# **Lake Elsinore Storm (18-18, 47-55)**









RHP Humberto Cruz (0-1, 4.70 ERA) vs. RHP Christian Zazueta (7-2, 2.45 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the opening game of a six-game series. Fans will enjoy \$2 Taco Tuesday and it's also a Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans can visit the website to learn how to score a FREE Club Seat Ticket. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** Today's game is the 13th of 24 head-to-head games and the tenth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 10-2 against the Storm with the two teams having played the first nine games of the series in Rancho where the Quakes own a 9-1 record. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes dropped four of six to Fresno, as they lost a 3-2 decision on Sunday night at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. Moments after Rancho tied the game in the top of the eighth on a Mairo Martinus RBI single, the Grizzlies took the lead for good on an RBI single off the bat of Jimmy Obertop in the bottom of the eighth against Cody Morse (0-1), giving the Grizzlies the series victory.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: Second-year Quake and RBI leader Samuel Munoz has been promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League, leaving Rancho with a .248 average, a 355 on-base percentage, 11 homers and a team-best 65 RBIs. Taking his spot on the roster is INF Joendry Vargas, who opened the year with Rancho, but has been rehabbing in Arizona with a right hand injury. MLB Pipeline rates Vargas as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect. In addition, the Quakes have also activated today's starting pitcher, Christian Zazueta.

**SERIES STUFF:** Sunday's loss at Fresno ended Rancho's bid for a third straight series win (2-of-3 at Lake Elsinore and 4-of-6 over Visalia). The Quakes are now 11-7-1 in series this year, but just 2-5-1 against the north.

**MORALES GOES DEEP...TWICE:** Emil Morales erupted on Saturday night in Fresno, as he belted his first two homers in a Rancho uniform. It's his fourth career two-homer game, after doing it three times in the Dominican Summer League in 2024, including in back-to-back July games last season. After getting Sunday off, Morales now has six RBIs in six games as a Quake and is back in today's lineup to open this six-game series.

**ELKINS STILL ROLLING:** Last week's Cal League Player of the Week had a strong follow-up in Fresno on the recent road trip, as Jaron Elkins went 8-for-24 (.333) with a home run, seven RBIs and six stolen bases over six games last series. Elkins is now batting .273 overall with nine homers and 64 RBIs, one off team-leader Samuel Munoz (65).

**DEFENSE STILL SCUFFLING:** Sunday was a step forward, as the team played error-free, but the Quakes had another tough series defensively, as they committed a total of nine errors over the first five games of the series. The Quakes have committed a league-worst 135 errors in 102 games and have a league-low fielding percentage of .963. CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: 20-year-old right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his 15th start of the year and his second against the Storm. This will be Zazueta's second start since June 18 and first since July 9 after going on the Injured List twice. In one game against Lake Elsinore this year, he's 1-0, allowing just one hit over five scoreless innings. Last year in Rancho, Zazueta went 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA over 14 games (11 starts) and 52.1 innings. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 in the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

HUMBERTO CRUZ: 18-year-old right-hander Humberto Cruz makes his fifth start for the Storm and first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed just one run on three hits in a no-decision vs Inland Empire on July 29. Cruz signed with the Padres out of Mexico in February of 2024.
