season. The Fred Nats have won five of six games against the Shorebirds in each of the prior three series. They're led by a high-powered offense that leads the league in runs scored and home runs. Fredericksburg hit 13 home runs in the last six-game series versus Delmarva three weeks ago.
