Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with game three at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It's the second of four series between the teams this season with New Hampshire, holding the edge 6-2. The Fisher Cats came to Reading from May 9-14 and return from Aug. 29 to Sept. 3. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from Aug. 8 to 13.

Morning Blues

Yesterday, Reading fell down 2-0 in the series with a 6-2 loss to New Hampshire. It was an early pitchers duel between Victor Vargas and Sem Robberse, but Vargas allowed a two-run home run to Orelvis Martinez to put New Hampshire up 2-0. The Fisher Cats tacked four more on in the bottom of the eighth. Reading avoided the shutout with two runs in the top of the ninth inning, but ultimately fell 6-2.

No Donuts for the Fightins

Through 46 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-10 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching earned its first shutout of the season Sunday.

A Look at the Bullpen

Last weekend, Reading's bullpen was lights out. From Friday to Sunday, the bullpen allowed three earned runs in 12.1 innings pitched, which is good for a 2.19 ERA. In wins this season, the R-Phils bullpen has a 2.42 ERA, but it balloons to 7.63 in losses.

Reading Streaks

Lots of Fightin Phils have been racking up impressive streaks lately. Nick Podkul leads the way with an 18-game on base streak that dates back to Apr. 20 and Podkul is hitting .297 over that span. Carlos De La Cruz has also reached base in 17-straight games. McCarthy Tatum has reahced base in 10-straight and Johan Rojas is at nine. The last R-Phil to have an on-base streak of 20 or more games was Logan O'Hoppe, who had a 21-game on-base streak last season.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies fell to the New York Mets 4-1 last night and the Phillies will look to avoid being swept today at 1:10 PM. Lehigh Valley fell 7-5 last night to the Railriders to drop to 25-27 on the season. Jersey Shore swept a doubleheader at home last night against Brooklyn, winning 9-3 and 5-0 respectively. Clearwater won against Dunedin 9-2 to improve to a Florida State League-best 33-13 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 1, 1999: At Portland, the R-Phils score six in the top of the 1st but still need 10 innings to defeat the Sea Dogs, 11-9. Every Reading starter has at least one hit and every starter but Andy Stewart scores. Pat Burrell goes 2-for-6 with a homer and three RBI.

A Look at New Hampshire

This is the second meeting between these teams in the span of just 16 days. The Fisher Cats are 24-22 and are in third in the Northeast Division, six games ahead of Reading. Last week, New Hampshire 2-4 at Portland, winning the final two games of the series. Up next, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Reading's last opponent, Harrisburg.

Fisher Cat Starter

It'll be the first time this season Reading sees righty Chad Dallas. Dallas began the season at high-A Vancouver and made his double-A debut on May 19 with New Hampshire. Overall, he is 3-0 with a 1.40 ERA over seven starts. In 38.2 innings pitched, Dallas has 50 strikeouts and 14 walks. At Portland on Friday, Dallas went five innings, allowing zero-earned runs on four hits, with four strikeouts. He was a fourth round pick out of Tennessee in the 2021 Draft by Toronto. Dallas spent all of 2022 with Vancouver, going 1-7 with a 4.60 ERA over 21 starts last season.
