Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Trenton Denholm** to the mound today, followed by RHP **Rorik Maltrud** (second straight piggyback through the rotation). Iowa will counter with LHP **Charlie Barnes**. Columbus is 2-8 (.273) versus left handers this year (2G win streak). Barnes has pitched against the Clippers five times in his career, going 2-1 with a 4.42ERA (18.1IP, 17H, 10R, 9ER, 7BB, 21K).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 17-16 opposing the I-Cubs (32-23 in the last 55G). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 15RBI in 20G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 33RBI in 32G (.310, 36x116) and **Milan Tolentino** has 9HR and 20RBI in 22G (.365, 27x74). **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .319 (23x72) with 3HR and 9RBI in 19G.

Keep 'Em Separated

Iowa became the first team in the IL to both score and give up over 200 runs with last night's 9-6 contest. With four scores today, the Clippers will become the 2nd team to do so (all other teams are at least 25 runs away from one column or the other, if not both). All told, Iowa and Columbus have seen a combined 809 runs in 77G (10.5 per), with 125 scored in their 10G with each other (12.5 per).

Watch Out for Watson

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .352/.507/.648 with 9XBH in his last 16G (1XBH in first 12G). He drew a pair of walks on Sunday (t-2nd in IL with 28BB), his first multi-walk game since three straight from 4/18-4/21 (4BB in 6G between). When posting up in centerfield, as he is today, Watson is hitting .383/.525/.596 in 13G (61PA; .182/.333/.364 in all others, 68PA).

Familiar Surroundings

Juan Brito is slotting into the second spot in the batting order today for the 165th time in his Clipper career (78G and 359PA more than any other player in the IL since his Triple-A debut on 9/19/23). Brito hit his 54th double in his Columbus tenure last night (seven from the franchise top 25), and has the 7th most in the IL since joining the league (188G, 12 other players with at least 50 have played 215+).

Good for What Ails Ya

Nolan Jones has gone 4x26 (.154) in 7G after hitting .407 (11x27) in the 8G prior (4/16-4/26). Jones is bringing the slump to the banks of the Raccoon River, where he owns a career line of .377/.506/.770 with 5HR and 21RBI in 16G (has reached base in all, at least twice in 13G). Despite the slump, Jones is still driving in runs, as he now has 88RBI in his last 96G in Triple-A (.310/.426/.600 with 24HR).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to collect multi-hit games in each of his last 4G (last night was third multi-hit game on the road, hitting .250, 14x56 in 15G away from home; .345, 19x55, in 14G at Huntington Park). His double last night was his 13th XBH of the season (had 25XBH in 101G last year, .330SLG). He also crossed the plate twice, giving him 21 runs in 29G (31 runs last year).

Hey Now

Angel Genao made his Triple-A debut last night in his 384th career game (101G in Double-A in the previous two seasons). Genao started the season with an 11G on base streak (.519OBP, snapped with pinch-hit strikeout) and was leading the Eastern League in walks (22; Columbus is 2nd in the IL with 189BB). He was the fourth rookie (all switch hitters, accounting for 7.5% of PA) used this year.

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .143/.302/.171 with 0HR and 0RBI in 10G (2x4 with a double on 4/28). Of 29 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off a LHP (100AB; 27HR in 397AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .400 (8x20) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

No Experience Necessary

Maick Collado has hit safely in every game (9x25 with 5XBH and 5RBI in 7G) since skipping over Double-A to make his Triple-A debut on 4/26 at Buffalo. Collado was a career .228 hitter over 188G in Advanced-A with Lake County, having gone hitless in 6G this season (.147/.205/.294 in 10G). Between Columbus and Lake County, he already has seven doubles (career best is 13, set last year in 84G).

This Date in Clipper History

5/6/1987

Jay Buhner powered the Clippers to a 10-1 victory over the Tidewater Tides, going 4x5 with 2 doubles, 2HR, 4RBI and 3 runs scored. Buhner would go on to lead the IL in HR, pounding the 5th most roundtrippers (31) in franchise history. In addition to being named an IL All-Star, Buhner was selected as a co-Clipper of the Year in 1987. The next year, he would be traded to Seattle for **Ken Phelps'** bat.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 44-46 (.489) in pitch reviews, with batters going 27-33 (.450) and pitchers/catchers going 17-13 (.567). They have run out of challenges in 19G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-35 when playing past regulation (.593, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 86G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 13th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 19G this season (10-9, .526), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 404-422 (.489), 374-376 with Columbus (.499).

Great Start:

Denholm's season debut, 4/1 vs. Indianapolis, was his 100th career game and his second at the Triple-A level (367 days between Triple-A games). He needed only 69 pitches to record a quality start (6.0IP, 1ER), giving the Clippers their first of the season (5th game, did not have a quality start until 41st game last season). Denholm had six quality starts last season, but did not notch his first until 6/6/25 vs. Chesapeake.

Tough Ones:

On 4/12, Worcester hung 7ER on Denholm, tying a career high (third time), while also connecting for 2HR (eighth career game giving up 2HR, first time allowing both to same batter, Allan Castro). He followed up with a quality outing next time out, 4/18 vs. Iowa (6.0IP, 3ER), throwing a season high of 92 pitches. Denholm closed out April by giving up 7ER again (fourth time), this time to Toledo on 4/30, while giving up 3HR for the first time in his career.

2026 Spring Training:

Denholm pitched twice for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 13.50ERA (3.1IP, 7H, 5R, 5ER, 2BB, 2K). He was reassigned to minor league camp on 3/6.

Last Season:

Started the season with Columbus, making Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Toledo (L, 3.1IP, 3H, 3R, 3ER, 1BB, 3K)... sent to Akron for beginning of the Double-A season... pitched out of the bullpen, on starter's rest, for first 6G with Akron (4/6-5/11), going 5-0 with a save and a 2.45ERA (22.0IP, 19H, 7R, 6ER, 3BB, 21K)... piggyback schedule was broken up with weeklong stint in Columbus (4/28-5/4) that saw no action (three postponements and two cancellations)... entered the Akron rotation on 5/18, going 2-2 with a 1.41ERA (32.0IP, 19H, 6R, 5ER, 3BB, 29K) in first 6GS (5/18-6/18)... hot streak ended with back to back scoreless starts on 6/12 at Hartford (6.0IP, 6H, 0BB, 6K) and no-hit bid at Portland on 6/18 (6.0IP, 1H, 0BB, 5K; lost with two out in the 5th), part of a larger 17.0IP scoreless streak (6/6-6/24)... from 6/24 through the end of the season, went 4-5 with a 5.20ERA (72.2IP, 42ER) in 14G... cold spell saw a wild streak (introduction of a knuckle ball) coming out of the All-Star Break, with 16BB to 155BF in 7G from 7/19-8/24 (10%; issued 10BB to 377BF, 2.7%, in all other games)... following the season, pitched in 5G for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League (12.2IP, 19H, 7R, 3ER, 6BB, 16K)
