The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees will play game four of their six-game series on Friday night from Dell Diamond. Express RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled to take the mound against Bees RHP Zach Plesac. First pitch is scheduled for 7:15 p.m. CT.

### LAST NIGHT'S FEATURE FILM

Round Rock collected a 1-0 walk-off win over Salt Lake on Thursday night. Both teams went scoreless through eight and a half innings behind stellar performances from starting pitchers. Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter threw 6.0 innings that saw only one hit and three walks and included eight strikeouts. Salt Lake starter LHP Kenny Rosenberg allowed four hits and two walks during his 7.0 innings on the bump and struck out five batters. The Express had chances with runners on base in six different innings, but the team combined to leave six stranded. In the bottom of the ninth, DH Sam Huff worked a one-out walk before RF Sandro Fabian sent his teammate home with a double that hit the left field wall, giving Round Rock the 1-0 win.

### IRON MAN ADRIAN

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson will take the mound on Friday in his fifth start of the season. Sampson is coming off a 7.0-inning outing at Sugar Land where he allowed only two runs and one earned run on six hits and three strikeouts. Left-handed hitters are batting only .179 (7-39) with zero home runs against him this year.

### PLESAC VS SAMPSON VOL. 2

Express RHP Adrian Sampson and Bees RHP Zach Plesac will square off against each other for the second time in their careers. On June 18, 2019, Sampson started for the Texas Rangers against Plesac for the Cleveland Indians at Globe Life Park. Plesac was in his rookie season and earned the win after 7.0 innings and only one earned run on two hits. He walked five and struck out six as Cleveland won 10-3. Sampson went 3.0 innings and allowed three runs while being tagged with the loss. Salt Lake 1B Willie Calhoun was in the lineup for Texas that night.

### SANDRO SMASH

Round Rock OF Sandro Fabian went 2-for-4 with two doubles including the walk-off double for the Express last night. All four of his at-bats ended with an exit velocity of 99.6 mph or higher. He lined out to center field twice. Since May 18, 2023, Fabian is slashing .329/.362/.586/.948 in 108 games. In his first 19 games this year he owns a slash line of .397/.429/.616/1.045.

### COME MEET YOUR DOOM

Express RHP Jack Leiter and RHP Aidan Anderson combined to throw the first one-hitter for Round Rock since June 20, 2022. Since the start of the 2005 season, this is just the 11th one-hitter for the E-Train. The last one-hitter came from RHP Spencer Howard and RHP Spencer Patton against Las Vegas. Current Express pitcher Collin Wiles was on the losing end after he went 8.0 innings for the Aviators and allowed only three earned runs.

### FOR THE LOVE OF ROUND ROCK

Express RHP Aidan Anderson was transferred to Double-A Frisco this afternoon while LHP Kolton Ingram was optioned to Round Rock. Ingram was claimed off waivers by Texas from the New York Mets on April 24. Ingram appeared in 22 games for Salt Lake last year while making his Major League debut with the Angels for five games.

**ALCS EXPRESS REUNION**

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

**EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

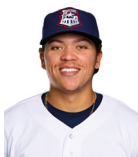
