vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It's the 11th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the fifth of 12 games in Virginia. With a win, Gwinnett would secure at least a split of this series, which would be its first non-losing road trip since 4/5-10 at Memphis (3-3).

VS. NORFOLK: The Stripers are 7-3 (.700) in 10 games vs. Norfolk (5-1 home, 2-2 road), their best record against an opponent so far this year. Gwinnett is 9-2-1 in 12 season series all-time vs. Norfolk (since 2009), and hasn't lost a season series since 2013 (went 7-14). Last year, the Stripers and Tides split the season series (6-6).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Gwinnett ranks second in the IL in team batting since 4/23, hitting .270 (266-for-984, 55 2B, 3 3B, 31 HR, 153 R, 141 RBI, 17 SB) over 30 games in that span. That's just one point behind Nashville's leagueleading .271 average through 29 games in that span.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 482 in 46 games (10.48 SO per game). That's nine more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 473 SO in 46G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 56) and Touki Toussaint (T-8th, 46) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 5/27.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out seven batters over 5.2 innings (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB) in a losing cause last night, raising his season strikeout total to 56, second in the IL behind Norfolk's Grayson Rodriguez (1st, 76 SO). Muller has fanned at least seven batters in eight of his 25 career Triple-A starts with the Stripers, posting a 10.99 SO/9.0 IP ratio (149 SO in 122.0 IP) while going 7-7 with a 3.54 ERA, .231 BAA, and eight quality starts.

RISING WATERS: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .300 (18-for-60, 4 2B, 2 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 1 SB, .790 OPS) in 15 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .252 (144-for-571, 31 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 96 R, 54 RBI, 32 SB in 144G).

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin has notched hits in 15 of 18 games in May, batting .328 (22-for-67, 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 10 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .969 OPS). Overall, he has reached base safely in 34 of 38 games, hitting .300 (42for-140, 8 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 21 R, 17 RBI, 3 SB, .854 OPS).

• GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .296 (297-for-1,004, 59 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 134 R, 99 RBI, 10 SB, .770 OPS) with 82 multi-hit efforts in 273 games

**TONIGHT:** The Stripers play game five of a six-game series **TROMP MASHING IN MAY:** Since 5/1, **Chadwick Tromp** ranks among IL leaders in RBI (T-2nd, 22), home runs (3rd, 8), slugging percentage (4th, .681), extra-base hits (T-6th, 12), total bases (T-7th, 47), and OPS (11th, .987).

> • Power Restored: In Game 2 on Thursday, he blasted a game-winning solo homer (#9) off LHP Kevin Smith for a last-at-bat 3-2 victory, his first clout since the final game of his 13-game hitting streak (.385 from 4/24-5/12), 11game RBI streak (23 RBI from 4/28-5/12), and ninegame extra-base hit streak (11 XBH from 5/1-5/12).

FIRST SAVE FOR VODNIK: Victor Vodnik recorded the first save of his Triple-A career in Game 2 on Thursday (1.0 IP. 0 H. 0 R. 0 BB. 2 SO in 3-2 win). He has made three scoreless appearances since joining Gwinnett on 5/17 (4.0 IP, 0 H, 3 BB, 3 SO). Vodnik has yet to allow a run over 11.0 IP (4 H, 6 BB, 17 SO) spanning 10 outings between Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi this season.

Triple-A Debuts: Vodnik is the sixth player to make his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett in 2022, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, SS Braden Shewmake, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP Willilam Woods.

**SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN:** Braden Shewmake is batting .316 (6-for-19, 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 1 RBI, .824 OPS) in his last five games, including the second four-hit game of his career on 5/21 vs. Memphis (4-for-4, 2B, R, RBI). Through the first 36 games of his Triple-A debut, he is batting .285 (37-for-130, 8 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 18 R, 7 RBI, 4 SB, .755 OPS) with 11 multi-hit efforts (tied for team lead).

**<u>DEMERITTE RETURNS:</u>** Today, the Atlanta Braves optioned Travis Demeritte back to Gwinnett. Demeritte hit .213 (19for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 161 of 189 games (85.2%) since 2019, batting .284 (185-for-651, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 126 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .946 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons (20 in 2019, 21 in 2021), joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia. The Stripers are 33-9 (.786) all-time when he homers.

### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Connor Johnstone makes his 12th appearance and fifth start of the season in game five of a six-game series at Norfolk. It is his third appearance and second start against the Tides this season (0-0, 1.80 ERA).

 <u>GWN Career:</u> It is his 57th career appearance (25th start) with Gwinnett dating back to 2018 (7-9, 4.83 ERA, 1.28 WHIP, .269 BAA, 1 SV).

 Triple-A Splits: Makes his 25th career Triple-A start (3-9, 5.33 ERA, .283 BAA) ... Makes his 28th career Triple-A appearance (13th start) on the road (5-4, 3.09 ERA, .218 BAA).

• <u>Last Win:</u> Johnstone is seeking his first win as a starter with Gwinnett since 5/8/21 at Charlotte (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 SO in 7-3 victory).

**2022 SEASON:** Johnstone was a member of Gwinnett's Opening Night roster for the third time in his career (also in 2019 and 2021) ... **4/19 at JAX:** Made his first spot start of the year (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 0 SO in 2-0 loss), his sixth career outing of 5.0-or-more innings with the Stripers ... **4/29 vs. NOR:** Ran his scoreless innings streak as a starter to 9.0 IP (ND, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO in 8-0 win) ... **5/5 vs. CLT:** Notched his first career Triple-A save (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R in 3-2 win).

**2022 SPRING TRAINING:** He appeared once for the Braves, earning a save on 3/28 vs. Toronto (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 SO in 5-4 win) ... Threw nine pitches (5 strikes).

**2021 SEASON:** For the first time in his career, Johnstone spent the entire year at the Triple-A level, pitching as both a starter (1-8, 6.23 ERA in 16 starts) and reliever (2-0, 2.36 ERA in 17G) with Gwinnett ... Did not issue a walk in 26 of his 33 appearances ... Walked only 10 while striking out 48 for the season ... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings in a spot start on 5/8 at Charlotte (win, 1 H, 0 BB, 5 SO in 7-3 victory) ... From 5/8-6/23, made starts in 10 of 11 outings (1-6, 7.31 ERA) ... On 6/10 at Memphis, tossed 2.0 scoreless innings as the first of six pitchers to combine on a two-hit shutout (won 11-0).
