TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints fell down 3-0 after two innings and were able to tie the game in the sixth but did not have enough in a 4-3 loss to lowa. Aaron Rozek made his Triple-A debut, allowing a two-run homer to Matt Mervis in the first and a RBI single from Patrick Wisdom in the second. The first Saints' runs came in the fifth on DaShawn Keirsey Jr.'s third home run of the season, making it 3-2. Alex look allowed by the sixth to knot the game at three. However, after an errant pickoff attempt in the eighth, the Cubs jumped back in front thanks to a Chase Strumpf single and would hang on to win 4-3. JENSEN JAMS THEM UP: Ryan Jensen has been one of the best relievers in the International League in the early stages of 2024. His six strikeouts on Saturday match the single-game high in the IL for any relief pitcher. His 13 strikeouts ranks tied for fifth among all IL relievers. He's one of 13 pitchers in the league to have thrown at least 6.1 innings and not allow an earned run yet. His two wins are tied for the second-most in the league.

WE JUST WANT TO GO HOME: Two Saints baserunners were cut down at home plate on Friday in their 6-0 loss to lowa. It's the second time in franchise history that the Saints had two runners cut down at home, with the other coming May 28, 2023 against Omaha. It marks just the sixth time in the International League since 2021 where multiple runners have been thrown out at home on outfield assists.

RACKING UP K's: The Saints struck out 15 lowa Cubs on Saturday, doing so for the third time this series. They struck out 15 batters in consecutive games on Tuesday and Wednesday, the second time in franchise history the club has recorded 15 strikeouts in back-to-back games, matching May 22-23, 2021 against Indianapolis. It's also the fourth time this season and the 17th time in franchise history that the Saints struck out 15 batters. The Saints are now 10-7 in games which they strike out 15 hitters. Saints' pitchers are third in the International League and sixth in Triple-A with 143 strikeouts. Their 94 swinging strikeouts are the fourth-most in Triple-A.

BULLPEN DOMINANCE: In the final 6.1 innings of the game on Thursday, the Saints bullpen retired 19 of the last 20 batters they faced. The lone baserunner was a Ali Sánchez home run in the seventh. The one batter that reached is the fewest for any game in franchise history in which the bullpen pitched at least 6.1 innings. It also was the third-longest appearance by the 'pen in which they did not walk a batter.

*The bullpen has also struck out a league-high 39 batters this week, six more than any other IL team. Their 26.0 innings pitched matches lowa for the fourthmost this week. The bullpen's 0.96 WHIP in this series is also tied for the fourth-best in the league.

RISP ASSESSMENT: Over the first four games of the season, the Saints were hitting .429 with runners in scoring position, ranking second in Triple-A. However, over the last nine games they have gone 12-for-75 (.160) with runners in scoring position, the lowest average in Triple-A. They also rank 19th in Triple-A in exit velocity with runners in scoring position in that span with an average exit velocity of 85.4 miles per hour.

THREE HOMERS HELPS, USUALLY: Tuesday marked just the seventh time in franchise history that the Saints homered three times in a game and did not come out with a win. Prior to Tuesday, the Saints were 58-6 in games where they homer three times in one game. It was also only the second time that the Saints have ever lost a game when they hit three home runs in one inning. The other instance came on April 6, 2023 in a 12-11 loss to the lowa Cubs.

SLOW OUT OF THE GATE: Offensively, the Saints have gotten off to a slower start than they have in previous years. Below is how the offense has fared through the teams first 13 games of last four years:

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: The Minnesota Twins reinstated LHP Caleb Thielbar from his rehab assignment on Sunday after two outings. He allowed one run in 3.0 innings (solo home run), struck out five and walked one. RHP Josh Staumont remains in St. Paul for his rehab assignment. Staumont was Placed on the 15-Day Injured List on March 28, retroactive to March 25, for a left calf strain.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins swept their doubleheader in Detroit yesterday, winning game one 11-5 by putting up seven runs in the 12th inning. Matt Wallner hit his first home run of the year, a three-run blast to help the Twins take the first one. In game two, Simeon Woods Richardson made his season debut in The Show by throwing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, striking out five and picking up the win in a 4-1 victory. Eduoard Julien hit his fourth homer of the season to give the Twins a 2-1 lead in the third that they would not give up.

LAST APPEARANCE: 4/9 v IOWA...made second start of the season, allowed eight runs, tying career-high on ten hits, three of which were home runs, tying a career-high and struck out seven...six of eight runs were allowed in the first two innings...all three home runs were allowed in the second inning, first to Luis Vazquez to lead off the inning, followed by back-to-back homers by Patrick Wisdom and Matt Mervis later in the inning...bequeathed one runner to Michael Boyle, which scored on a home run...took first loss of the season in 9-7 Saints' defeat

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 4/3 @ NASH...made first start of the season in Nashville, allowing one run on two hits and striking out five over 5.2 innings...retired the first six batters he faced before allowing a single to Chavez Young in the third inning...allowed lone run after a wild pitch and a single allowed lone run to score...proceeded to retire final 10 batters before exiting the game in the sixth...received first win in 6-5 Saints victory.

WORLD SERIES RUNNER-UP: Caleb spent his college years not far from home at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. As a freshman, he got to experience something that not many players get the opportunity to experience: a trip to the College World Series. His DIII squad reached the championship after beating Salisbury, 7-3, Emory, 3-2 in 12, losing the first game of the semifinals to Trinity(TX), 16-7, but bouncing back to win the second game, 10-7. Unfortunately, they met their match in the championship dropping the best-of-three to Cortland, getting swept 11-3 and 6-2. He would get back to the DIII World Series in 2016, but this was less successful losing 8-0 to Trinity, beating Emory, 12-3 before being eliminated by the team they lost to in the 2015 DIII Championship Game, Cortland, 8-3.

SOMETHINGS BREWING: One can't help where they grow up which can determine who you root for growing up. Caleb was born in Neenah, WI and resides in Madison, WI, so naturally he rooted for the Milwaukee Brewers. His hometown team came calling in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021, taking Caleb with the 22nd pick overall from the San Diego Padres. The storybook had an incredible ending when he was called up to the Brewers on September 29, 2023. He pitched 2.1 innings of relief vs. Chicago Cubs and allowed one run on one hit while walking two and striking out five. He earned the win in his lone Major League appearance.

GIVE BACK: Each of the Major League team's usually choose a player or players within their organization for the hard work they put towards the community. In 2023, the Brewers selected Caleb as the Nashville Sounds Community Player of the Year.
