LAST TIME OUT

ROCHESTER, NY (September 9, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders beat the Rochester Red Wings 4-1 at ESL Ballpark on Wednesday night. Max Schuemann and Duke Ellis went deep, backing Brendan Beck's tenth win of the year and helping the RailRiders get level with the Red Wings atop the International League standings.

After a two-hour and 55-minute delay, Schuemann staked Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to a 1-0 lead with his fifth home run of the season. Schuemann launched a first-pitch sinker 413 feet to left-center for the early lead.

In the second, Ellis singled, stole second, and scored on a Jarred Kelenic single for a 2-0 lead.

Brendan Beck made the lead stand with 5.1 scoreless innings of work, walking one and striking out six.

In the top of the seventh, Ellis's fifth home run of the year doubled the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre advantage to 4-0. Rochester plated a run on a pair of hits in the bottom of the inning to close the scoring.

Beck (10-2) earned the win, and former Yankees' farmhand Jack Cebert (0-2) took the loss.

NEWS & NOTES

IN THE LEAGUE - After a win last night, the RailRiders move back into a tie for first place alongside their current competitors, Rochester Red Wings. They are a game in front of third place Indianapolis and two ahead of Worcester and St. Paul in the International League. The RailRiders are 7-3 in their last ten games and are ten contests above .500 on the full season. Rochester has gone 5-5 in their last ten contests.

THE BIG TEN - J.C. Escarra had a two-hit game yesterday, pushing his hit streak to ten consecutive contests. It is the first time he has done that this summer with the RailRiders and joins Oswaldo Cabrera and George Lombard Jr. as the only other players to do so this summer. Duke Ellis and Cabrera have each had a hit in nine consecutive games played.

HOMER HEAVEN - The RailRiders did not add to their home run total in the series opener, still holding 199 on the season. The team currently holds the second most in Triple-A, behind the league leading Saints with 242. Fernández has the most tallying 25 on the summer, a dozen hitters have double digits, and 30 different players have at least one on the books for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The season record is 219 long balls, done back in 2023.

RODRÍGUEZ RETURNS - Yankees #3 prospect Elmer Rodríguez was optioned by NYY to the RailRiders on September 7 and will made his 20th start in Triple-A. Rodríguez has been stellar for the RailRiders accumulating 97.1 innings pitched, with eight wins while striking out 99 batters. The righty has lowered his ERA to 2.59 in Triple-A. After making two more starts up in the big leagues for the Yankees this time around, he has totaled six in the Majors for a 5.40 ERA. Rodríguez was picked up in a trade with Boston for C Carlos Narváez in 2024.

ESCARRA ELECTRIC - Since being optioned to the RailRiders on June 26, J.C. Escarra has been exceptional for SWB. In 56 games, the lefty has hit .306 with 14 doubles and ten homers. Escarra has driven in 45 runs and scored 35 of his own. He has also been influential behind the plate, having thrown out 15 of 40 runners for 27% caught stealing rate.

BRENDAN'S JOURNEY - Yankees #28 prospect Brendan Beck still holds on to the best earned run average among qualified pitchers, holding a 2.75 ERA in the International League. This is just under a run better per frame than the next closest pitcher. He also is first in wins (10), strikeouts (146), innings pitched (131.0), and WHIP (1.03). In the past month Beck has been on the move courtesy of the Yankees when he was recalled and optioned down four separate times. His most recent performance was one clean inning out of the bullpen for New York. Beck has been honored with the International League Pitcher of the Week award three times and was deemed the June Pitcher of the Month for the league. The 27-year-old was drafted by the Yankees in the 2nd round back in 2021 out of Stanford University and has made two appearances this season for New York.

DUKE'S RECORD PERFORMANCE - Duke Ellis set a new single season record with 51 stolen bases on the season. He broke the record of 44 set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 85 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 88 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games. Ellis's personal record is 57 in a single year done back in 2024.
