BACK-TO-BACK, AGAIN: Omaha did something in last night's 9-1 win that had not been done since at least 2019. The Chasers, in the first inning, hit back-to-back home runs for the second consecutive game. Yesterday, **OF Brewer Hicklen** launched a three-run shot before **OF Dairon Blanco** hit a moonshot three pitches later. In the final game before the break, **INF Angelo Castellano** and **OF John Rave** went yard on back-to-back plate appearances in the first inning in Omaha's 13-7 win at Rochester. Both pairs of long balls chased the starting pitcher out of the game before the end of the first inning, something that the Chasers have done three times in the last month after having not done it since April of 2019.

SWEET RELIEF: Omaha's bullpen tossed 8.0 innings of scoreless relief last night, dropping the Chasers' reliever ERA to 3.54, the third lowest mark in the International League. **RHP Marcelo Martinez** came in to start the second and went 4.0 innings and to get the win while **RHP Colin Snider**, **RHP Ryan Weiss**, **RHP Ronald Bolaños**, and **LHP Gabe Speier** each tossed an inning to secure the win. **RHP Andrés Núñez** is riding a 20-game streak without allowing an earned run, the longest streak in the International League.

MASHING MASSEY: **INF Michael Massey** had an impressive 3-for-3 night last night, hitting a homer that he paired with two walks to reach base five times. He also scored a pair of runs and recorded two RBIs. Massey now has more games with three or more hits than he has games without recording a hit in a Storm Chasers uniform. His 23-game on-base streak is the second longest active streak in the International League, trailing Rochester's Josh Palacios who has reached in 25 consecutive games.

MAKING A SPLASH: **OF Drew Waters** has recorded a hit in each of his first seven games for the Storm Chasers, hitting leadoff for the last seven games. Last night, Waters went 2-for-4, hitting a homer and scoring three runs in his first game at Werner Park. Waters is hitting .333 with Omaha since getting traded from the Atlanta Brave's organization. Waters is now the No. 8 Royals prospect according to mlb.com and the highest rated prospect currently with the Storm Chasers.

CATCH US IF YOU CAN: **OF Brewer Hicklen** stole his 19th base yesterday, now tied for ninth most in the International League this season. He has yet to be caught this season, the only member of the top ten with a perfect 1.000 stolen base percentage. **OF Drew Waters** also swiped a bag yesterday, now with three stolen bases in his first seven games as a Chaser. Omaha, as a team, leads the league with a .868 stolen base percentage, stealing 99 bases and getting caught just 15 times.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Carlos Hernández** heads to the mound to make his ninth start for the Storm Chasers this season. In his last start, Hernández went just 2.1 innings, allowing no earned runs with one hit and striking out a pair. The 25-year-old started the season with Kansas City before getting optioned to Omaha in May. With the Big-League club, Hernández holds a record of 0-3 with a 9.10 ERA in seven starts. Although his strikeout to walk ratio is better when playing at Werner Park, Hernández is 0-2 at home with a 5.71 ERA in four starts. Hernández has struck out 14 batters while allowing just five free passes in 17.1 innings of work at home. Hernández was signed as an international free agent by Kansas City during 2016 and has worked his way up the Royals minor league system. He made his MLB debut in September of 2020, throwing 3.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

FOR TOLEDO: **RHP Caleb Kilian** toes the rubber for his 15th start for the I-Cubs this season. In his last start, Kilian went 3.0 innings and allowed two earned runs on three hits and five walks with six strikeouts against Buffalo. The 25-year-old is facing off against Omaha for the second time this season, with the first coming on May 13 in Des Moines when Kilian went 5.2 innings and allowed two unearned runs on six hits with six strikeouts and a pair of walks. Texas Tech product made his debut in The Show seven weeks ago, throwing 5.0 innings in the second game of a doubleheader, striking out six while allowing three earned runs. Kilian was drafted by the San Francisco Giants in the eighth round in 2019 before being traded to the Chicago Cubs organization at the end of July last year, part of the trade that sent Kris Bryant to the Giants.
