Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and the Charlotte Knights play game three of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The two clubs have split the first two games of the set with Nashville winning game one on Tuesday and Charlotte getting game two last night. Tonight, left-hander Ethan Small starts for the Sounds against right-hander Mike Wright for the Knights.

Ethan Small: 24-year-old Ethan Small makes his Triple-A debut tonight. The left-hander was recently promoted from Double-A Biloxi where he went 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in 8 starts. In 41.1 innings with the Schuckers, Small allowed 10 runs on 26 hits and racked up 67 strikeouts. He held Double-A hitters to a .184 batting average. Small earned Double-A South Pitcher of the Week in early June. The Spring Hill, Tennessee resident was drafted by the Brewers in the 1st round (28th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University where he garnered multiple national accolades as a junior.

Mike Wright: 31-year-old Mike Wright starts for the Charlotte Knights tonight. The right-hander is making his eighth start for Charlotte and his second against Nashville. He worked 7.0 shutout innings on June 4 vs. Nashville and gave up just two hits and struck out eight. He has been the winning pitcher in his last four starts. In 2020, the right-hander pitched for the NC Dinos of the Korean Baseball Organization, he helped guide them to their first KBO Championship. Wright was selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 11, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Sounds vs. Wright: The Sounds faced Mike Wright at Truist Field on June 4. He was dominant as he pitched 7.0 scoreless innings and struck out eight in a 1-0 loss for Nashville. Current Sounds who have faced Wright include: Jamie Westbrook 0-3, Zach Green 0-2, HBP, K, Weston Wilson 1-2, 2B, K, Tim Lopes 0-2, K, Luke Maile 1-2, K and Cooper Hummel 0-2.

Birthday Boys: There's a pair of birthday boys in the Nashville lineup tonight. Tim Lopes turns 27 years old today and will hit second. Payton Henry turns 24 years old today and is making his Triple-A debut in the six-spot tonight.

Back-to-Back Blasts: Tim Lopes and Jamie Westbrook hit back-to-back home runs in the 13-6 loss last night. It marked the second time the pair have gone back-to-back this season (last - 6/9 vs. Indianapolis) and the third time Nashville has gone back-to-back.

Reyes Rolls On: Nashville infielder Pablo Reyes has hit safely in all seven games he has played in with the Sounds, including five multi-hit efforts. In the seven games, he is batting .464 (13-for-28) with 12 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 7 walks.

Westbrook Finds A Way: Infielder/outfielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in 13 consecutive games. During the streak he is batting a Triple-A East League-best .434 (23-for-53) with 10 runs, 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 14 RBI and 4 walks. His on-base percentage during the 13 games is .475.

Henry Is Here: Milwaukee promoted catcher Payton Henry yesterday, up from Double-A Biloxi. Henry entered the 2021 season as Milwaukee's 19-best prospect according to MLB Pipeline. The catcher turns 24 today and was hitting .315 (35-for-111) with 11 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 10 RBI and 12 walks in 30 games with the Schuckers.

Another Streak for Pérez: Pérez has hit safely in seven straight games for the second time this season. He is batting .406 (13-for-32) with 2 doubles and 5 RBI during the streak. He has also recorded four consecutive multi-hit games. Pérez is one of four Sounds to have two hit streaks of at least five games (Zach Green, Corey Ray and Dustin Peterson).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,054-1,936. The 2,054 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The last time Nashville played on June 24 was in 2019 when they picked up a 6-5 win in New Orleans. Shortstop Eli White went 3-for-5 with a homer, one of four Sounds with a home run (White, Zack Granite, Matt Davidson, Patrick Wisdom).
