FRES-NOTES

FRUSTRATING FRIDAY FOR FRESNO: The Fresno Grizzlies (5-2) were defeated by the Inland Empire 66ers (2-5) 3-0 Friday night from Chukchansi Park. An announced crowd of 8,293 fans were treated to an amazing promotional night, which included a replica jersey, a pitcher's duel and a post-game fireworks show. The attendance ranked first in the California League (by 3,544 people) and Single-A (by 1,694), while ending 17th overall in all of Minor League Baseball. For the Grizzlies offense, Jason Hinchman was not retired, reaching base four times (two walks, one single and one HBP). Jake Snider mashed a double and walked once. Fresno starter Jack Mahoney (1-1) took the tough-luck loss after surrendering two runs over five and one-third innings of work. Mahoney allowed five hits and two walks while fanning three. The bullpen trio of Stu Flesland III, Collin Baumgartner and Welinton Herrera punched out seven batters over three and two-thirds frames.

DOUBLEHEADER IN DOWNTOWN FRESNO: Thanks to a rainout on Saturday, the Fresno Grizzlies and Inland Empire 66ers will play a doubleheader today starting at 12:05 pm. This is the first doubleheader for the Grizzlies since April 24, 2022 vs. Lake Elsinore. Fresno was swept in that doubleheader 6-1 in Game 1 and 6-2 in 8 innings in Game 2 (technically, extras). Both of today's games are scheduled for seven innings with a 30-minute break in between the contests for the teams to recover and get ready for the back half of the doubleheader.

INFO ABOUT INLAND EMPIRE: The Fresno Grizzlies and Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angels Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series today at Chukchansi Park with a doubleheader. This is the first of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting this year in Fresno. The 66ers are the current affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels and have been a part of the Angels system since 2011. Prior to teaming up with the Angels, the 66ers had ties to the Los Angeles Dodgers (1995-2000, 2007-2010) and Seattle Mariners (1987-1994, 2001-2006) organizations. They were also the former Fresno Giants/Fresno Cardinals franchise. The 66ers are named after the historic U.S. Route 66 that runs through San Bernardino. Prior to the name change, the 66ers were known as the San Bernardino Stampede (1996-2002) and San Bernardino Spirit (1987-1995). The mascot for Inland Empire is Bernie, who is one of the only talking mascots in all of professional baseball. Bernie has been a part of the organization since 1999. The 66ers play at San Manuel Stadium and are owned by Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH) as of 2024.

COUPET GETS THE NOD: In Game 1, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

FARM GROWN: In Game 2, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

GETTING INTO THE EARLY NUMBERS: The Grizzlies' pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters in six of their first seven games this season (10, 5x and 13). Overall, Fresno arms have fanned 68 total batters in 2024. The Grizzlies offense has walked 36 times over their last five contests, giving them 49 base-on-balls this year (T-1st in Single-A, High-A and Double-A with Lake Elsinore, T-24th overall in Minor League Baseball, with all Triple-A teams ahead of them).

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Outfielder Jake Snider has had an impressive start to the season, going 6-for-18 (.333 AVG/.600 OBP/.722 SLG/1.322 OPS) with one homer, one triple, two doubles, four RBI, 12 runs, 11 walks and one stolen base. Snider's triple on April 7th (Sunday) in San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

EJ AND THE SB: Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' outfielder EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 12 bases, one in 12 different games. Fresno is 12-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with all 12 games ending within five runs.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all seven games to start this season. Perez is 9-for-30 (.300 AVG/.364 OBP/.567 SLG/.931 OPS) with one homer, one triple, three doubles, seven RBI, five runs and three walks.
