RIDERS TAKE FINALE TO SPLIT SERIES WITH NATURALS:

The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 5-4 in the series finale of the six-game set on Sunday afternoon from Arvest Ballpark. The Naturals (24-39) scored the first run of the game in the first inning on a sacrifice fly against Frisco (28-34) starter **Owen White**, who went three innings in his start. The RoughRiders tied the game in the fifth on an RBI single from **Chris Seise**, but the Naturals took the lead right back in the bottom of the inning when a run scored on an error to make it 2-1. In the top of the sixth, **Aaron Zavala** crushed a two-run home run to center, his third homer of the season, to give the Riders a 3-2 lead, but once again, the Naturals tied the game in the bottom of the inning with a Parker Bates RBI double. In the top of the seventh, Frisco nabbed the lead again. **Thomas Saggese** ripped an RBI single and **Trevor Hauver** added an RBI double to put the Riders in front 5-3. Northwest Arkansas put up a run in the eighth, but **Alex Speas** recorded his second save of the year by getting the last four outs of the game from the Frisco bullpen. Both Zavala and Seise cashed in with two-hit days while former Naturals pitcher **Danny Duffy** (1-1) took home the win for Frisco. Andrew Hoffmann (2-5) was handed the loss in relief for Northwest Arkansas, ceding five runs over his four innings.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been hot lately, hitting safely in nine-straight games while batting .378 (14-for-37)/.439/.486/.925 with one double, one home run, four RBIs, five runs, four walks and a steal. Over the last nine games, he has raised his average from .200 to .233 and his OPS from .612 to .668.

OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:

Pitcher **Owen White** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, 9-0. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A. White made his MLB debut on Tuesday, allowing three runs over two innings with two strikeouts. On Tuesday, White was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock.

THOMAS WAS BACK IN NWA:

Thomas Saggese returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by batting .381 (8-for-21)/.409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a walk. In the six games of the series this year, he hit .370 (10-for-27)/.419/.630/1.049 with a double, two home runs, four runs, seven RBIs and two walks.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.72 over 21 appearances. In 25.0 innings, he has struck out 42 to 12 walks. Opponents are hitting just .138 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 12 outings. During that span, he has struck out 27 to five walks over 14.2 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .125 (8-for-64) against him on the season with a .385 OPS.

POWER SURGE:

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 14 long balls over their last 12 games. In the 12 games, Frisco is hitting .256/.359/.417/.776 with 23 doubles, 14 home runs and averaging 5.9 runs per game. **Luisangel Acuña** has led the way, hitting .320 (16-for-50)/.382/.500/.882 in the span while **Thomas Saggese** hit five home runs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .452 (19-for-42) on the initial offering while his 19 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 29 and is on pace for a career-best 64 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 95 bases in 110 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .300 (70-for-233)/.369/.433/.802 through the first 54 games. Over his last 50 games, he is batting .312/.384/.456/.840. Acuña is riding an 12-game on-base streak, batting .327 (18-for-55). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (115).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 311 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .353 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 44 walks.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
