LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 5-0, for their 2nd shutout of the season in a 1-hitter on Friday night...LHP **Zach Thornton** tossed 6.0 innings of 1-hit shut-out ball...The 23-year-old did not walk a batter, struck out a career-high-tying 8, and faced the minimum 18 batters...RHP **Anthony Nunez** yielded only a walk in his 2.0 frames of relief, earning the hold...RHP **Saúl García** permitted a free pass to begin the 9th, but struck out the next 3 hitters to secure the victory...Brooklyn pitchers faced only two batters over the minimum for the game...3B **Jacob Reimer** tallied a pair of hits, including a solo home run in the 1st and a triple in the 7th...RF **D'Andre Smith** added 2 hits and reached base 3 times with a walk...C **Ronald Hernández** was on base 4 times with 3 free passes and a RBI double...Hernández and LF **Chris Suero** each swiped a pair of bases.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On April 19, 2010, 1B **Ike Davis**, who made his professional debut with the Cyclones in 2008, made his Major League debut with the New York Mets...He goes 2-for-4, picking up his first hit in his first at-bat with a single off RHP **Randy Wells**...Davis later adds an RBI single off LHP **Sean Marshall** in the Mets' 6-1 win over the Chicago Cubs.

BACK IN BLACK-BURN: RHP **Paul Blackburn** joins the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment and is scheduled to start Saturday evening's contest in Aberdeen...New York Mets manager **Carlos Mendoza** stated Thursday that Blackburn is slated to throw 2 innings...The 31-year-old was placed on the Mets' 15-day injured list on March 27 (retro March 24) with right knee inflammation...Blackburn was acquired by New York from the Oakland Athletics on July 30, 2024, in exchange for RHP **Kade Morris**...Morris was a member of Brooklyn's rotation at the time of the trade...Blackburn was named an American League All-Star with the A's in 2022...In 86 MLB appearances (82 starts) with the A's and Mets, the California native has tallied a 22-28 record with a 4.85 ERA (231 ER in 428.1 IP), 17.8% strikeout rate, and a 7.1% walk rate...Saturday's originally scheduled starter, RHP **R.J. Gordon**, is expected to follow Blackburn in relief.

A THORN-TON IN THEIR SIDE: LHP **Zach Thornton** has been utterly dominant to start 2025...The Lawrence, Kan. native posted a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball, striking out a career-high-matching 8, while facing the minimum...Thornton is 1 of only 2 arms at the High-A level to toss 15.0 or more innings without allowing an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg**)...Thornton is the only arm not to allow a run at all...He is also 1 of 2 arms to not allow a run over 15.0+ frames across all of Minor League Baseball in 2025 (Double-A Corpus Christi RHP **José Fleury**)...Entering play on Saturday, the 23-year-old is 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in WHIP (0.44) and 7th in batting average against (.098)...Among South Atlantic League arms, Thornton leads the circuit in wins (3), strikeouts (22), and WHIP (0.44)...He also sits tied for 2nd in innings pitched (16.0) and 3rd in batting average against (.098)...Since 2005, Thornton's 44-to-4 strike-out-to-walk ratio (11.0) is the best in Cyclones' history among pitchers with 40.0 or more innings of work (43.0)...RHP **Benito García's** 9.50 ratio (38-to-4 in 42.2 IP) is 2nd...His WHIP (0.91) is 6th...Trailing only LHP **John Mincone** (0.71), García (0.75), RHP **Hansel Robles** (0.78), RHP **Marcos Molina** (0.84), and RHP **Dylan Owen** (0.87).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: The Cyclones' pitching staff tossed its 2nd shutout of the season on Friday night, blanking Aberdeen on the road, 5-0...Brooklyn's first shutout of the season came back on April 6 in a 4-0 win vs. Wilmington...In 2024, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 14 shutouts...Since Aberdeen scored 3 runs in the bottom of the 3rd inning on Thursday, Brooklyn's pitching has tossed 151 consecutive scoreless innings...In those 151 frames, Cyclones' pitching has allowed only 1 hit and 7 walks...Brooklyn's staff has struck out 18 of 46 batters in that stretch, good for a 39.13% strike-out rate.

WHAT A RELIEF! Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, Cyclones relievers have a 5-2 record with a 3.54 ERA (22 ER in 56.0 IP), 2 saves, 34 walks, and an eye-popping 86 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.09 WHIP from relief arms is the lowest at the High-A level and 9th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Additionally, the Cyclones have accrued a 13.82 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio, which is the best at High-A and 2nd-best in MiLB...Only Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa (14.10) has a better mark...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a Minor League-best .144 batting average against and an impressive 38.05% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C **Chris Suero** has been one of the best hitters in Minor League Baseball to start 2025...On Thursday, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On Tuesday, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on Sunday vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Saturday, Suero is 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.850)...He also ranks tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (11), and 6th in OPS (1.263)...He also leads the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.850), home runs (5), extra-base hits (11), and OPS (1.263)...Suero is also 2nd in RBI (15) and doubles (6), 3rd in total bases (34), tied for 4th in runs scored (11), and 9th in batting average (.325)...The 2022 international signee has a hit in 9-of-11 games played and reached base safely in all 11 contests...Suero was recognized on MiLB's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after going 10-for-29 (.345) with 5 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI over his first 8 games.

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer has registered multiple base hits in each of the first 4 games of Brooklyn's series in Aberdeen and 5-straight since last Sunday at Hudson Valley...The Yucaipa, Calif. native is an impressive 19-for-51 (.373) at the plate with 12 RBI and 10 extra-base hits...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer leads the South Atlantic League lead in triples (3) and total bases (36), and is tied for the league lead in hits (19)...Reimer is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.706), OPS (1.145), and extra-base hits (10), tied for 2nd in runs scored (13), 3rd in batting average (.373), tied for 3rd in doubles (5), tied for 5th in RBI (12), and 8th in on-base percentage (.439).

ROTATION IS ROLLING: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 13 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 1.77 ERA (11 ER in 56.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 72:19 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 1.77 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (2.29)...It is also 2nd among all High-A fran-

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn treks south for their first road trip of the season...The 2-week stretch begins with 6 games against the IronBirds...Aberdeen enters the series after taking 4-of-6 on the road against Jersey Shore...In 2024, Brooklyn went 11-13 against the IronBirds and 4-8 at Ripken Stadium...Aberdeen boasts 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: OF **Vance Honeycutt** (5), INF **Griff O'Ferrall** (7), RHP **Michael Forret** (8), RHP **Nestor Germán** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (14), RHP **Trey Gibson** (15), INF **Aron Estrada** (16), C **Ethan Anderson** (18), INF **Leandro Arias** (21), OF **Thomas Sosa** (23), and OF **Austin Overn** (30)...De León and Sosa are currently on the injured list...In 267 all-time meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 140-127 (.524).

chises...Only Cincinnati's High-A Dayton (1.68) has tallied a lower ERA...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a SAL-low 2.65 ERA (33 ER in 112.0 IP), which is good for the 2nd-lowest at High-A behind Kansas City's High-A Quad Cities (2.57)...The 2.65 ERA ranks 6th in all of Minor League Baseball...The Athletics' Single-A Stockton (2.45) is 1st.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss on Wednesday, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP **Noah Hall** sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Ryan Lambert**, and RHP **Alfred Vega** united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

NOAH'S ARC: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 3 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA (2 ER in 14.2 IP), 18 strikeouts and only 6 hits allowed...Entering Friday, Hall is 6th in the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.125), tied for 6th in innings pitched (14.2), 8th in ERA (1.23), and tied for 9th in strikeouts (18)...The University of South Carolina product became not only the first player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

VETERAN PRESENCE: OF **Rafael Ortega** remains with the Cyclones on a minor league rehab assignment from Triple-A Syracuse...Through 5 games, the 33-year-old is 2-for-21 (.095) at the plate with a double, 2 RBI, and a stolen base...This is Ortega's second stint in the New York Mets organization after spending most of the 2023 season with the club...The El Tigre, Venezuela native played 30 games at Triple-A Syracuse and another 47 with the Mets, hitting .219/.341/.272 with a home run and 8 RBI for the Big League club...Ortega has appeared in 425 MLB games with the Colorado Rockies, Los Angeles Angels, Miami Marlins, Atlanta Braves, Chicago Cubs, Chicago White Sox, and Mets, slashing .245/.322/.349/.671 with 22 home runs and 110 RBI...Ortega also played for Single-A Asheville in the South Atlantic League in 2011, hitting .294/.335/.438 with 9 homers and 66 RBI in 113 games.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones' offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shut-out relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33-year-old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls...Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League...The Dominican native will serve as **Albert Pujols'** assistant manager for Team Dominican Republic in the upcoming 2026 World Baseball Classic.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 8 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez**, LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernández** (27)...Of those 8, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 6 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Suero (20), and Reimer (21).

ON THE MEND: Blackburn joins the Cyclones on Saturday as part of a Major League rehab assignment...New York Mets manager **Carlos Mendoza** stated Thursday that Blackburn is slated to throw 2 innings...The 31-year-old was placed on the Mets' 15-day injured list on March 27 (retro March 24) with right knee inflammation...RHP **R.J. Gordon**, Saturday's originally scheduled starting pitcher, is expected to follow Blackburn in a piggyback role.

2024: The 31-year-old battled through injury during the season...Blackburn opened the season in the Oakland Athletics rotation...Tossed 7.0 innings of shutout ball, taking a no-decision in his season debut on 3/31 vs. Cleveland (7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 3 K)...Started his season with a 22.1-inning scoreless streak...Longest scoreless streak to start a season by an A's starting pitcher in franchise history...Broke the previous mark of 16.0 innings set by RHP **Matt Keough** in 1980...3rd-longest streak by an A's pitcher to begin a season behind RHP **Ryan Cook** in 2012 and LHP **Harry Kraus** in 1910...Landed on Oakland's 15-day injured list on 5/13 (retro to 5/11) with a stress reaction of the fifth metatarsal of his right foot...Sent to Single-A Stockton on a Major League rehab assignment on 7/9...Rehab transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on 7/14...Reinstated on 7/26...Acquired by the New York Mets from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for RHP **Kade Morris** on 7/30...Went 4-2 with a 4.41 ERA (25 ER in 51.0 IP), 14 walks, and 38 strikeouts in 9 starts for the A's...Joined the Mets' roster on 8/2...Earned the win in his New York debut on 8/2 at Los Angeles-AL (6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Landed on the Mets' 15-day IL on 8/25 (retro 8/24) with a right hand contusion...Joined Triple-A Syracuse on a MLB rehab assignment on 9/3...Reinstated on 9/30...Placed on the 60-day IL on 10/5 with a spinal fluid leak...Underwent left thoracic 12 Hermilaminotomy surgery to repair a cerebral spinal fluid leak on 10/11 at Cedars Sinai in Los Angeles...In 5 starts for the Mets, posted a 1-2 record with a 5.18 ERA (14 ER in 24.1 IP), 7 walks, and 21 strikeouts.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Blackburn was named to his first Major League All-Star team in 2022 as a member of the Oakland Athletics...Was the A's lone representative in the contest...Earned a hold in the mid-summer classic, tossing a scoreless 4th inning in relief, picking up a swinging strikeout of San Francisco Giants OF **Joc Pederson**...The American League won the All-Star Game, 3-2...Before the All-Star Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, the California native registered a 6-5 record with a 3.62 ERA (39 ER in 97.0 IP), 27 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 18 starts...Held a 2.26 ERA (18 ER in 71.2 IP) and a .616 opponent in his first 13 starts through 6/16/22...His season was cut short after being placed on the injured list on 8/5/22 with an inflamed right middle finger...Blackburn was also named an All-Star on 3 occasions at the minor league level in 2014 with Single-A Kane County, 2016 with Double-A Tennessee, and in 2017 with Triple-A Nashville.

TRADE DEAL: The Chandler, Ariz. resident has been traded 3 times throughout his professional career...After being selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 1st round (56th overall) in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Heritage High School (Brentwood, Calif.), Blackburn spent 5 seasons in the organization...Was dealt by the Cubs with 1B **Daniel Vogelbach** to the Seattle Mariners in exchange for LHP **Mike Montgomery** and RHP **Jordan Pries** on 7/20/16...Montgomery would go on to record the final out of the 2016 World Series for Chicago-NL, snapping their 108-year drought...Was dealt again 4 months later...Dealt by Seattle to the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF **Danny Valencia** on 11/12/16.
