YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels scored six straight runs to come from behind and beat the Altoona Curve, 6-3. Altoona opened a 2-0 lead in the fifth with an RBI ground-rule double by Josh Bissonette and a sac fly by Matt Fraizer. The Curve extended the lead to 3-0 in the sixth with an RBI single by Connor Kaiser. In the seventh, the Flying Squirrels scored their first run after a throwing error by Ji-Hwan Bae. In the eighth, **Sandro Fabian** brought Richmond within a run with an RBI double and **David Villar** followed with a two-run homer, his 17th of the season, to put the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-3. Fabian brought in two insurance runs with a single in the top of the ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Flying Squirrels are 26-32 against teams from the Southwest Division and 12-16 in road games against division opponents. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 1-6, with the Curve winning four games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 13-19 since July 21 but have won seven of the last 10 games since August 18. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 10.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.94 ERA for the season.

THE CURVE have lost four of the last six games. They split last week's six-game series against the Patriots. The Altoona offense is ranked fifth in the league with a .250 batting average and the pitching staff is eighth with a 4.63 ERA. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including SS Oneil Cruz (No. 3), RHP Roansy Contreras (No. 6 - on IL), 1B Mason Martin (No. 17), OF Matt Frazier (No. 23), OF Canaan Smith-Njigba (No. 28 - on IL), RHP Cody Bolton (No. 29 - on IL) and OF Jack Suwinski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his seventh start for the Flying Squirrels and his first against the Curve. Last time out, he allowed two runs over five innings in a no-decision against Erie at The Diamond last Sunday. Blair has thrown five innings in each of his last three starts. Blair has gone 0-2 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER/21.0 IP) over his last five starts since July 30. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. *For more on Blair, see page two.*

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Travis MacGregor makes his 19th appearance and 18th start of the season. On Sunday, he faced the Somerset Patriots at PNG Field and allowed four runs in 2.1 innings. Over his last three starts since August 12, MacGregor has gone 0-3 with a 15.58 ERA (15 ER/8.2 IP). He faced the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond on June 2 and picked up his first win of the season after allowing two runs on one hit, a two-run homer by Ryan Howard, over five innings. MacGregor was drafted in the second round (68th overall) by the Pirates in 2016 out of East Lake High School in Tarpon Springs, Fla. He reached as high as the Low-A level in 2018 but had Tommy John surgery at the end of the year, forcing him to miss the entire 2019 season.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 28 homers in the last 15 games since August 10, which is tied for the second-most in the Double-A Northeast. In that stretch, **David Villar** has six homers, **Diego Rincones** has five home runs, **Sandro Fabian** has four, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andres Angulo** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Frankie Tostado**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered in that span. The Flying Squirrels hit 15 homers during a six-game set at Bowie from August 10-15 and added 10 homers during last week's six-game series at The Diamond against the SeaWolves. They added two homers in Tuesday's series opener at Altoona.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth in the Double-A Northeast with 111 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 133 home runs this season in 120 games. On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .398 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 53 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: In his last 15 games since August 10, **David Villar** is batting .370 (20-for-54) with six homers, seven doubles and 11 RBIs. He now leads the team with 17 home runs this season, which is also tied for the third-most in a season in franchise history and is one homer shy of matching the single-season franchise record (18 - **Jarrett Parker** in 2013 and **Mario Lison** in 2014). On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. He finished that series with three home runs, he homered in each of the last two games of last week's series against Erie at The Diamond and he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer on Friday night at Altoona.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 15 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .317 (19-for-60) with four homers and 20 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 16 RBIs over the last 11 games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in five of those contests.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 32 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .322 (39-for-121) with nine homers, seven doubles, one triple and 26 RBIs. Over his last 22 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .349 (30-for-86) with five homers, six doubles and 15 RBIs. He added a walk-off single last Friday night to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. Rincones homered on Saturday night and hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh in the series finale against the SeaWolves on Sunday night. He went deep for the third straight game on Tuesday at Altoona.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 28 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 108 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **David Villar** is tied for eighth with 17 homers, eighth with a .367 OBP, tied for sixth with 91 hits, ninth with 23 doubles, tied for seventh with 41 walks, tied for sixth with 40 extra-base hits, sixth with 165 total bases and tied for eighth with 59 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for seventh with 16 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked eighth with a 5.10 ERA and ninth with 82 strikeouts. **Joey Marciano** (34/3rd), **Patrick Ruotolo** (34/3rd), **Matt Seelinger** (32/6th), **Frank Rubio** (31/T-7th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (31/T-7th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fourth with nine saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for 10th with six.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (14 - on IL), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (15) and Beck (29), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
