LAST TIME OUT: Asheville rallied from 5 runs down to stun Brooklyn, 6-5, on Wednesday night...CF **Lucas Spence** provided the go-ahead 3-run home run in the bottom of the 7th...The Cyclones put the tying run in scoring position in the 9th, but could not complete the comeback...SS **Marco Vargas** tallied a pair of hits and drove in a run for Brooklyn...The Cyclones scored 4 runs in the opening frame, 3 of which scored on a 3B **Jesús Báez** double...Brooklyn went without a hit from Vargas' RBI single in the 2nd until LF **Diego Mosquera's** single with 1 out in the 9th...RHP **Chandler Marsh** tossed 2.0 innings of scoreless relief, striking out 4...RHP **Dylan Ross** struck out 3 in a scoreless inning...RHP **Juan Bello** earned the win for Asheville, tossing 5.0 innings of 1-hit shutout relief, striking out 6...The Tourists' bullpen allowed only 1 hit and 1 walk over 6.0 innings of scoreless ball.

NOTHING AGAINST NUNEZ: RHP **Anthony Nunez** earned his 1st career save with a 5-out performance last Friday vs. Wilmington and added his 1st career victory with 1.2 frames of perfect relief at Asheville on Tuesday...The Miami Springs, Fla. native has yet to allow an earned run through his first 9 appearances of the season...Nunez did not surrender a mere base hit until his 7th appearance of the year...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 14.0 IP, Nunez is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00)...He is 1 of 2 players to not allow an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg**)...Nunez's 0.36 WHIP leads the league amongst those with 14.0 IP, and is tops in all of High-A...Nunez's 0.36 WHIP is also the 2nd-lowest in Minor League Baseball among arms with 14.0 or more innings...Only Boston's High-A Greenville's LHP **Brandon Clarke** (0.35) has a lower mark...Nunez's .025 batting average against (1-40) is the lowest mark in MiLB ahead of New York-AL's Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's RHP **Kervin Castro** (.037) by 12 points...On the year, Nunez holds a 51.06% strikeout rate and an 8.51% walk rate.

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 5th in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (18) and 7th in slugging percentage (.623)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in batting average (.330), total bases (66), slugging percentage (.623), OPS (1.031), extra-base hits (18), hits (35), and doubles (10), and tied for 1st in triples (3)...Reimer is also tied for 2nd in runs scored (22), tied for 4th in home runs (5), and tied for 5th in RBI (23).

DÍAZ DELIVERS: Another year removed from Tommy John surgery, RHP **Joel Díaz** has returned to form in 2025...The 21-year-old's scoreless inning streak to start the year ended at 17.1 IP after allowing a run against Wilmington on April 30...The righty sports a 0.72 ERA (2 ER in 25.0 IP), which is the lowest in the South Atlantic League by nearly a full run over Greensboro's RHP **Garrett McMillan** (1.55)...Díaz also paces the circuit in WHIP (0.68) and sits 2nd in batting average against (.169)...Entering Thursday, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native leads the SAL in walk rate (2.2%) and FIP (1.80)...Díaz is also 2nd in strikeout rate (32.6%), strikeout-to-walk-rate (30.4%), and swinging strike percentage (17.5%).

EW CAN'T STOP HIM: IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, the 20-year-old is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4) and tied for 7th in stolen bases (18)...Ewing has reached base safely in all 7 games he's played with the Cyclones and has reached in 14-straight games since April 18 vs. Tampa with Single-A St. Lucie...In that time, Ewing is hitting .302/.422/.434/.856 with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, 9 runs batted in, 11 walks, and 11 stolen bases.

MARCO POLO: IF **Marco Vargas** has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the start of last week...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 7 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 20 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 20-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .351/.443/.459/.902 with 18 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 13 RBI, 12 walks, and 6 stolen bases...He has also accrued at least 1 RBI in 6 of 7 games played with Brooklyn.

STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 28 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.85 ERA (36 ER in 113.2 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 139-to-36 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.85 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Hudson Valley is 2nd (3.09)...It is also 2nd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (1.92) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 3.17 ERA (86 ER in 244.0 IP), which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 5th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.31) holds the lowest mark at High-A and in MiLB.

WHAT A RELIEF! Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, Cyclones relievers have an 11-4 record with a 3.45 ERA (50 ER in 130.1 IP), 6 saves, 67 walks, and an eye-popping 186 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.14 WHIP from relief arms is the 2nd lowest at the High-A level behind Hudson Valley (1.09) and 4th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Miami's Double-A Pensacola is 1st (0.96)...Brooklyn's 12.84 strikeouts-per-nine-innings ratio is the best at High-A and 3rd-best in MiLB...Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa (13.34) holds the top spot...The Cyclones have also held opponents to a .181 batting average, which is tied for the 3rd-lowest in the minors...Pensacola is 1st (.154)...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 34.64% strikeout rate.

WE THE BEST: The Cyclones swept the South Atlantic League Player and Pitcher of the Month awards that were handed out on Monday...INF **Jacob Reimer** was recognized as the SAL Player of the Month, and LHP **Zach Thornton**, now at Double-A Binghamton, was named as the SAL Pitcher of the Month...In 21 games played April, Reimer hit .318/.383/.659/1.042 with 18 runs scored, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 9 walks, and a stolen base...The 21-year-old paced the SAL in doubles (8), extra-base hits (16), triples (3), slugging percentage (.659), and total bases (56)...Reimer also was 2nd in OPS (1.124), tied for 2nd in RBI (21) and hits (27), 4th in batting average (.318), tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 6th in runs scored (18)...The Yucaipa, Calif. native was also 5th in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.659), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16), and tied for 8th in total bases (56)...Thornton accrued a perfect 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 12 hits, 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...Among SAL arms with 20.0-plus innings pitched in April, Thornton led the league in strikeout-to-walk ratio (12.50) and was tied with teammate RHP **Joel Díaz** for the league lead in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68)...He also tied for first in wins (3) and sat 3rd in batting average against (.162)...Additionally, IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** took home Florida State League Player of the Month honors in April...With Single-A St. Lucie, the 20-year-old hit .400/.506/.615/1.121 with 15 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 swiped bags...Ewing paced the FSL in steals (14), batting average (.400), and OPS (1.121), and was tied for first in triples (4)...The Springboro, Ohio, native also ranked 2nd in on-base percentage (.506) and RBI (20), 3rd in slugging percentage (.615) and hits (26), and tied for 5th in total bases (40)...In April, Ewing was tied for 2nd in MiLB in triples (4), tied for 5th in steals (16), 6th in batting average (.376), 8th in OPS (1.052), and 10th in on-base percentage (.484)...Thornton is Brooklyn's first Pitcher of the Month honoree since RHP **Dom Hamel** was named SAL Pitcher of the Month in September 2022...Reimer is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Month since moving to the High-A level in 2021 and the first to win at any level since at least 2016.

WEEKLY HONORS: INF **Jacob Reimer** earned New York Mets' Minor League Player of the Week for the 2nd time this season on Monday...Last week vs. Wilmington, the 21-year-old went 10-for-25 (.400) at the plate with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base...Last Wednesday, Reimer became the first Cyclone since 2005 to register a 3-home run game...The Yucaipa, Calif. native was the first to do it since **Caleb Stewart** on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley...Reimer was the first to do it at home since **Noel Devarez** on July 1, 2001, vs. New Jersey...On the season, he leads the Mets' farm system in runs scored (22), total bases (66), slugging percentage (.629), OPS (1.026), extra-base hits (18), hits (35), and tied for 1st in RBI (23).

vs. ASHEVILLE: After a 4-2 homestand vs. Wilmington, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Tourists...Asheville enters the series after taking 4-of-7 on the road against Greenville...This is the Cyclones' first trip to McCormick Field since winning 4-of-6 from August 22-27, 2023...Asheville is 5-6 at home this season...The Tourists boast 7 of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: C **Walker Janek** (4), RHP **Anderson Brito** (6), OF **Joseph Sullivan** (12), INF **Chase Jaworsky** (13), OF **Kenni Gómez** (18), RHP **Juan Bello** (24), and RHP **Bryce Mayer** (29)...In 19 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 11-8 (.579)...Brooklyn is 7-6 (.538) in 13 games in Asheville.

ROCKIN' RONNY: C/1B **Ronald Hernández** has been an integral piece of the puzzle for the Cyclones all season...The switch-hitter had a 9-game on-base streak dating back to April 23 at Jersey Shore snapped on Wednesday...During the stretch, Hernández is hitting .419 (13-31) with 10 runs scored, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 4 walks, and 4 stolen bases...Since the streak started, the 21-year-old has raised his batting average by 115 points from .125 to .240...Hernández has already swiped a career-high 9 bags in 2025, surpassing his career-best from 2024 in 86 fewer games (108 to 22)...The Venezuela native was named to MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after an 8-for-18 (.444) week at the plate with 4 runs scored, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 steals...Last Wednesday, Hernández and INF **Jacob Reimer** (3) became the first pair of Brooklyn teammates to hit multiple home runs in the same game since INFs **Edgardo Fermin** and **Ronny Mauricio** each powered a pair on July 21, 2021, at Jersey Shore.

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win v. Wilmington last Wednesday...It marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24th's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season...Before this season, the Cyclones had not scored 15 or more runs in a game at home since putting up 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-5 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 24, 2010.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader at St. Louis...Tidwell punched out C **Pedro Pagés** swinging for his first MLB strikeout in the 2nd...OF **Rhylan Thomas** (2023) went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night for the Seattle Mariners at Texas...C **Hayden Senger** (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** (19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

OFF AND RUNNING: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on Tuesday saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C **Chris Suero** and DH **Jesús Báez** each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal.

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 6 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2-2 with a 1.88 ERA (6 ER in 28.2 IP), 35 strikeouts and only 20 hits allowed...Entering Thursday, Hall is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in strikeouts (35), 5th in ERA (1.88), tied for 5th in double plays induced (3), and 10th in innings pitched (28.2)...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SUPER SUERO: C **Chris Suero** has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Thursday, Suero is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (7), tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (11), 6th in slugging percentage (.506), 8th in OPS (.891), and tied for 10th in RBI (18).

SIR SERRANO: OF **Eli Serrano III** put together his best game as a professional April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B **Luke Ritter** also accomplished the feat 9th 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Thursday, Serrano is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (11).

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On May 8, 2021, the Cyclones defeated the Asheville Tourists, 16-12, at McCormick Field for the 800th win in franchise history...Brooklyn clubbed 4 home runs in the game...2B **Luke Ritter**, DH **Ronny Mauricio**, SS **Cody Bohanek**, and 1B **Joe Genord** all went deep in the win.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 10 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22), and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), and INF **A.J. Ewing** (27)...Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 3rd win of the season last Friday night vs. Wilmington...Piggybacked off of Major League rehabber RHP **Paul Blackburn**, entering to start the top of the 4th inning and the Cyclones in front 3-2...Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings, allowing 2 hits...Walked 3 and hit a batter, striking out 4...Induced a double play...Threw 71 pitches and 41 strikes (57.75%)...Relieved by RHP **Anthony Nunez** with a runner at 1st and 1 out in the top of the 8th and Brooklyn still leading 3-2...Gordon's bequeathed runner was erased on an inning-ending double play...Nunez tossed a perfect 9th inning to secure the 3-2 victory.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Registered a no-decision in his professional debut on 4/8 vs. HV (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st victory of his pro career piggybacking off Major League rehabber RHP **Paul Blackburn** on 4/19 @ABD (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Struck out a career-high 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings to earn the win on 4/25 @JS (5.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 9 K)...Picked up the win piggybacking off of Blackburn again on 5/2 vs. WIL (4.1 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K)...Has not allowed more than 2 runs in any outing this season.

DUCK TALES: Gordon spent his four-year collegiate career at the University of Oregon...As a junior in 2024, the Santa Clarita, Calif. native accumulated a 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts for the Ducks...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention and was recognized on the University's Dean's List in the Winter of 2023...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, as well as the Santa Barbara Regional and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in games started (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87)...Gordon was initially recruited to Eugene as a two-way player.

ON THE MEND: The 23-year-old returned to the bump for the Ducks in 2024 after missing and redshirting the entire 2023 season due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery to correct...Despite missing an entire campaign, Gordon still finished his career at Oregon tied for 10th in program history in games started (28)...Finished his college career with a 14-9 record, a 5.22 ERA (106 ER in 182.2 IP), 1 save, 89 walks, and 155 strikeouts in 51 appearances (28 starts).

SUMMER FUN: Following his freshman season at Oregon, Gordon spent his summer of 2021 pitching for the Bend (Ore.) Elks of the West Coast League...In four starts, the right-hander posted a 2-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (10 ER in 22.2 IP), 7 walks, and 29 strikeouts...Gordon was teammates with a pair of former Cyclones that summer, spending time on the pitching staff with LHP **Eli Ankeney** (2023) and RHP **Kade Morris** (2024).

BOTH WAYS: Gordon finished his high school career at West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, Calif., before attending the University of Oregon...The 23-year-old spent his sophomore and junior seasons at Notre Dame High School...Was a freshman when Cincinnati Reds RHP **Hunter Greene** was a senior...During his time in high school, the right-handed pitcher also served as a gifted outfielder, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a home run, 4 RBI, and 1.204 OPS in a COVID-shortened senior season...In high school, Gordon faced off as a hitter against 2024
