Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Hitting Machine: Joey Meneses is 17-for-52 (.327) in his first 14 games of 2025 with 11 doubles, nine RBIs, and five walks. Meneses's 11 doubles lead the International League with the next closest players at seven. The 32-year-old's strong start to the season comes after Meneses had an excellent winter in the Mexican Pacific Winter League, hitting .320 with 58 RBIs, ten home runs, 14 doubles, and an .896 on-base plus slugging percentage.

Starting Strong: Syracuse starting pitchers have held opponents to a .208 batting average against this season which is fourth best in the International League. Mets starter's 1.29 WHIP (walks plus hits divided by innings pitched) ranks sixth in the league, and their 3.60 ERA is eighth. Meanwhile, Syracuse's bullpen ranks 20th with a 5.66 ERA, 19th with 40 walks allowed, 19th with a 1.65 WHIP, and 14th with a .255 batting average against.

Deflating Defense: Syracuse's defense has committed nine errors in the last ten games after committing just one error in the first four games of 2025.

Boom or Bust: Only one of Syracuse's first 14 games has been decided by one run. Every other matchup has been decided by three runs or more. The average scoring margin through the first ten games is 4.6 runs.

Untimely Hitting: Syracuse is hitting .227 with runners in scoring position this season which ranks 15th in the International League while the Mets' .624 OPS with runners at second and/or third ranks 17th. Syracuse is hitting .196 with runners in scoring position and two outs, ranking 15th. The Mets are hitting .200 (3-for-15) with the bases loaded with five RBIs, no walks, and seven strikeouts.

Both Sides of the Ball: Gilberto Celestino is on a nine-game hitting streak, going 11-for-30 (.367) over this stretch with three RBIs, a home run, two doubles, and four walks. Celestino also has Syracuse's lone outfield assist of the season.

Finding a Way: Syracuse began the 2025 season with a one-run win over Worcester on Friday. The game was close throughout with neither team leading by more than two runs. In 2024, Syracuse had the second-best win percentage in the International League, winning 60% of games decided by one run (18-12 record). Only Rochester with 61.8% (21-13) had a better record in one-run games last year.

Power Surge: In 2024, Luke Ritter tied for third in the International League 26 home runs, ranked second with 93 RBIs, 11th with an .849 on-base plus slugging percentage, tied for fifth with 73 walks, ranked fourth with 63 extra-base hits, and eighth with 80 runs. Ritter's 93 RBIs were a career-high and his 26 homers were one shy of his career high that he set in 2023.

- In 2025 MLB Spring Training, pitched an immaculate inning, getting three strikeouts on nine pitches that were all strikes against the Tampa Bay Rays on March 1st, striking out Josh Lowe, Eloy Jimenez, and Jose Caballero
- In 2023, led all Mets minor league pitchers with a 31.4% strikeout rate and a .208 batting average against, but his 12.9% walk rate also led Mets minor league pitching qualifiers in 2023
- Selected by the New York Mets in the second round (52nd overall) of the 2022 MLB draft and signed for \$1.85 million
- Played two seasons at the University of Tennessee...Started 18 games as a freshman, going 10-3 with a 3.74 ERA and 90 strikeouts in 98.2 innings pitched...Missed the beginning of sophomore season with shoulder soreness but appeared in 13 games and struck out 51 batters in 39 IP with a 3.00 ERA
