THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue a six-game home-stand tonight with the fourth game against the Springfield Cardinals. Wichita opens play in first place, leading the Tulsa Drillers by a half game. Wichita season best four game win streak ended last night.

VS. SPRINGFIELD - Wichita leads the season series 10-5. The Surge won five of six to open the season in Springfield and the teams split a six-game series at Riverfront May 25-30. Wichita has outscored the Cards 96-67, Springfield has a 22-18 advantage in home runs.

LAST GAME - Delvin Perez hit a two run ninth inning home run to break a 3-3 tie and Springfield defeated Wichita 5-3. Wind Surge starter Austin Schulfer pitched a quality start working six shutout innings. The Surge took a 3-0 lead thanks to a Roy Morales two run hit. Jordan Milbrath allowed three walks in a blown save and Ryan Mason suffered the loss.

ON THE HILL – Josh Winder is on the hill for his team-leading ninth start of the season and his fourth start against Springfield. In his other three starts against the Cards, he is 0-0 and allowed 4 runs, on 13 hits in 14 2/3 innings pitched. Winder is 3rd in the league with a 2.16 ERA, 3rd in league in innings pitched 41.2, 3rd in WHIP at 0.94 and will lead the league in starts.

STRIKE EM OUT- The Wind Surge punched out a season high 16 Redbirds in the game and have 37 in the last three games. The Surge have punched out 429 batters this season, leading the AA-Central. Josh Winder leads the league with 50K's and Cole Sands is seventh with 42. The Surge have punched out ten or more in ten of last 11 games.

MORALES - Roy Morales extended his hitting streak to seven games last night, he is 12x28 in the streak with 5RBI. He has an RBI in four consecutive games.

CALEB- Caleb Hamilton has a hit in 12 of his last 13 games, he is 16x48, 5HR, 16RBI in last 13 games.

ROAD WARRIORS - The Wind Surge started a stretch of 18 of 24 games away from Riverfront Stadium last Tuesday. Wichita is home this week for six and then heads to Texas for 12 games and will not return to Wichita until July 6. The Wind Surge are 10-8 on the road this season.

MIRANDA - Infielder Jose Miranda 31 RBI leads the league, his nine home runs is 6th in the league and his 49 hits leads the league, and his .316 average is 3rd. He has also started at all of the infield positions, 1b, 2b, 3b, and SS.

PALACIOS - Jermaine Palacios had four hits in five at bats and his first multi-home run game of the season on Wednesday. Palacios is 7th in the league with a .305 batting average, 4th with a .411 OBP, he has reached base in 35 of the 37 games he has played in.

NOTES - The Wind Surge have the most wins in one run games within AA-Central play. (8-5) Wichita leads the league lead with a .259 team batting average. The Surge pitchers are tied for second in the league with 4 shutouts and third with a 3.91 team ERA. Wichita is 8-1 in games that the club has hit at least two home runs. Manager Ramon Borrego picked up career win number 398 Thursday night.
