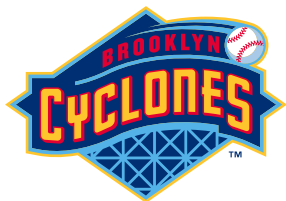

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn was swept by Jersey Shore in Saturday's doubleheader...The BlueClaws won the opener, 3-2, in 8 innings and the nightcap by the same final...DH **Rixon Wingrove** delivered the walk-off RBI ground-rule double in the 8th in Game 1...He was 3-for-3 with a walk...SS **Casey Martin** registered 2 hits for Jersey Shore in the opener...C **Kevin Parada** collected 2 knocks, including a double...DH **José Mena** recorded a 2-run single in the 5th...RHP **Tyler Stuart** permitted 1 earned run (2 total) over 5 frames in a no-decision for the 'Clones...Wingrove added 2 hits, a double, and an RBI in Game 2...LF **Jared Carr** went 2-for-3 with an RBI in the nightcap for Jersey Shore...RF **Omar De Los Santos** tallied 2 hits for Brooklyn, while CF **Jaylen Palmer** reached base twice on a single and a walk.

**BLADE RUNNER:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball...Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him.

**BIG STU:** At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old had his scoreless inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings last Sunday vs. Winston-Salem, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.23)...Stuart is also 7th in innings pitched (44.0) and 10th in WHIP (1.20)...The Kankakee, Ill. native is also 2nd in LOB% (87.2%), 2nd in FIP (2.86), 4th in xFIP (3.46), 6th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 8th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64).

**THEY'RE NO. 1:** The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 18 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 36 earned runs (48 total) on 117 hits through the last 151.0 innings...That is good for a 2.15 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia is 2nd in MiLB (2.49)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 62 (10.0 BB%) and struck out 180 in that span (28.9 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 75-48, over the 18-game stretch...Brooklyn is 10-8 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.80).

**BULL-PEN ON PARADE:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.13) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Rome (3.51) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.29) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...San Francisco's Double-A Richmond leads MiLB (3.02).

**UP TO PAR-ADA:** C **Kevin Parada** extended his hitting streak to 8 games with multi-hit effort in Game 1 on Saturday...The 21-year-old is 11-for-his-last-32 (.344) with a run scored, 3 doubles, 2 RBI, and a pair of walks...Parada holds a 126 wRC+ and .378 wOBA in that span...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (14)...Since the start of May, Parada was tied for 3rd in the circuit in two-baggers (10) and tied for 5th in the league in extra-base hits (13).

**MATEO MASH:** INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .267/.365/.600 and he has registered an impressive .965 OPS, 154 wRC+, and .423 wOBA in that time...Gil is 12-for-45 at the plate (.267) with 9 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 home runs, and 11 RBI adding 7 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (4) with three others...The former 3rd-round pick is also 3rd in the league in slugging (.600), tied for 5th in RBI (11), and 7th in OPS (.965).

**OMAR ON THE RUN:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** is 10-for-his-last-32 (.313) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and a 115 wRC+...In addition to his 19 stolen bases in 2023, he remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 89 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (96), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (94), and Mariners prospect OF **Jonathan Clasé** (91) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 38...Omar is already 13 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**THRILL OF THE 'CHASE':** After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 22 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .286/.360/.494 with a .854 OPS...Estep has accumulated 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 13 RBI in 86 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 130 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 153 points in that time (.047 to .200).

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs **Orion Kerker** (25) and RHP **Tommy McCollum** (29) are featured...INF **Hao Yu Lee** (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30...The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Cyclones were swept in Saturday's twinbill and dropped to 1-7 in doubleheader games in 2023...All 4 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...The 'Clones are 20-21 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games this year.

**DÉJÀ VU:** Brooklyn was handed a walk-off defeat for the 6th time this season in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader...3 of those 6 have come at the hands of the BlueClaws at ShoreTown Ballpark...This is in addition to the Cyclones' 4 walk-off victories in 2023...The first of which came vs. Jersey Shore on a bases-loaded walk to **Chase Estep** in the 11th on Opening Day...20.4% (10-of-49) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

**JEFE JEFFREY:** RHP **Jeffrey Colón** tossed another gem on Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts last Friday vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

**RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN:** RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 5 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed a run on 1 hit and walked only 3 over 7.1 innings, registering 10 strikeouts...That equates to a 38.5 K%.

**AT HIS BECK-ON CALL:** RHP **Jace Beck** has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strikeout rate of 45.1% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is 4th in strikeout rate (45.1%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is the best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cincinnati's LHP **Jacob Heatherly** (19.89) is 2nd at Single-A Daytona.

**THE DONUT SHOPPE:** Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occurred in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that day.

**IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (181), at-bats (596), plate appearances (714), runs scored (94), walks (98), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (189), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (111).


**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C **Kevin Parada** and CF **Alex Ramírez**...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include **Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), **Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (24/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 3.2 innings on Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...Walked 3 and struck out 4...Tossed 65 pitches and 40 strikes (61.5%)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** with a man at 1st and 2 outs in the bottom of the 4th and Brooklyn leading, 3-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...He, Beck (2.1 IP), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.2), RHP **Michael Krauza** (0.1), and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (1.0) combined on a 5-hit shutout in the Cyclones' 8-0 win.

**BLADE RUNNER:** Tidwell the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball... Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him.

**BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN:** Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

**2022:** Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.
