LAST OUTING: Ashby look his third loss of the Triple-A season last Saturday in Jacksonville. He yielded six runs (all earned) on seven hits and four walks in a 10-0 defeat to the Jumbo Shrimp.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's fourth outing against Charlotte - each of the previous three came in the 2021 season with Nashville. He took the loss despite striking out 11 and not allowing an earned run in seven innings on June 4, 2021 in Charlotte (2 H, 1 R, 1 BB). He then worked in relief on June 23 and June 26 against the Knights in Nashville, allowing four runs in an inning on the 23rd. Overall, he is 0-1 with a 3.72 ERA (9.2 IP/4 ER).
