TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their first series of the season with the Richmond Flying Squirrels, the lone series in the first half of the season between the clubs.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona earned their first win of the week on the strength of Braxton Ashcraft's career-high 12 strikeouts. Tsung-Che Cheng and Sammy Siani homered in the win.

A 'CRAFT FIT TO CARRY THE CURVE: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft struck out a career-high 12 batters in 7.0 innings on June 6 at Richmond, the most by a Curve pitcher since 2015 when Tyler Glasnow struck out 12 Akron RubberDucks. Ashcraft threw 93 pitches in his seven innings of work, with 74 going for strikes. His 12-strikeout performance came without a walk, making him the sixth pitcher in all Minor League Baseball this season to punch at least 12 batters without a free pass. Ashcraft was one shy of Tom Gorzelanny's Curve franchise record of 13 strikeouts in a game. It was the fifth time in team history that a pitcher struck out 12+ batters in a single contest and the second time this season that Ashcraft struck out 10 batters in a game.

Entering play on Friday, June 7 his 3.6% walk-rate was the lowest among Double-A pitchers that have thrown at least 40.0 IP, and he also ranks 2nd in Swinging Strike% (whiffs divided by total number of pitches) and 1st in K-BB% (25.0%).

BOWEN'S BAT: Outfielder Jase Bowen has hit his stride in the month of June. He's batting .435 (10-for-23) in the first four games he's played in the month of June with one double and one triple.

THE POWER OF GEN Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his career when he knocked solo homers on June 5 and 6 at Richmond. Cheng has reached base safely in 6 of his last 7 games, during which he's hit .292/.414/.583 with 1 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI and 2-2 SB.

K SPELLS TROUBLE: The Curve have struck out at least 13 times in 5-of-7 games since Thursday, May 30. Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 24 times this season in 54 games.

BULLPEN TROUBLES: Altoona's bullpen has blown 11 of 21 save chances this season, second-most by a Double-A club behind the Akron RubberDucks (12 blown saves). Altoona's 5.62 bullpen ERA is last among 30 Double-A clubs, 111th among 120 minor league

SULLY DOMINATES: Righty Sean Sullivan has picked up right where he left off in 2023 in the Curve rotation. Sullivan tossed 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings (5/7 - 5/28), the longest streak by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras began the 2021 season with 18.2 scoreless innings. In his time with Altoona he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 20-of-31 starts and his 3.12 ERA ranks 10th in the Eastern League.

NOWHERE TO GO BUT UP: Through April and May, Altoona had the 3rd-worst record among professional baseball teams with an 16-33 record. The Curve were the last team in the affiliated minors to win 10 games. The Chattanooga Lookouts (Reds, Southern League) hold the worst record in professional baseball at 14-35. Altoona's 16-33 start is the worst record for the club through 49 games in franchise history, matching the 2009 Curve who started the season 17-32. The 5 wins in the month of April were the fewest for the team in a calendar month in which they played at least 15 games.

THE SQUIRRELS IN FLIGHT: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the post Grant McCray has been one of their most consistent players this season, entering the series he leads the club's all-time Managerial wins list. Grant McCray has been one of their most consistent players this season, entering the series he leads the club in HR (6), RBI (23), runs (27) and stolen bases (6). Richmond is 12-6 since going 1-12 over a 13-game stretch from April 28-May 12. They won 5-of-6 in back-to-back series before splitting last week's series with Erie, 3-3. John Michael Bertrand and Grant McCray swept the Eastern League's weekly awards after their series in Bowie two weeks ago. Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30)

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: Dylan Cumming takes the ball on Friday night for Richmond. Signed as an undrafted free agent in Liberty in 2023, Cumming makes his second appearance for the Flying Squirrels tonight, he struck out 7 in 4.0 innings in his team debut last week against Erie. Cumming hails from Grand Blanc, Michigan and began his collegiate career at Chicago State where he played three seasons. Cumming comes from an athletic family, his mother played Volleyball at Central Michigan and was inducted into the Flint, Mich. Hall of Fame in 2019 and his father played professional volleyball on the AVP tour


