#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**NO BREAKS:** The Bradenton Marauders are currently in the middle of their longest stretch of the 2024 season without a day off. After having an off-day on Monday, June 24, the Marauders will play 12-straight games against the Clearwater Threshers and the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. The Marauders will then have back-to-back off days on July 7 and July 8.

A FIRST FOR EVERYTHING: With a few injuries in the rotation, RHP Peyton Stumbo is set to make his first professional start on Monday night. A 20th round selection in the 2023 MLB Draft by the Pirates, Stumbo was a starter at the University of Nevada in 2022 and 2023. In his college career, 19 of his 33 appearances were out of the rotation and he started a season-high 10 games in his final year in 2023.

**TWO SIDES OF A WEEK:** In the first three games of this past week's series against the Clearwater Threshers, the Marauders offense hit .245/.341/.481 with five HRs, and 23 runs scored (7.7 per game). In the latter three games, the offense hit just .138/.231/.238 with two HRs and five runs scored (1.7 per game). Bradenton also scored first in the opening three games and won all three while the Threshers jumped in front early in the next three in which Clearwater won all three.

**AMERICA'S BIRTHDAY:** Monday is the start of a mini three-game home & home series with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. Fort Myers enters the week with 1.5 game lead for first place in the second half of the Florida State League West Division.

**BACK BETTER THAN EVER: LHP Inmer Lobo** tossed three more scoreless innings on Sunday afternoon in Clearwater. Lobo has given up one unearned run in 7.1 innings in his last four outings.

**THEY'RE FIGHTING:** After a 4-22 record on the road to start the season, Bradenton won six of their last 10 games away from LECOM Park. Bradenton has split road trips with Clearwater and Dunedin. Bradenton won their fifth-straight road game on Thursday for the first time since last June/July when Bradenton won seven-straight road games in Lakeland and Daytona.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. In June, Bradenton hit 31 home runs in 26 games, which was the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 18 of their last 21 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023. Bradenton needed to hit three on Sunday in Clearwater to tie the record.

JAVVY'S MASHIN: In June, Javier Rivas slashed .341/.400/.646 with five doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBIs, three walks, and 13 runs scored in 25 games. His seven home runs on the season are also a new career-high with his six in June tied for the most in Single-A. Rivas finished first in the Florida State League during the month of June in total bases (53), tied for first in home runs (six), second in batting (.341), slugging (.646) and OPS (1.046), tied for second in hits (28) and extra base hits (12) and sixth in OBP (.400).

**PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS:** With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, **RHP Khristian Curtis** entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30 last Tuesday night. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system.

**CLOSE QUARTERS:** Wednesday's win against Clearwater marked the Marauders' 27th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 16-11 record in those games with 51 of their first 75 (68.0%) games having been decided by three runs or less.
